

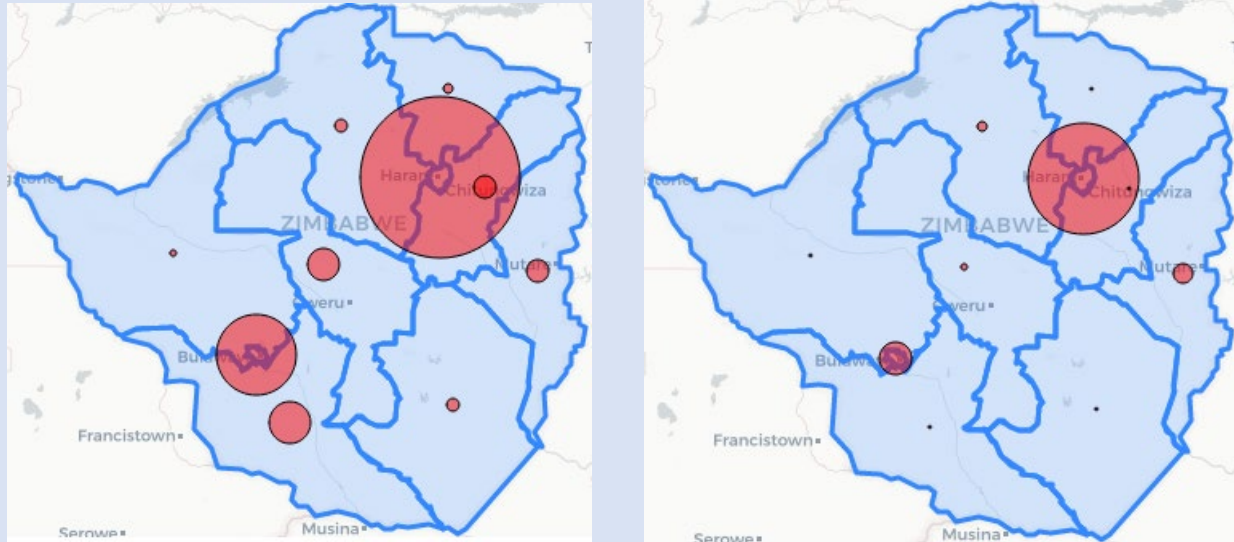


## Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 04/12/2020

### HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- **123** New Cases and **1** Death reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average\* for new cases rises to **119** from **114** yesterday).
- **1722** PCR tests done today (Positivity today was **7.1%**)
- **108** are local cases and **15** are returnees from SA(Death reported by Manicaland)
- **48** new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at **83.5%** and Active cases go up to **1568** today
- As of 04 December, Zimbabwe has now recorded **10547** Cases **8802** recoveries and **281** Deaths.

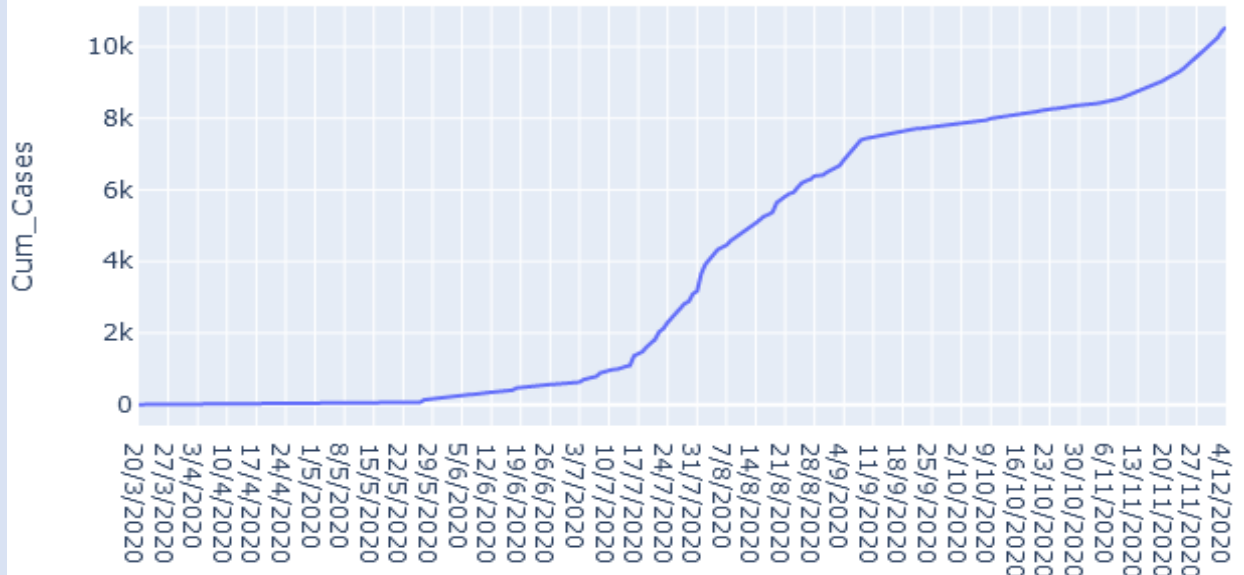

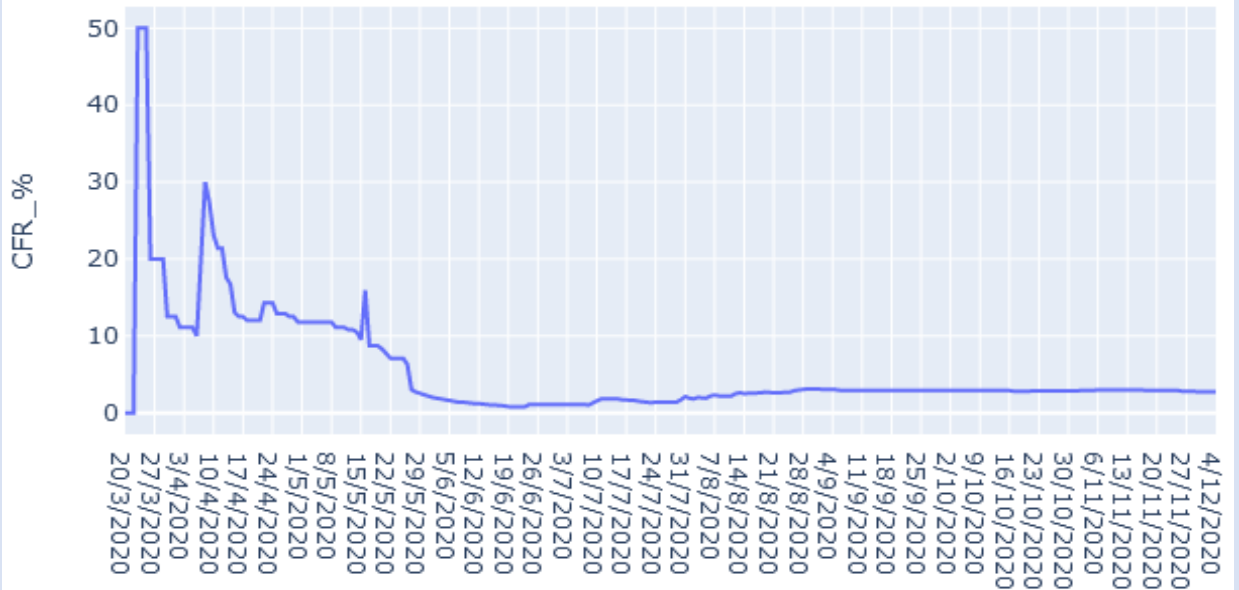

## Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate



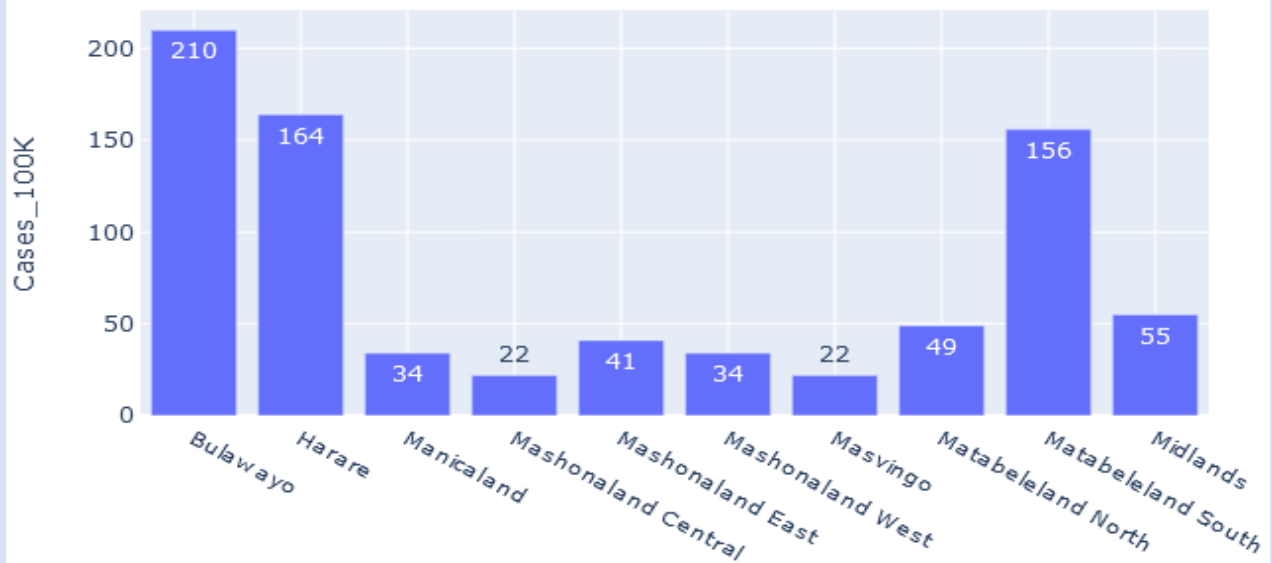

- National Case fatality Rate now stands at **2.7 %** as at 04/12/20

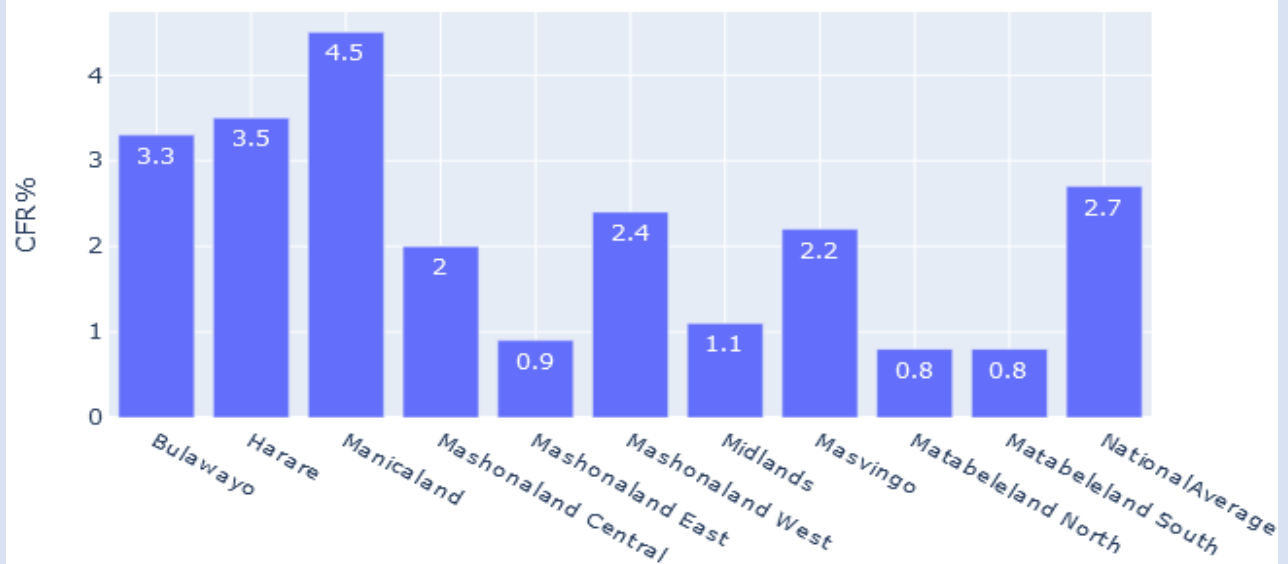

### Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province



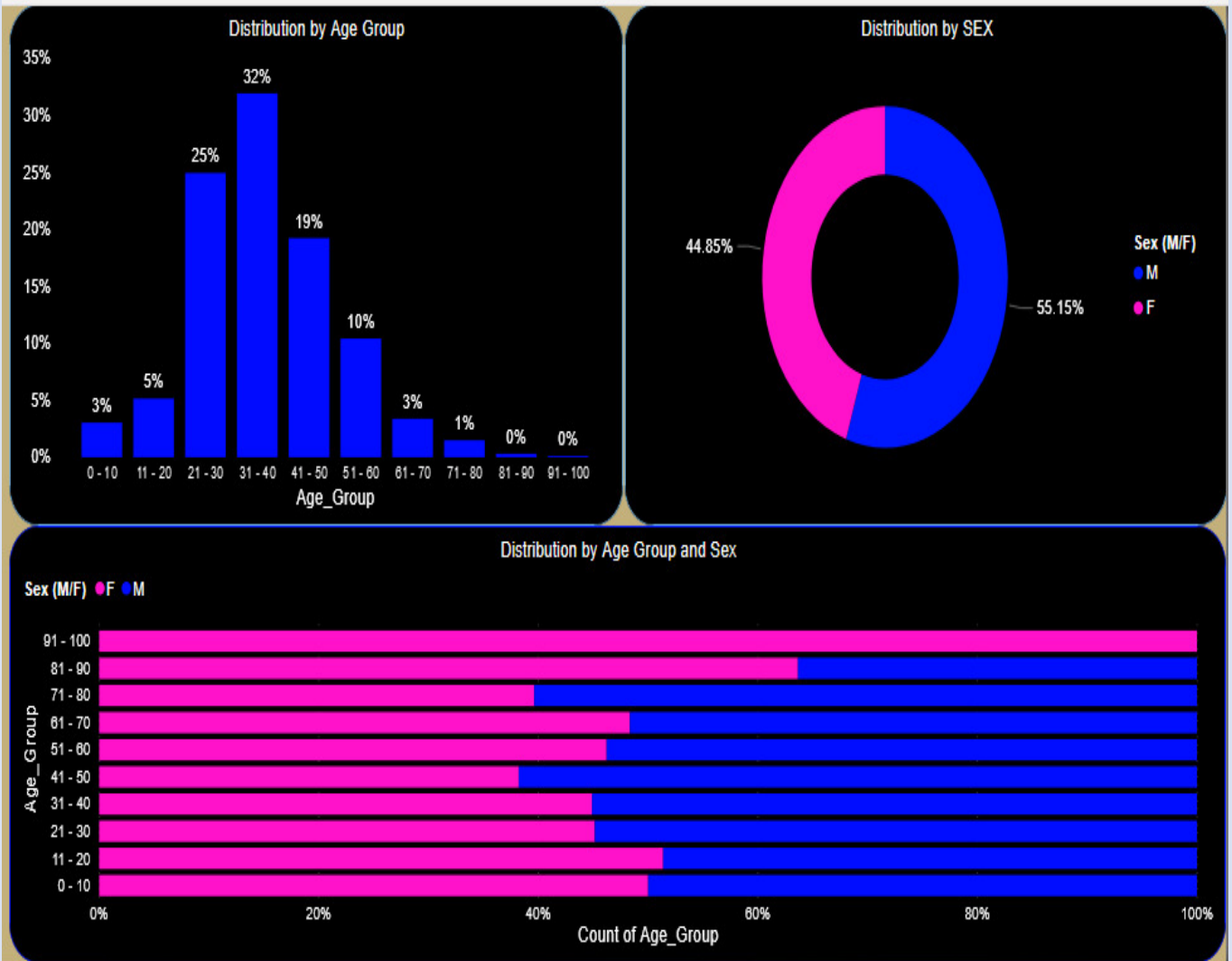
## COMMENTS

### Age and Sex Distribution for Cases



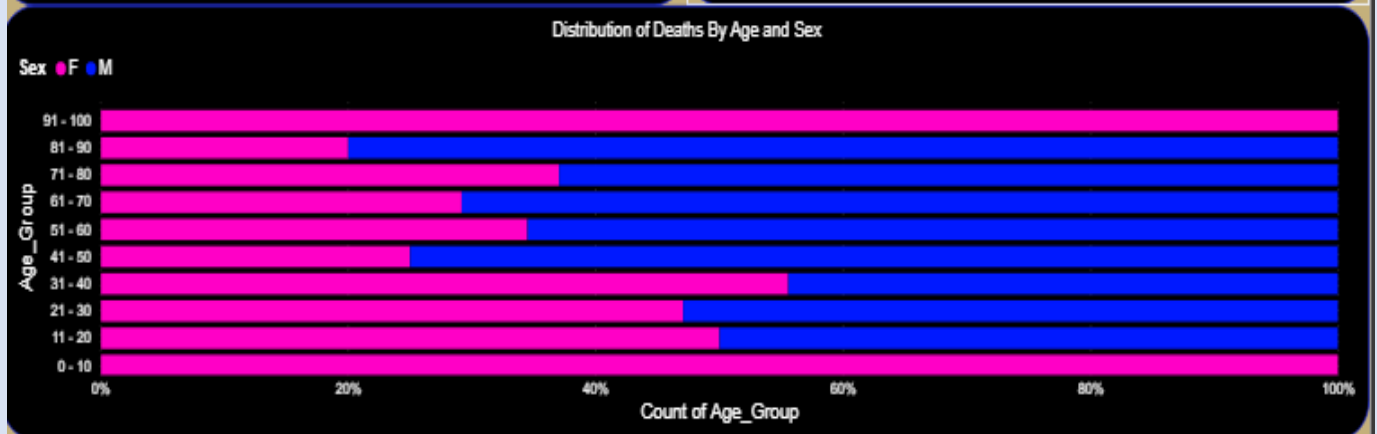
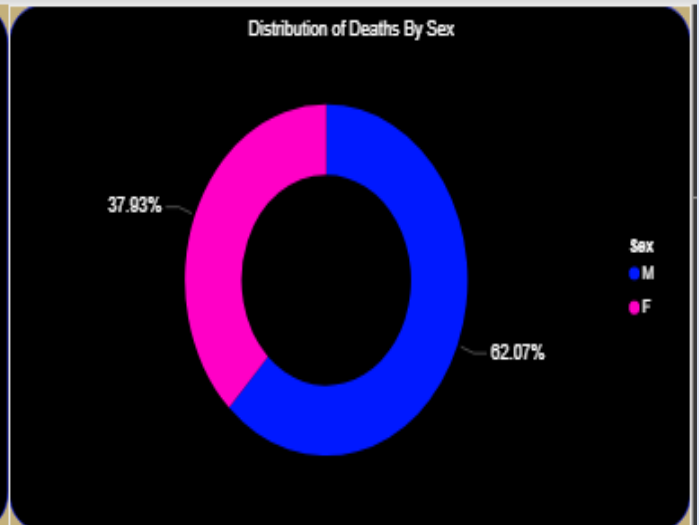
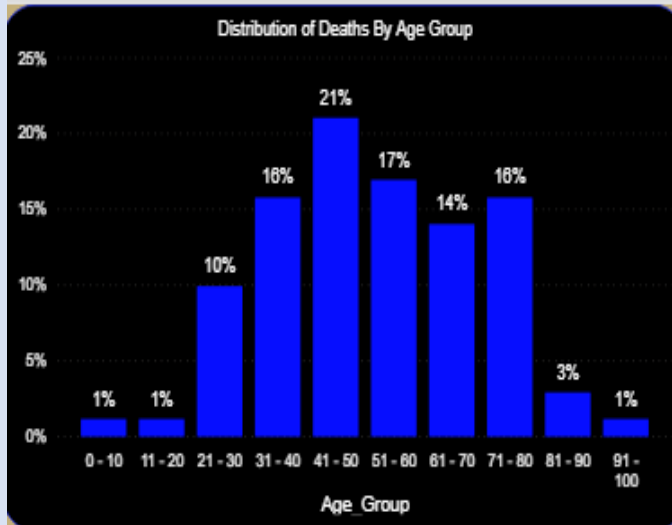
## COMMENTS

- There are more deaths from males as age rises

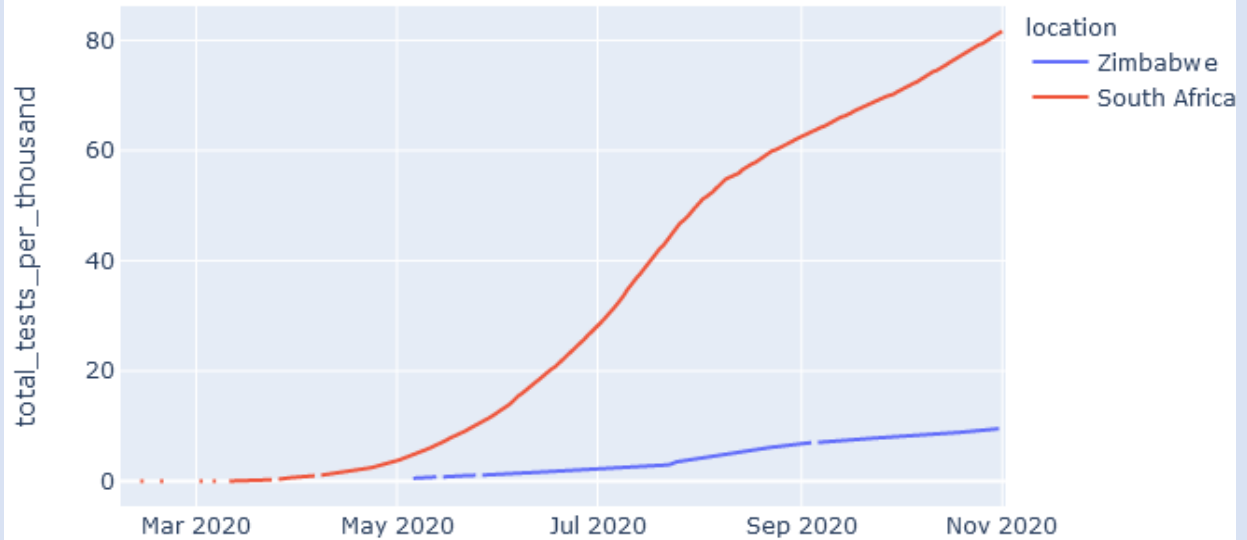

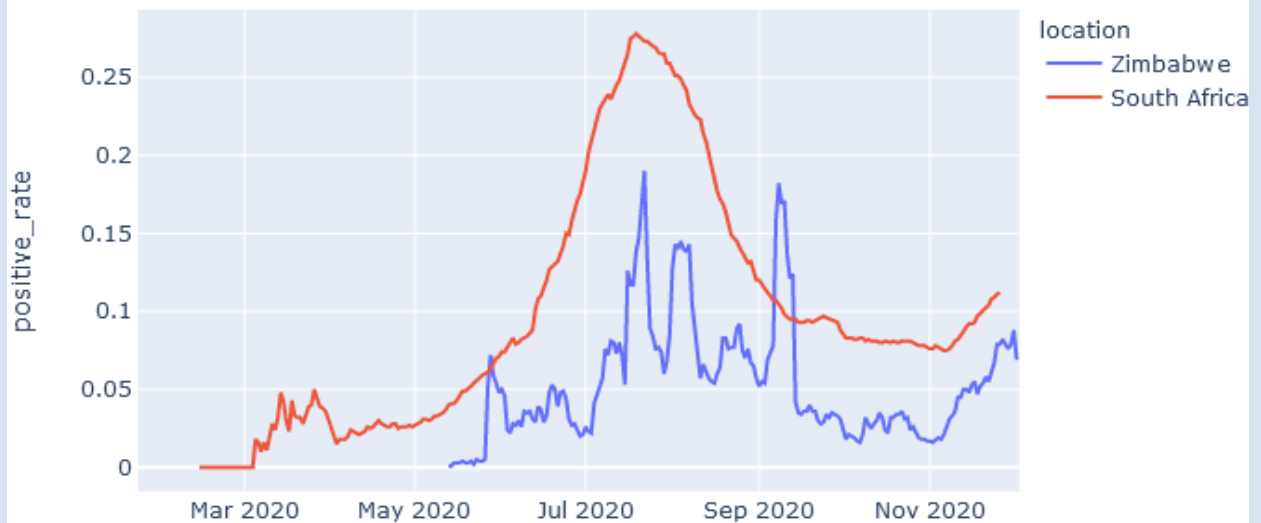

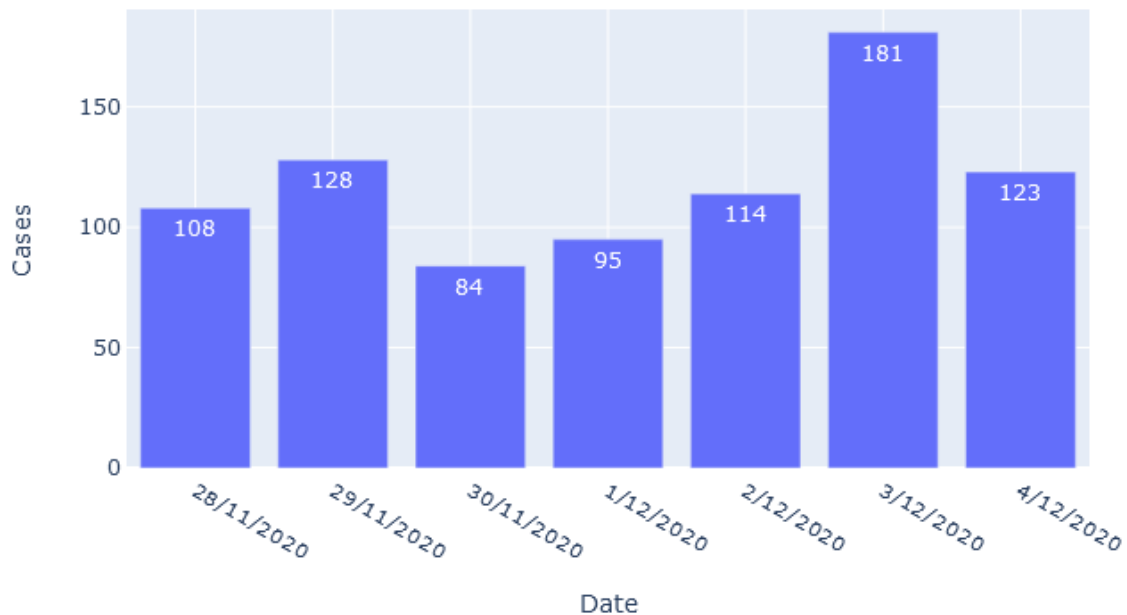

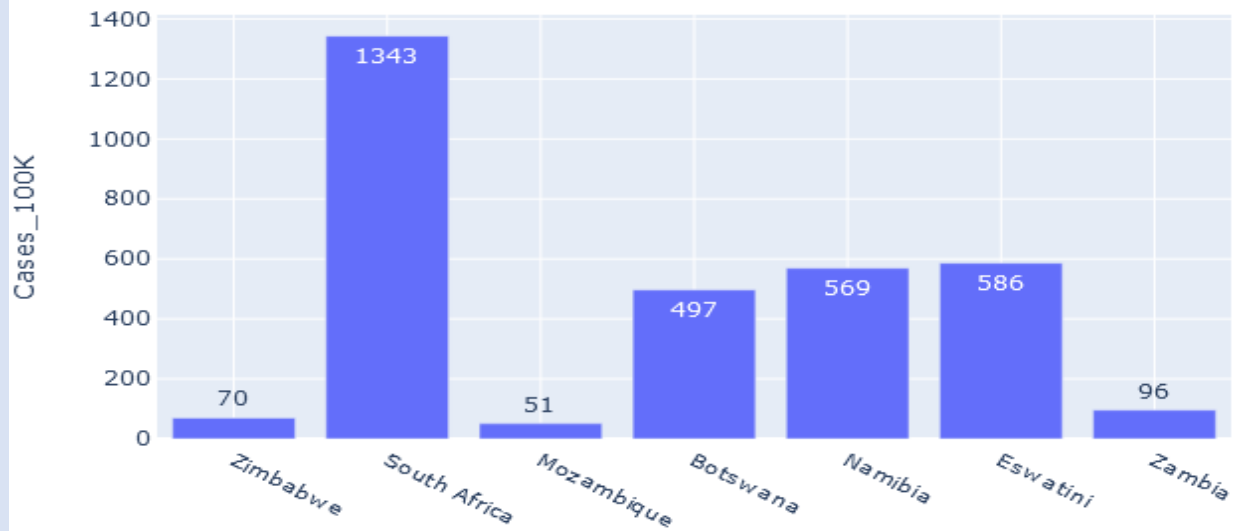

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cases In Last Seven Days

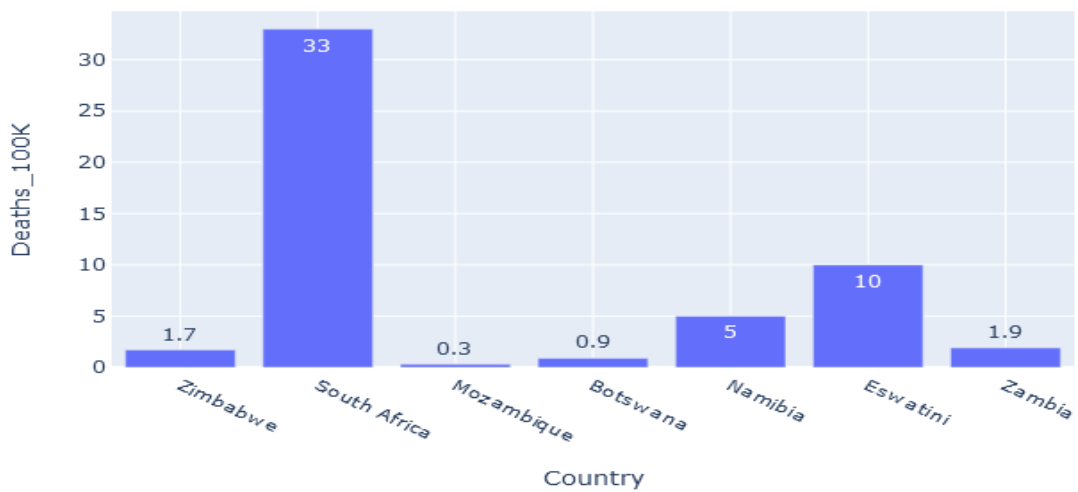




### SADC Covid Cases Per 100K Population
