





HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SITUATION REPORT

- ✓ No new cases tested positive for COVID-19 today.
- ✓ Today 225 RDT screening tests and 210 PCR diagnostic tests were done. The cumulative number of tests done to date is 37 474 (21 709 RDT and 15 765 PCR).
- ✓ To date the total number of confirmed cases remains at 56; recovered 25, active cases 27 and 4 deaths, since the onset of the outbreak on 20 March 2020.
