

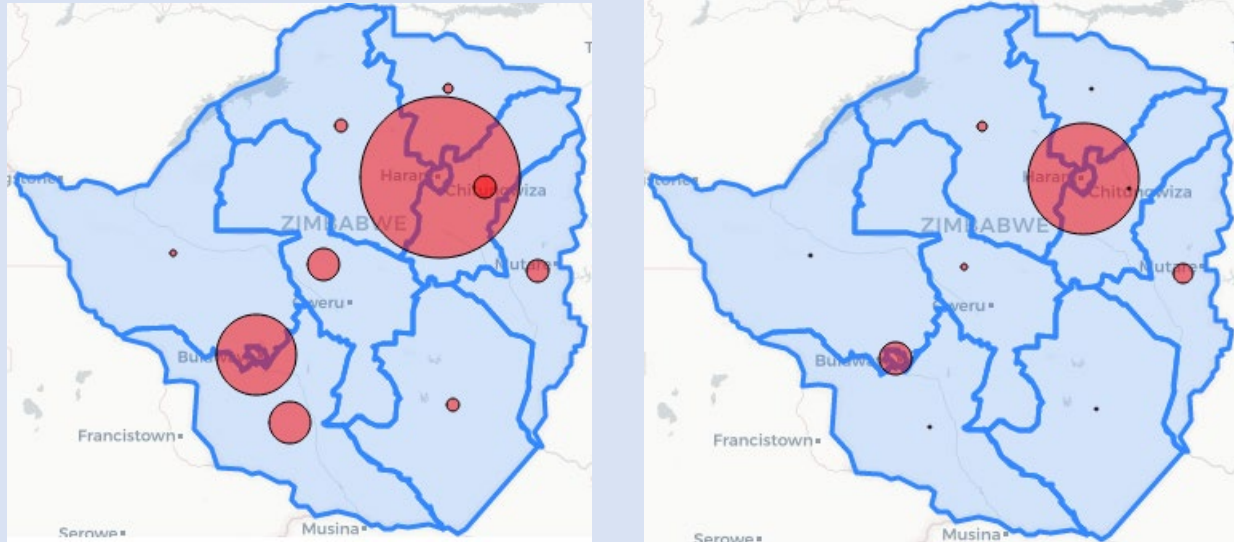


Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 14/12/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- **112** New Cases and **2** Deaths reported in the last 24 hours . (7 day rolling average* for new cases falls to **74** from **75** yesterday).
- **1626** PCR tests done today (Positivity today was **6.9%**)
- All **112** are local cases
- **103** new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at **84.1%** and Active cases go up to **1495** today
- As of 14 December, Zimbabwe has now recorded **11358** Cases **9554** recoveries and **309** Deaths.

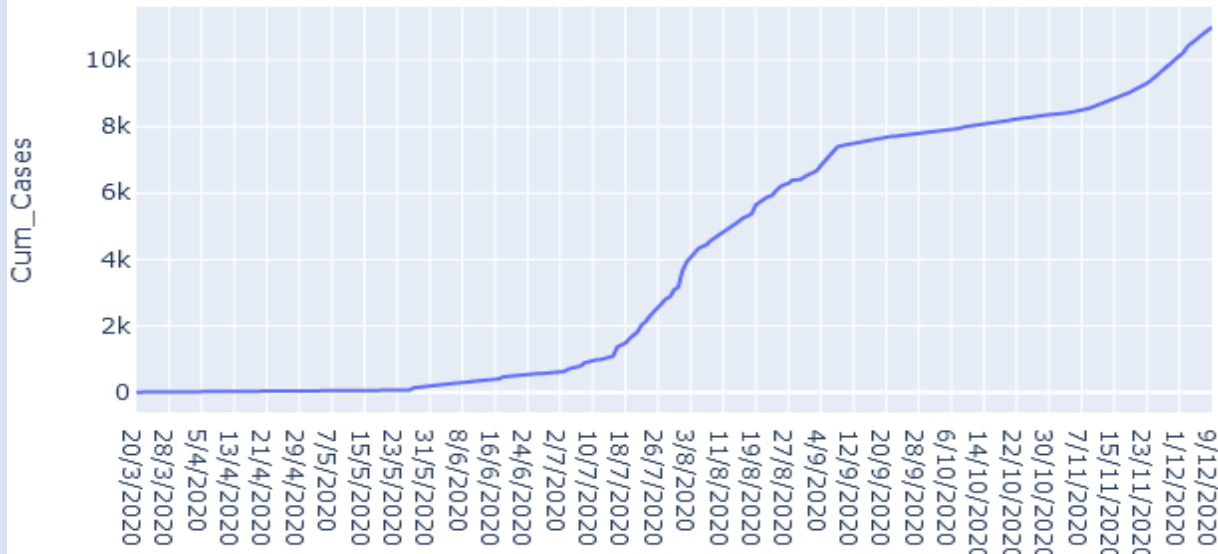

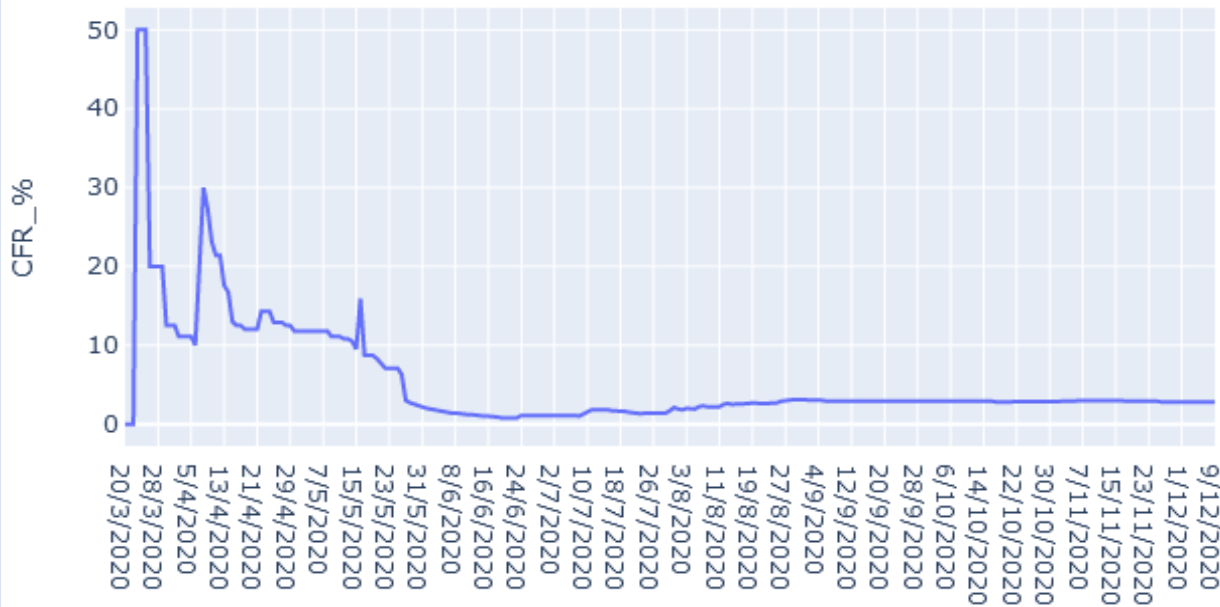

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate



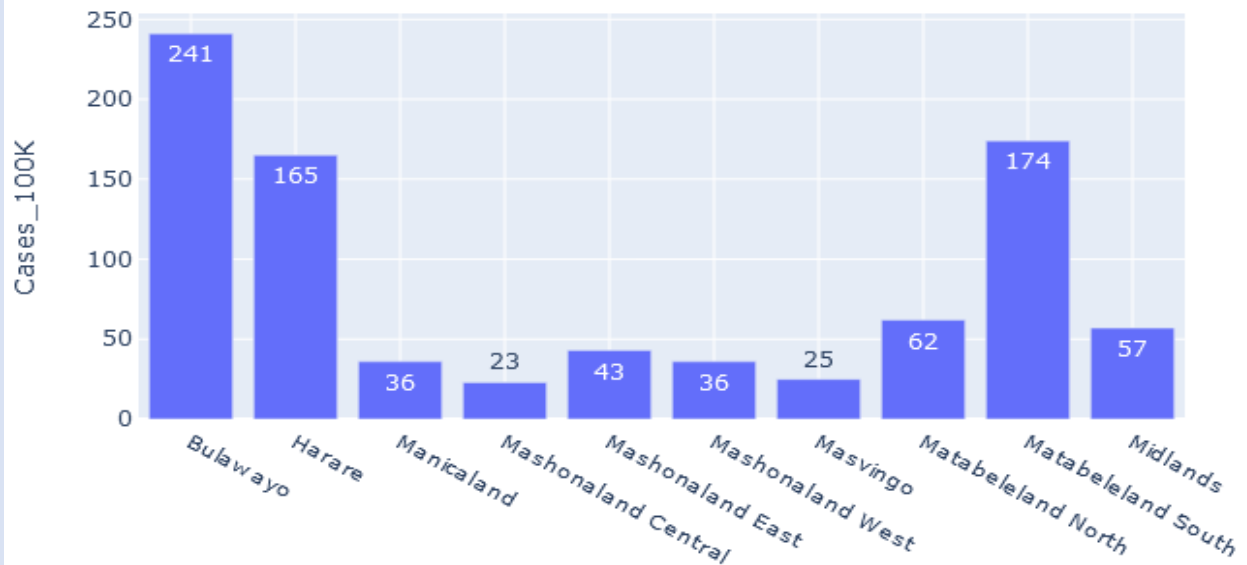
COMMENTS

- National Case fatality Rate now stands at **2.7 %** as at 14/12/20

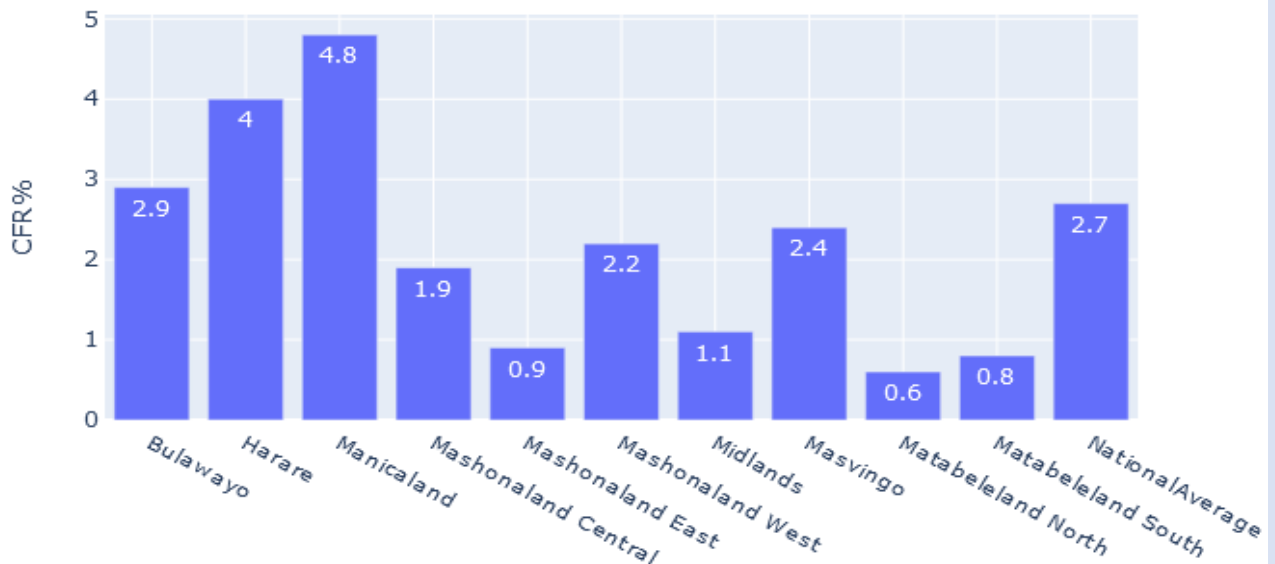

Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province



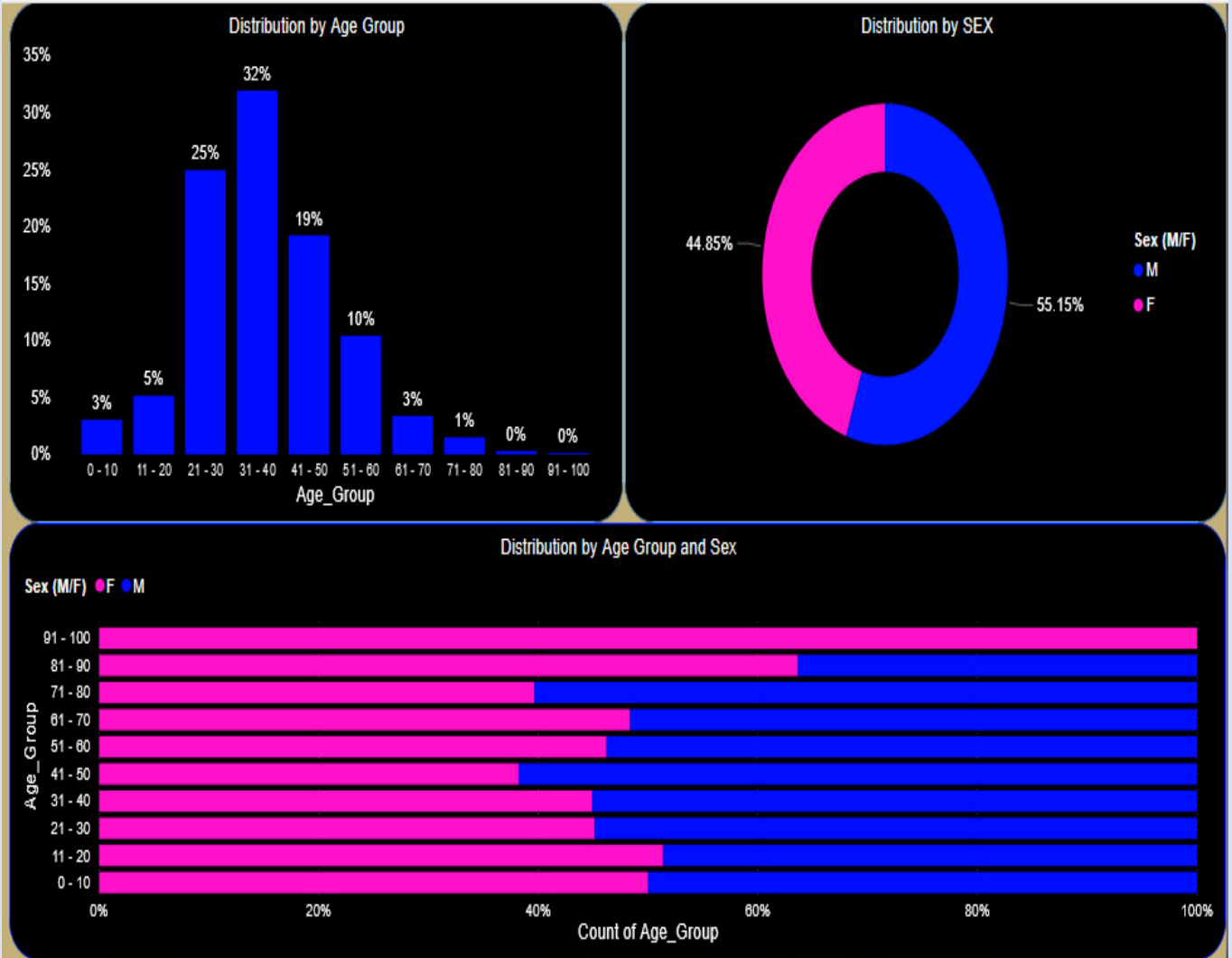
COMMENTS

- Most Covid-19 cases are in the 20 – 40 years age groups(57%)
- There are more females affected as age rises

- Most Deaths are between 40 and 80 years of Age(68%)
- There are more deaths from males as age rises

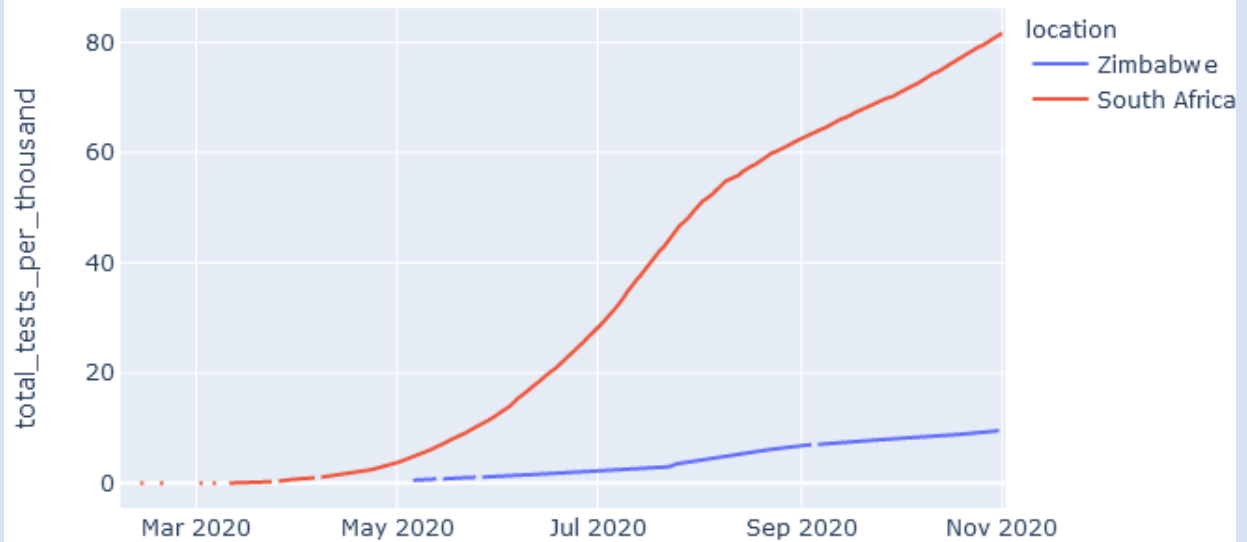

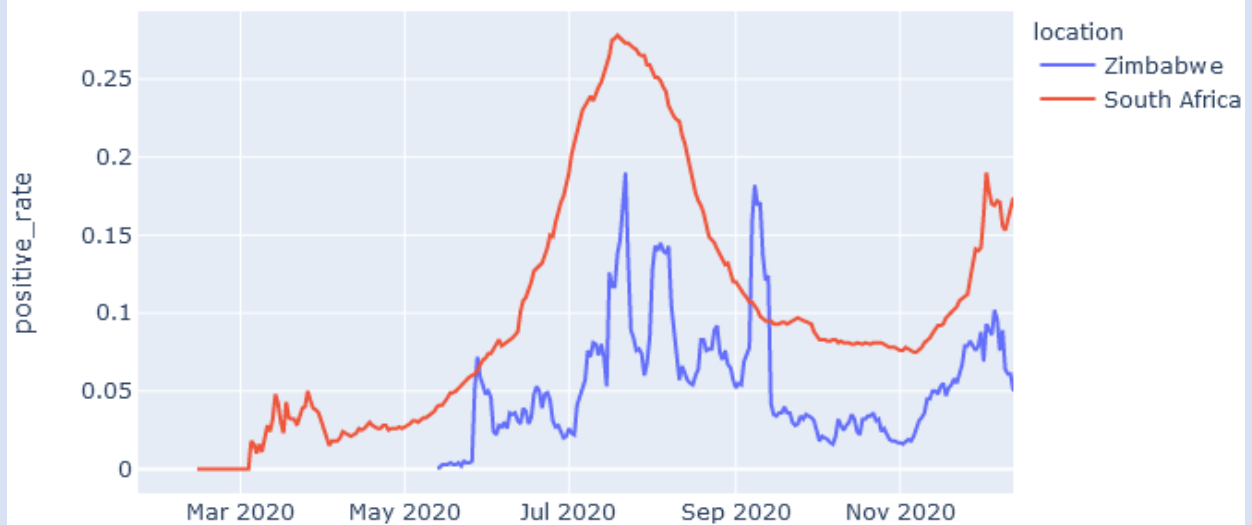

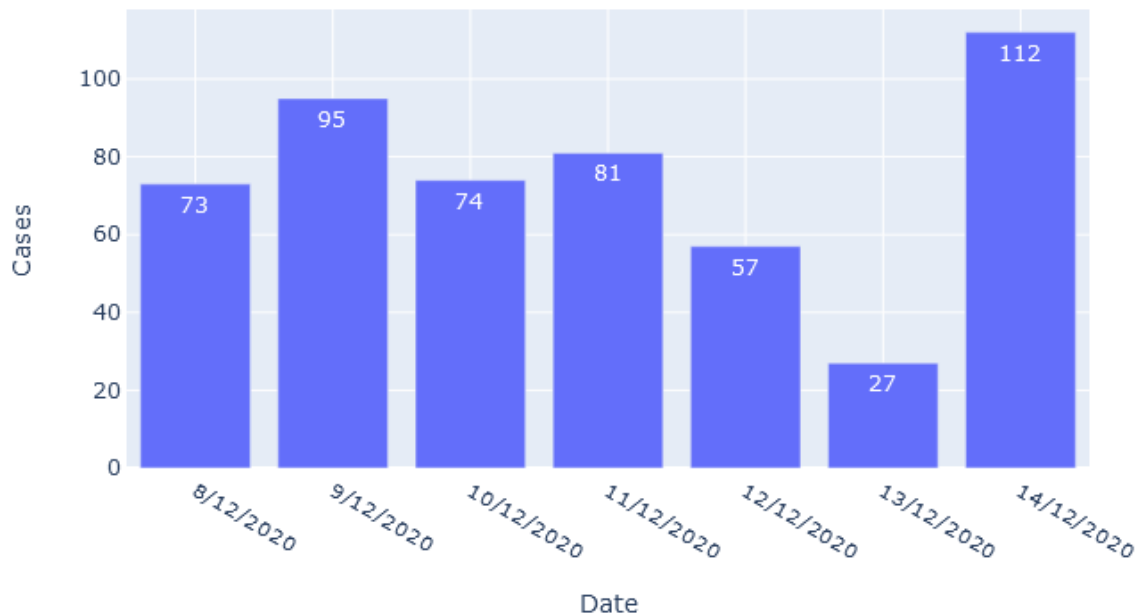

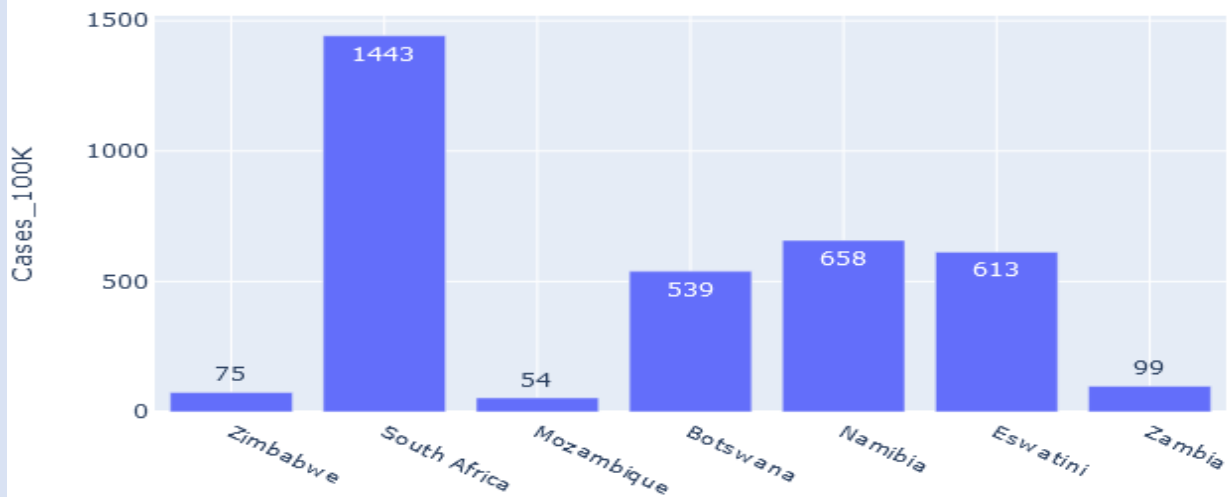

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cases In Last Seven Days

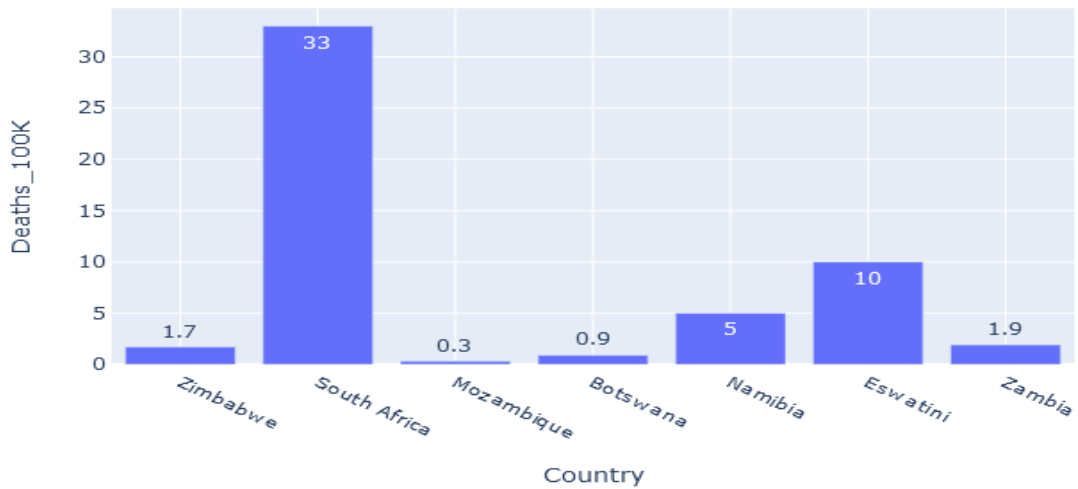




SADC Covid Cases Per 100K Population
