HIGHLIGHTS OF THE SITUATION REPORT

- ✓ Four (4) cases tested positive for COVID-19 today. These are all returnees from South Africa and are all isolated.
- ✓ Today 349 RDT screening tests and 251 PCR diagnostic tests were done. The cumulative number of tests done to date is 59 794 (34 930 RDT and 24 864 PCR).
- ✓ Harare Province reported 8 recoveries.
- ✓ To date the total number of confirmed cases is 391; recovered 62, active cases 325 and 4 deaths, since the onset of the outbreak on 20 March 2020.
