

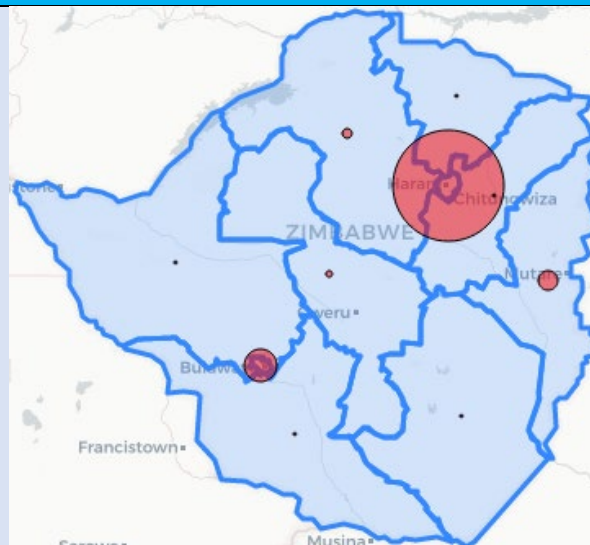
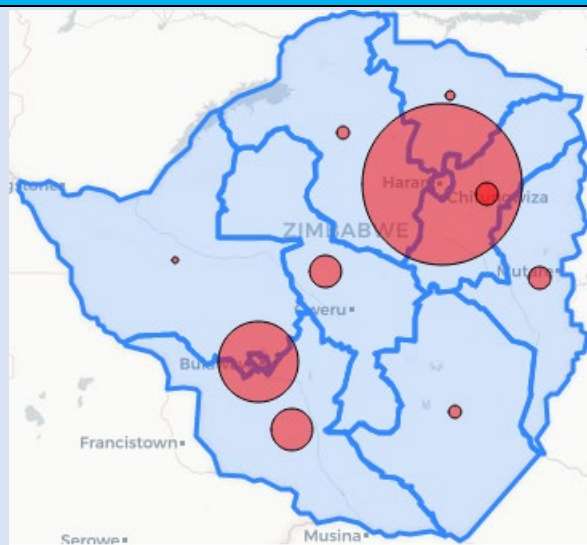


Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 02/11/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- **15** New Cases and **2** Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases falls to **12** from **14** yesterday).
- **610** PCR tests done today (Positivity today was **2.5%**)
- All **15** are local cases
- **12** new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at **94.6%** and Active cases go up to **205** today
- As of 2 November 2020, Zimbabwe has now recorded **8389** Cases **7939** recoveries and **245** Deaths.

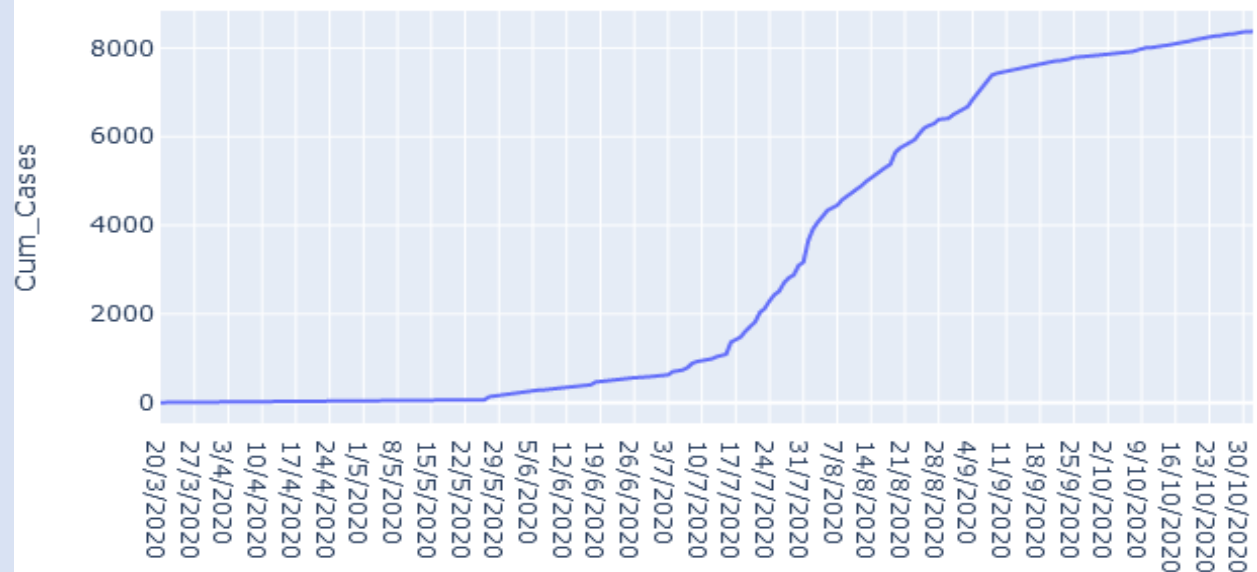

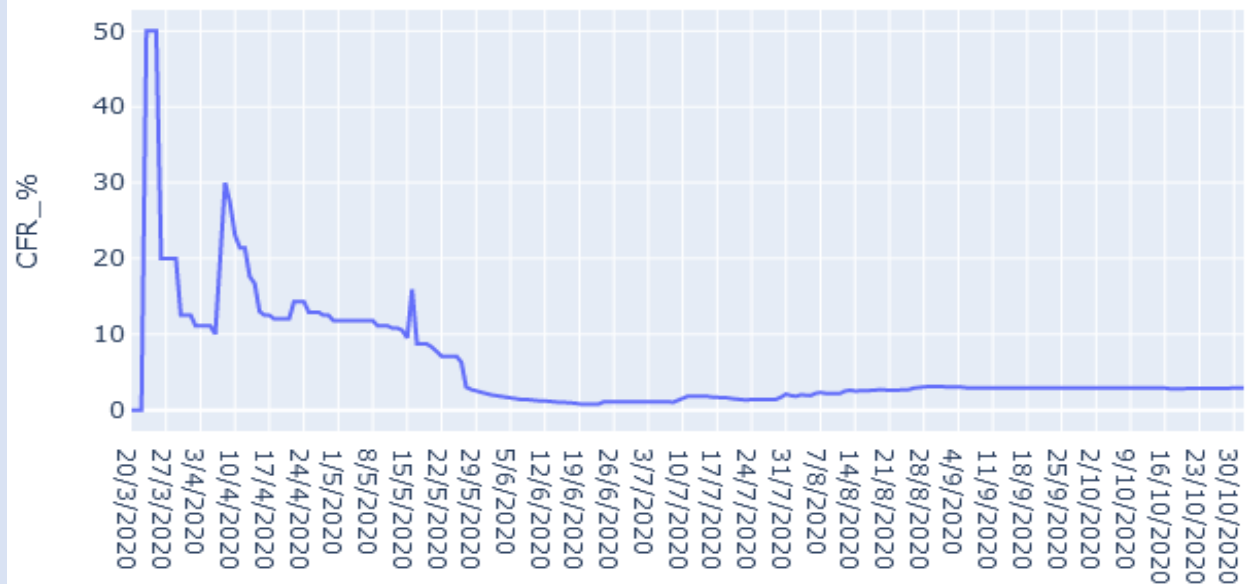

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate



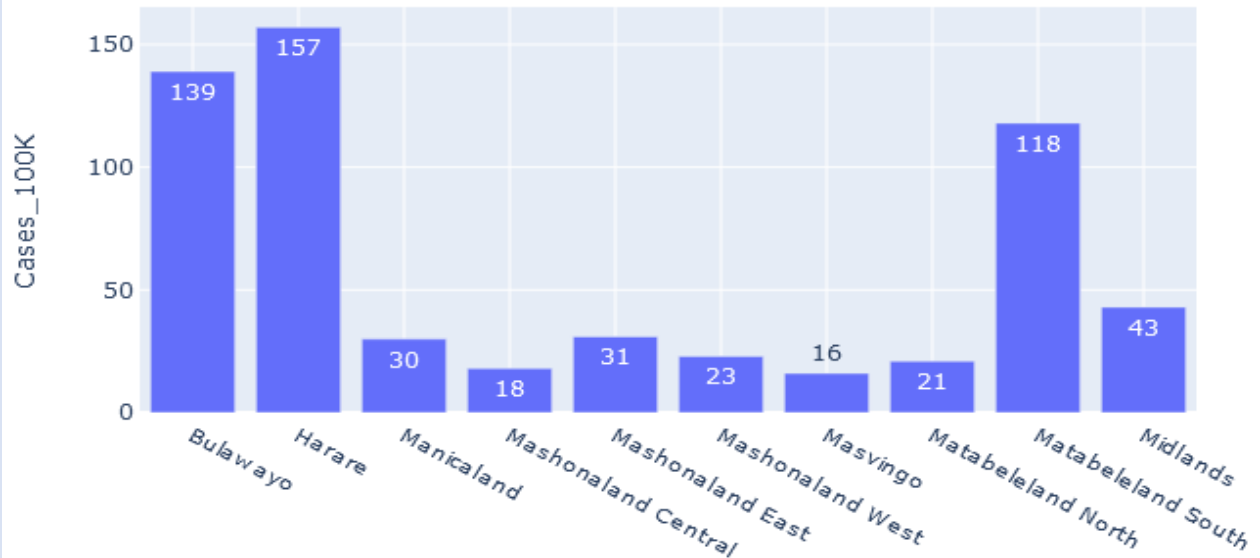

- National Case fatality Rate now stands at **2.9 %** as at 02/11/20

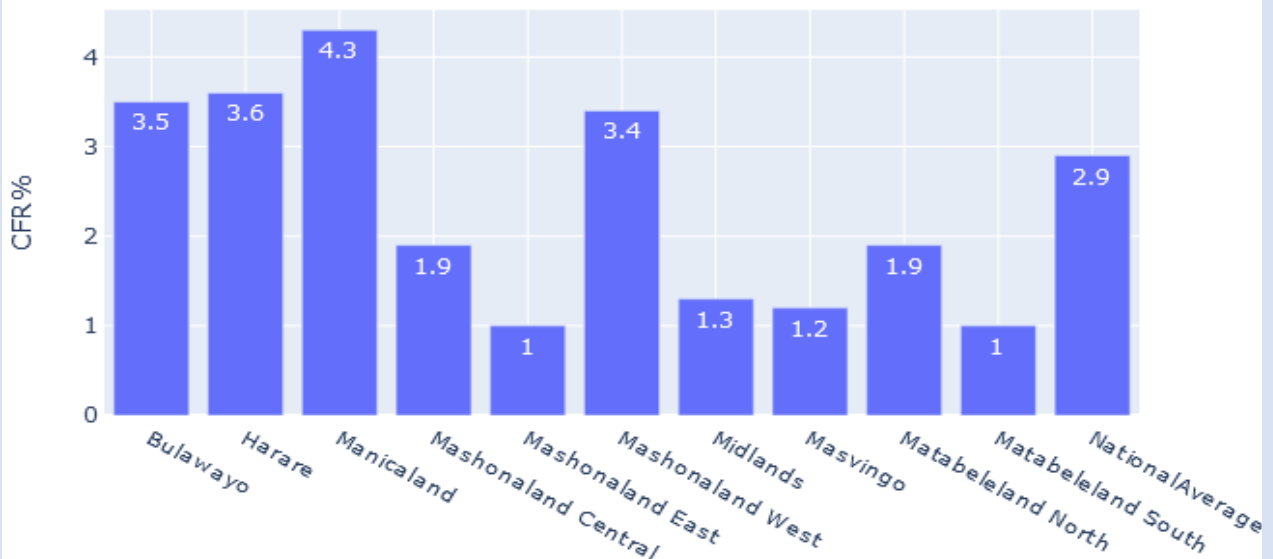

Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province



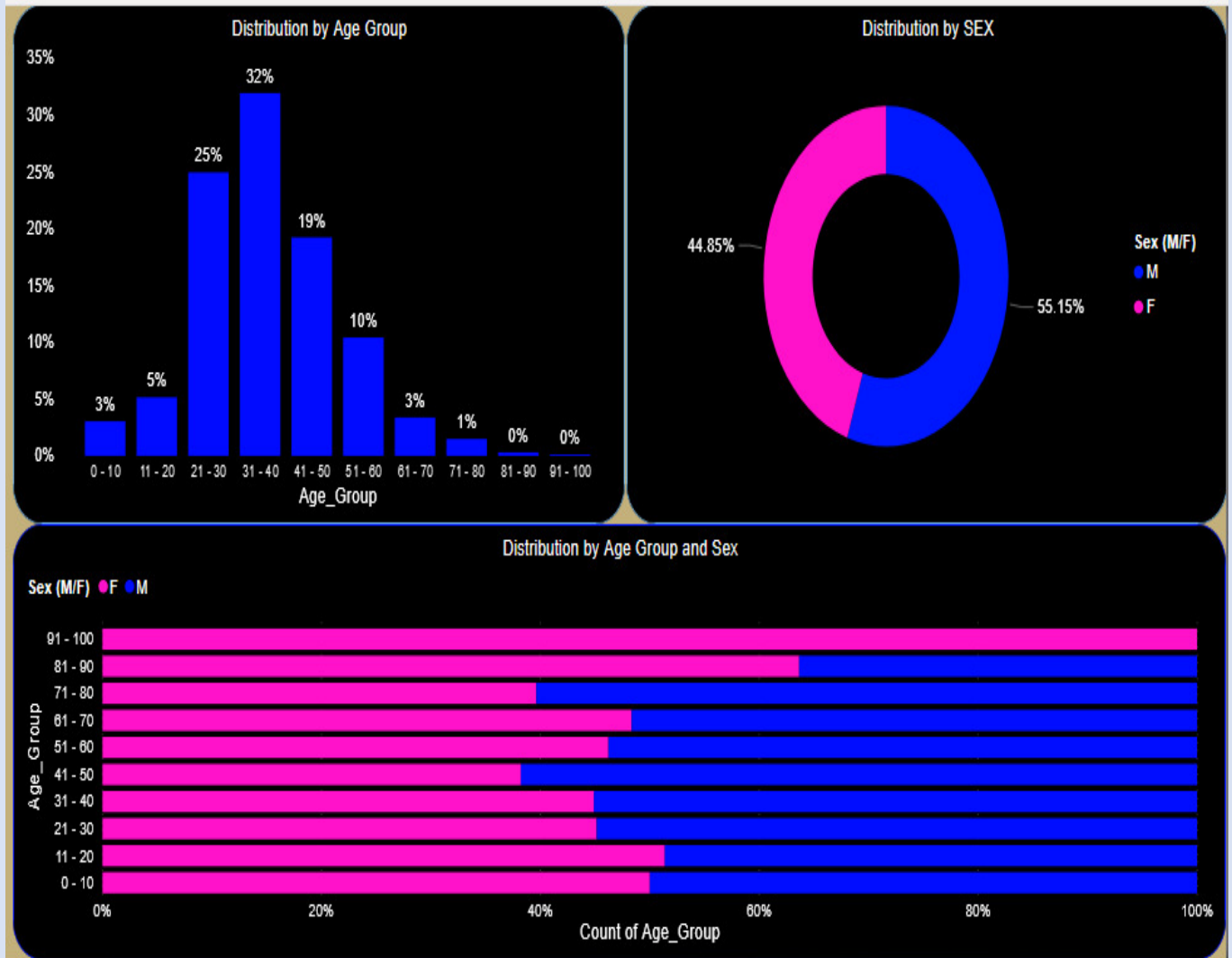
COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases



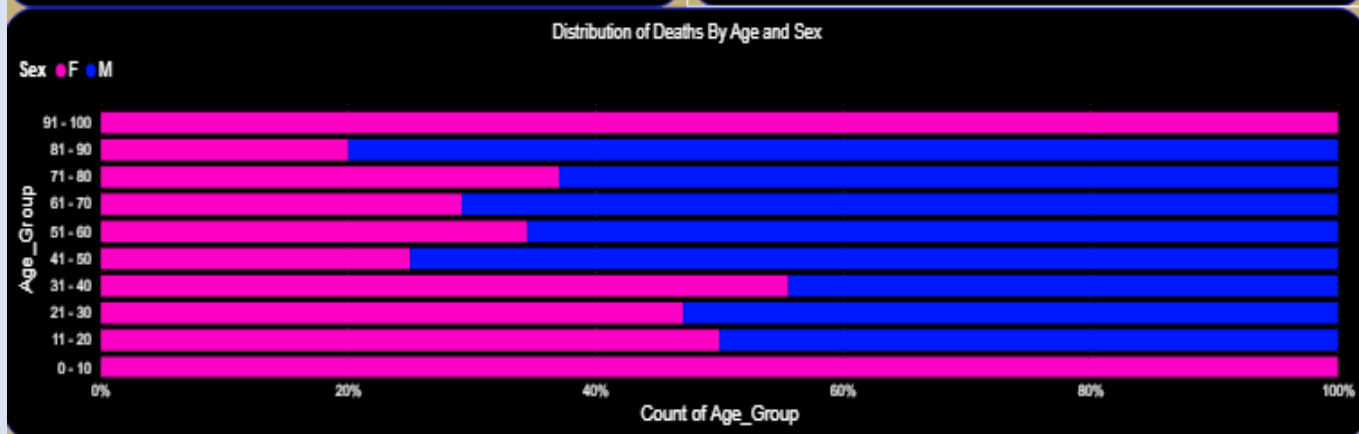
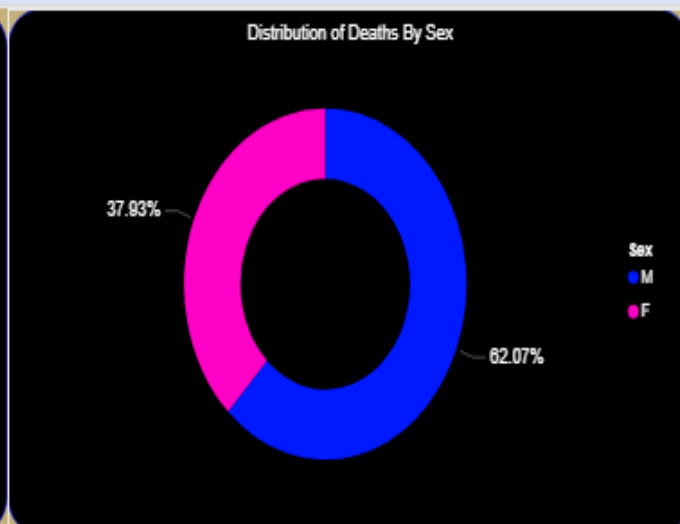
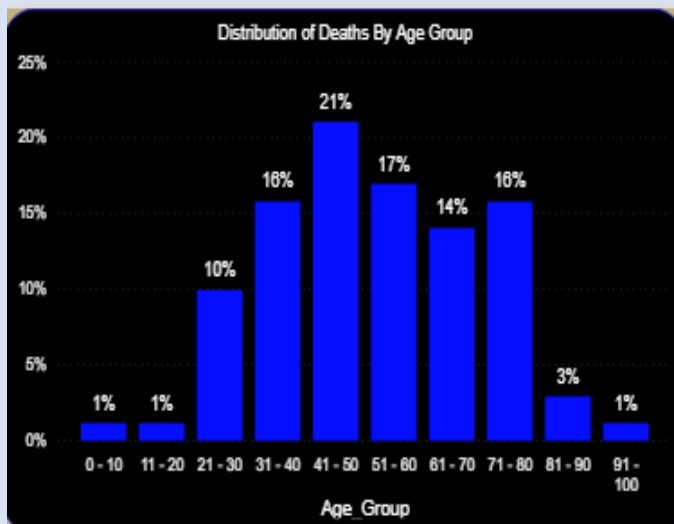
COMMENTS

- There are more deaths from males as age rises

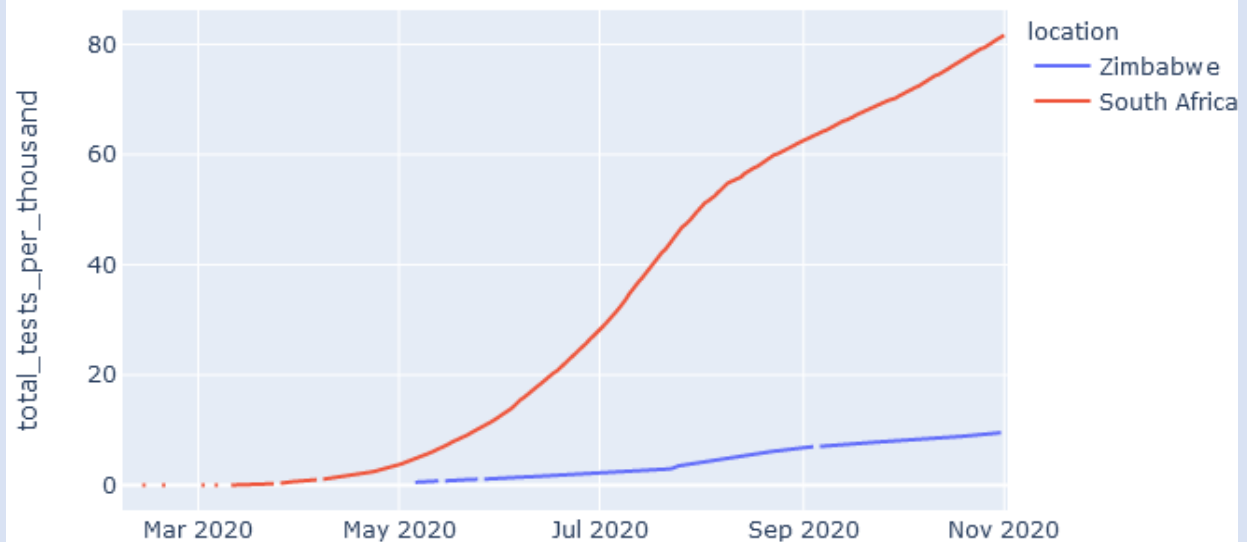

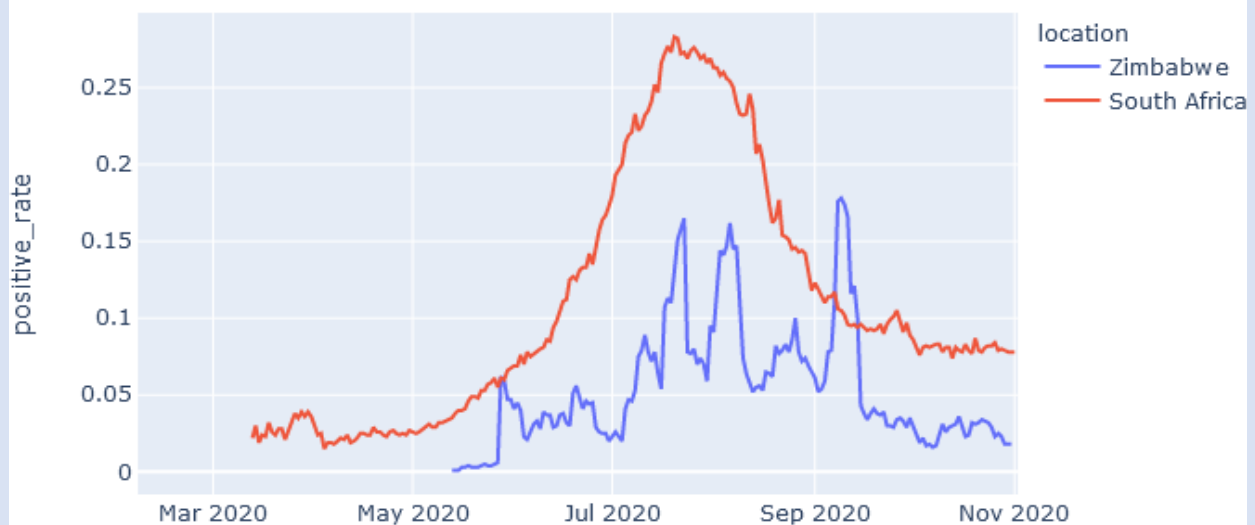

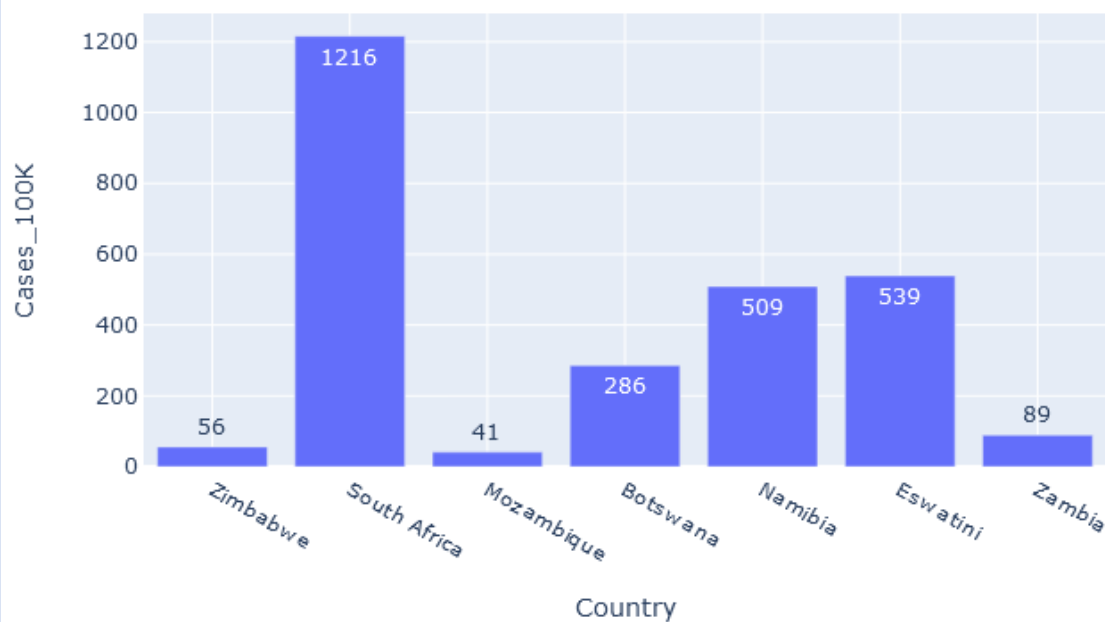

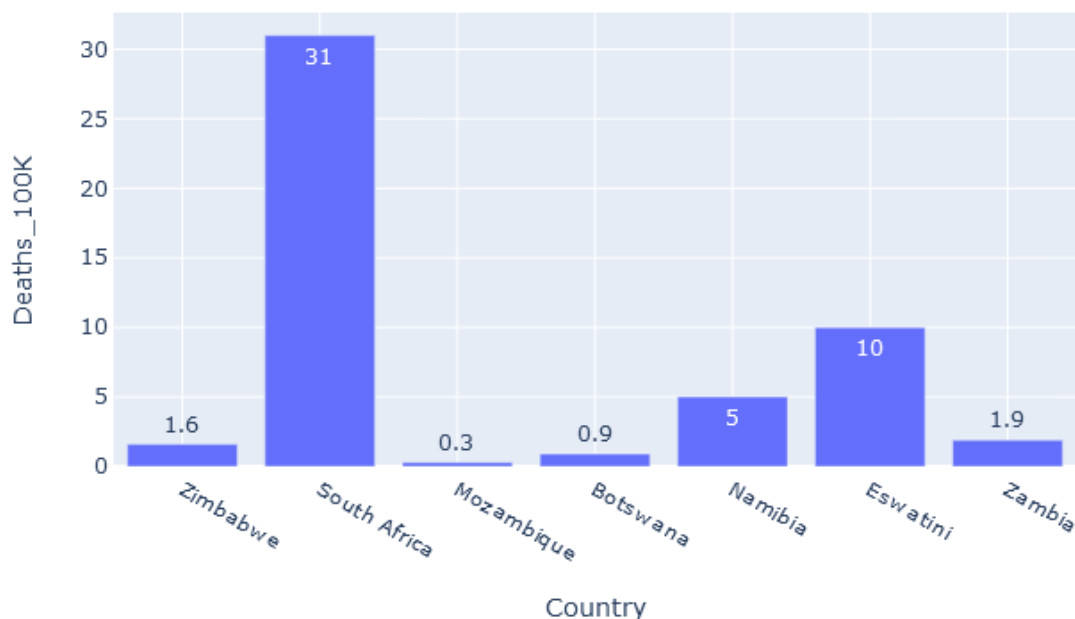

- *The Seven-Day Rolling average or moving average is used to take care of fluctuations in sample processing due by weekends or backlogs due to other operational issues. It is a mean of the last seven days' cases and it is calculated daily. It is used to highlight a finer trend of the variable being reported in this case New Covid-19 Cases in Zimbabwe.*
- The Public is encouraged to keep following MOHCC prevention guidelines as a rise in cases has been noted with most cases reported by Bulawayo in the last two weeks*
