

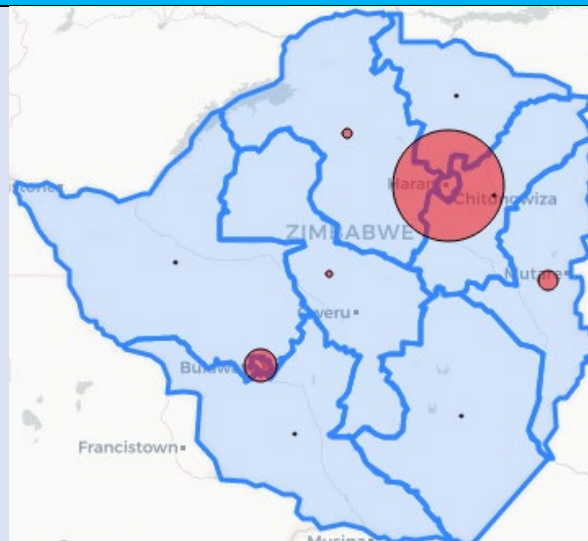
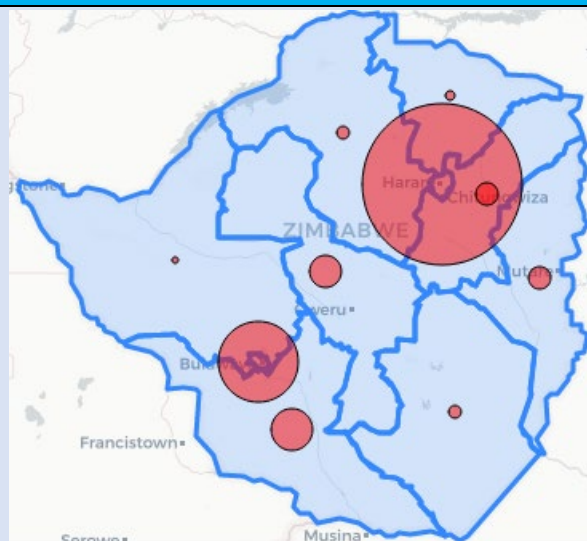


Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 15/12/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- **164** New Cases and **1** Death reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases rises to **87** from **75** yesterday).
- **All Provinces reported cases today, Bulawayo reported the highest (66)**
- **559** PCR tests done today (Positivity today was **29%**)
- All **164** are local cases (Death reported by Harare)
- **45** new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at **83.3%** and Active cases go up to **1613** today
- As of 15 December, Zimbabwe has now recorded **11522** Cases **9599** recoveries and **310** Deaths.

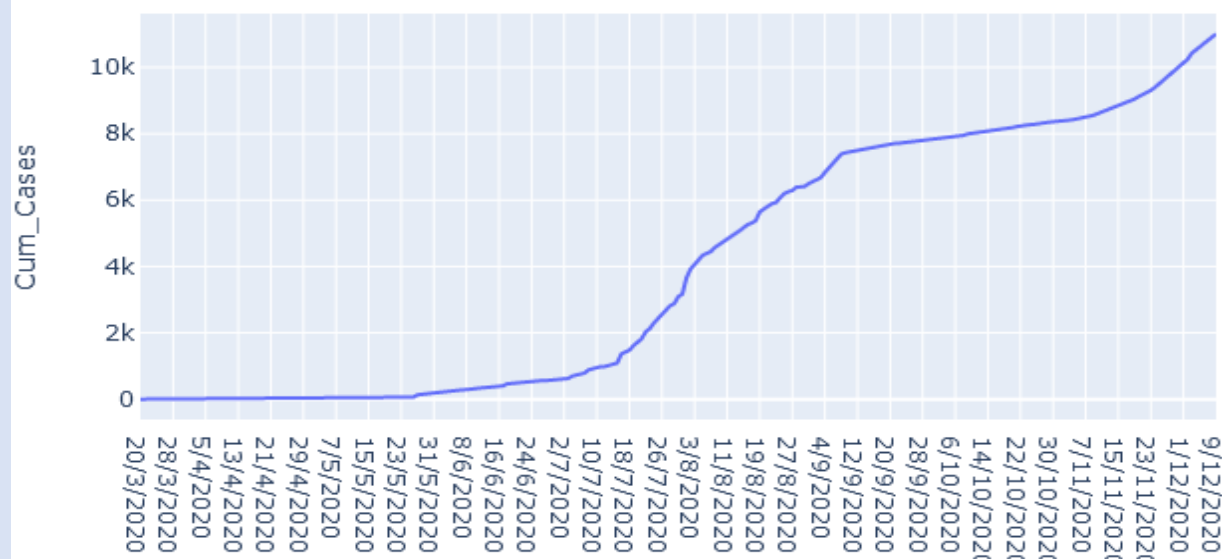

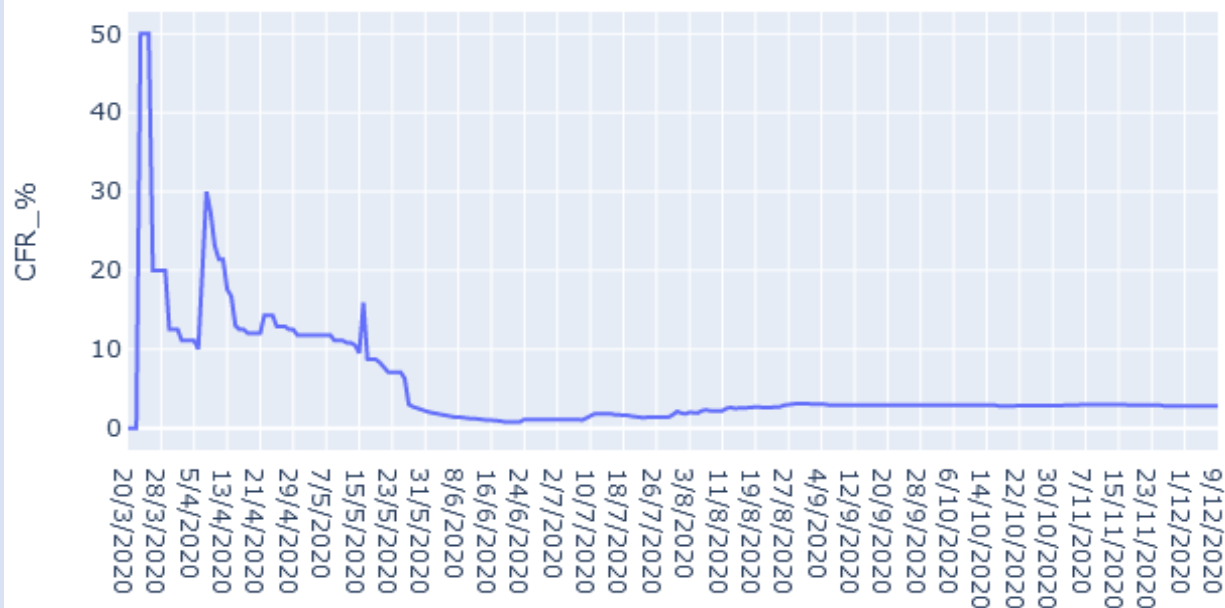

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate



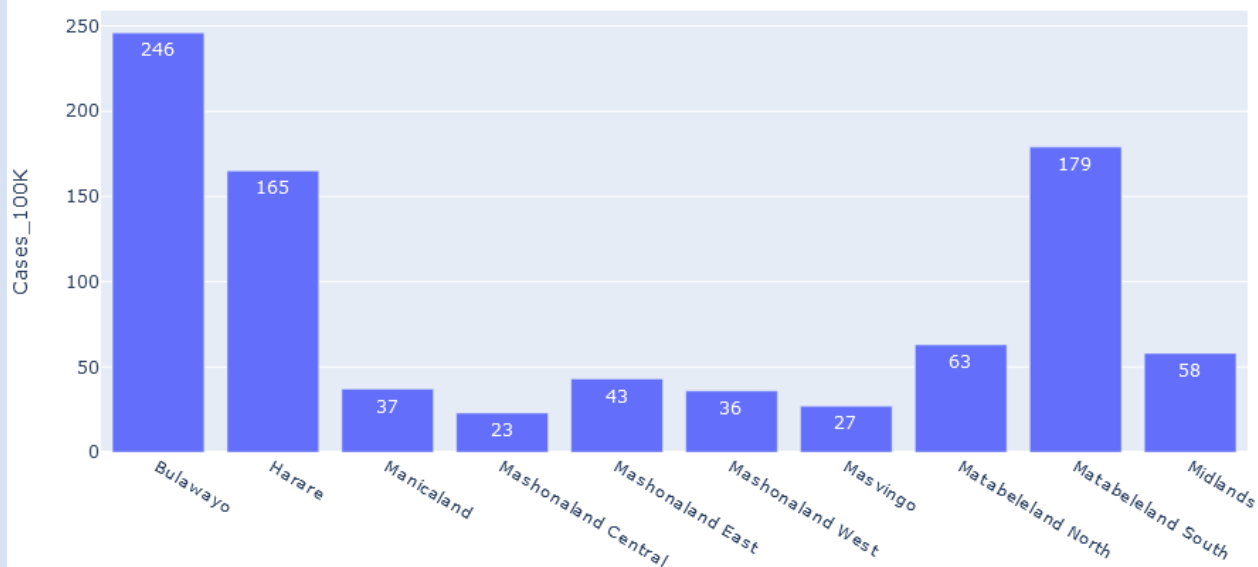

- National Case fatality Rate now stands at **2.7 %** as at 15/12/20

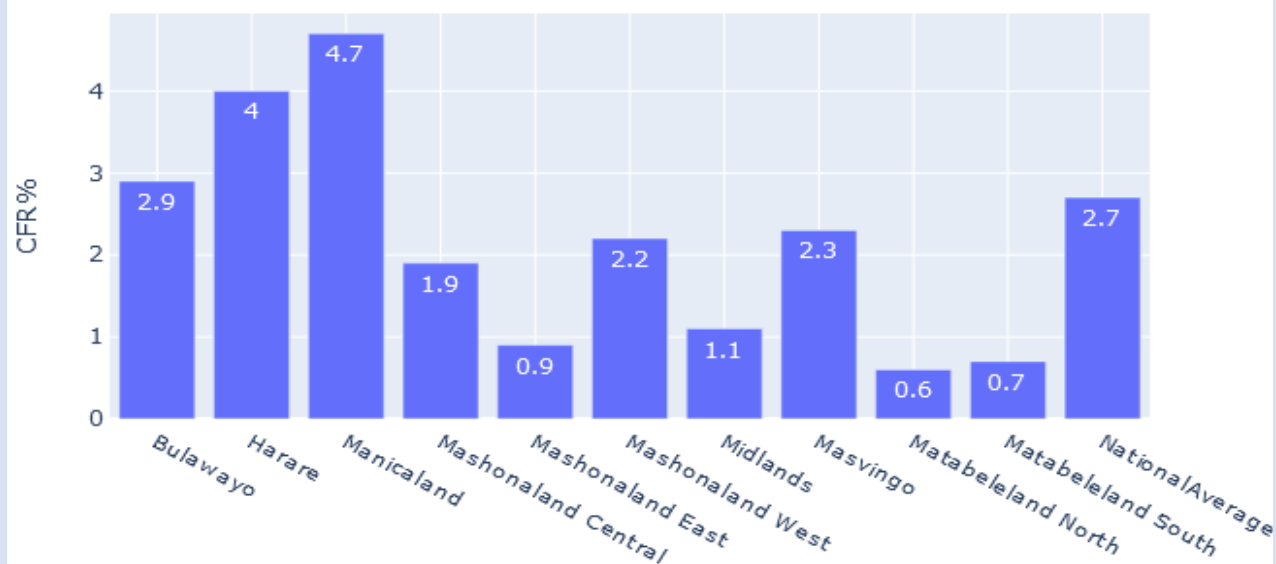

Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province



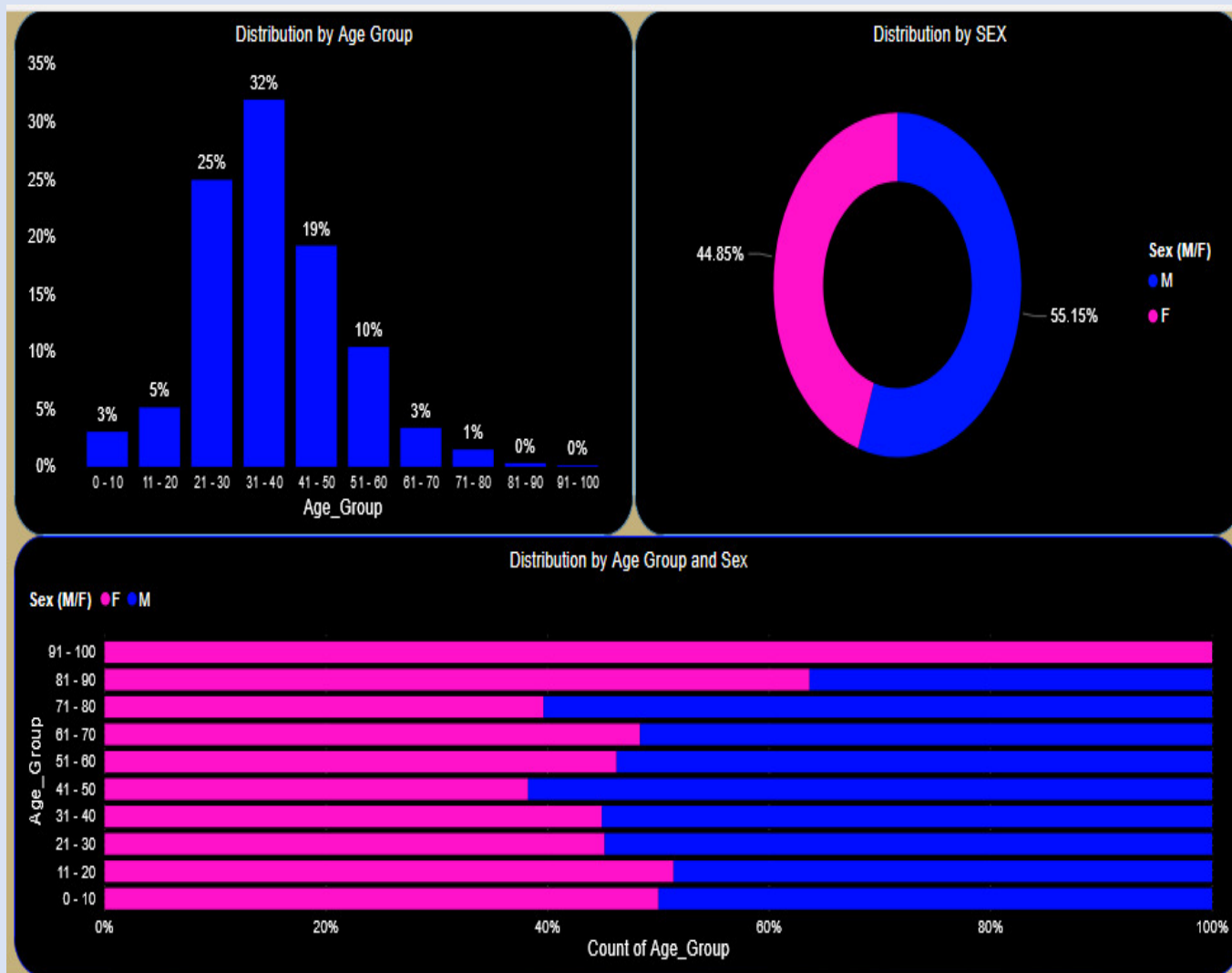
COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases



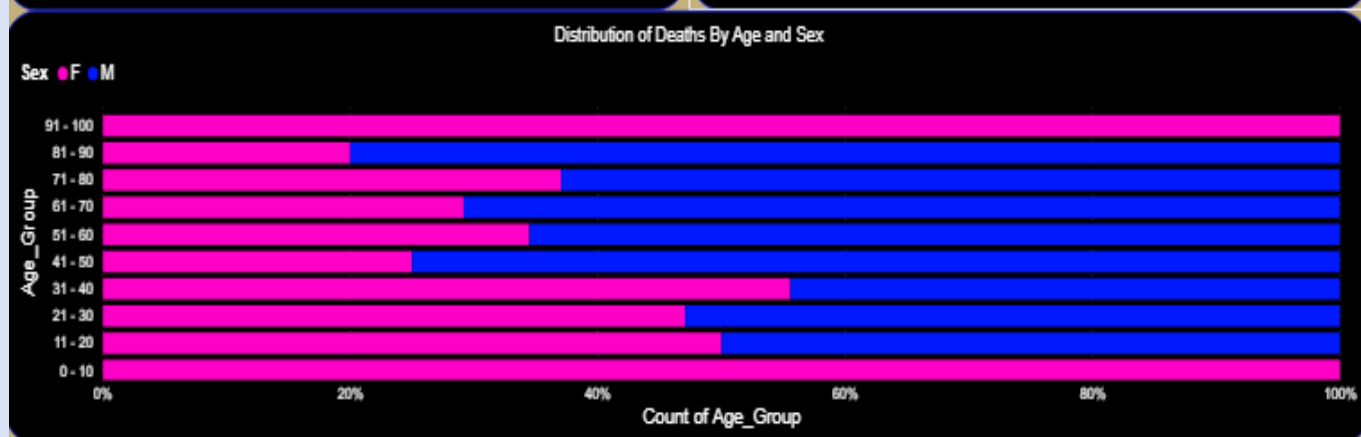
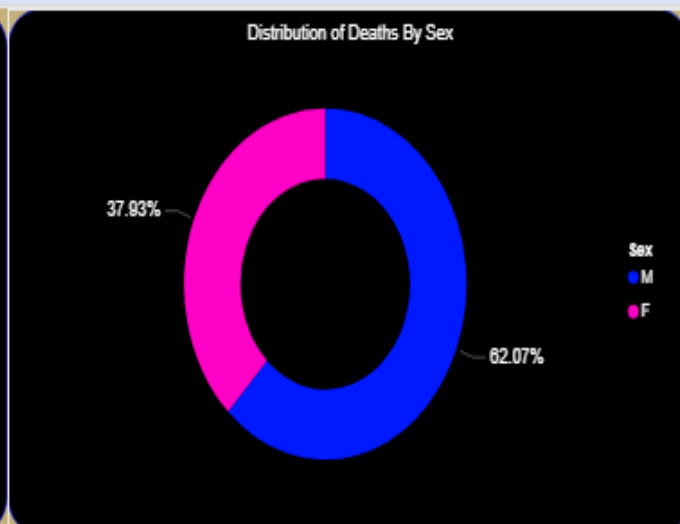
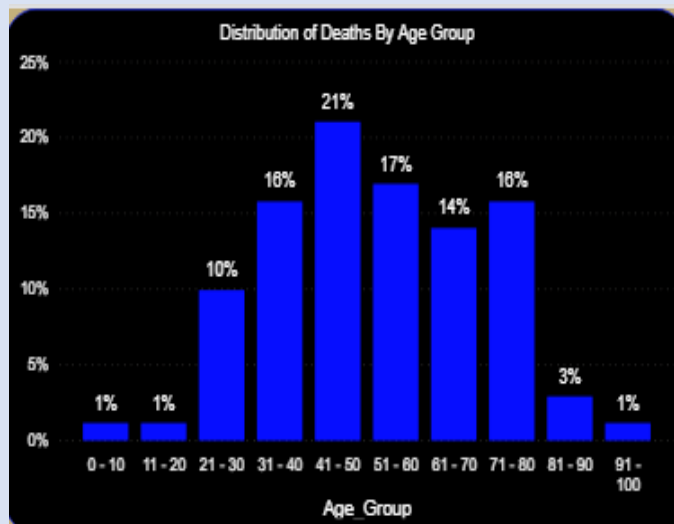
COMMENTS

- There are more deaths from males as age rises

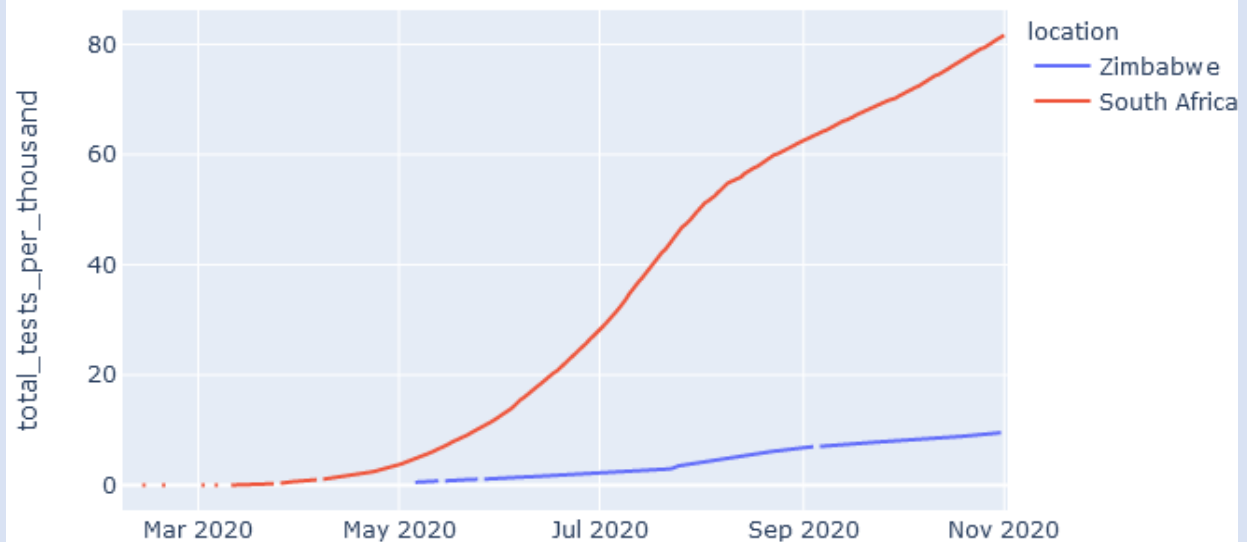

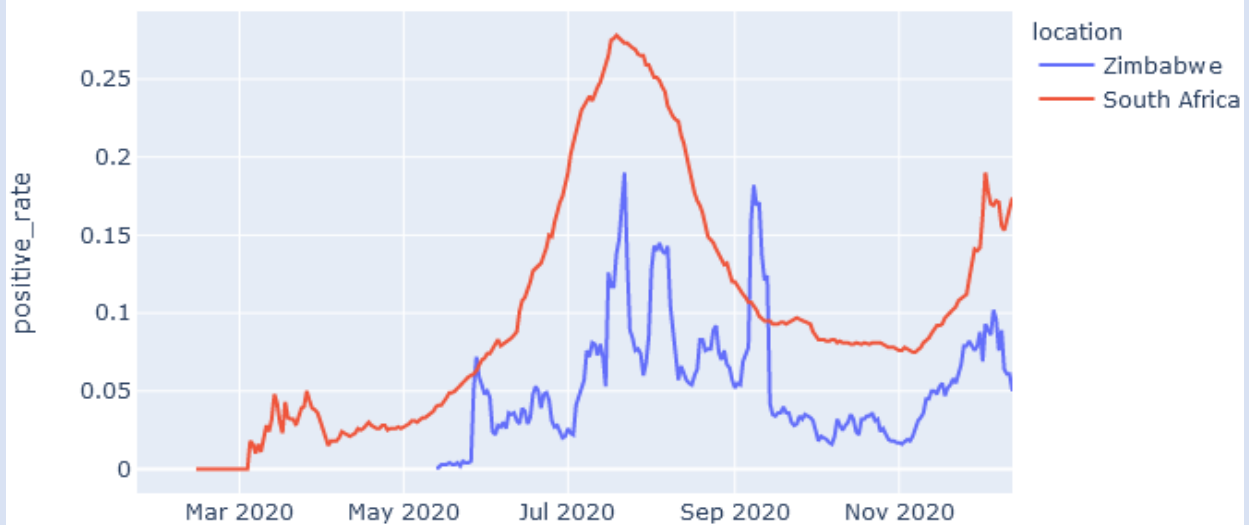

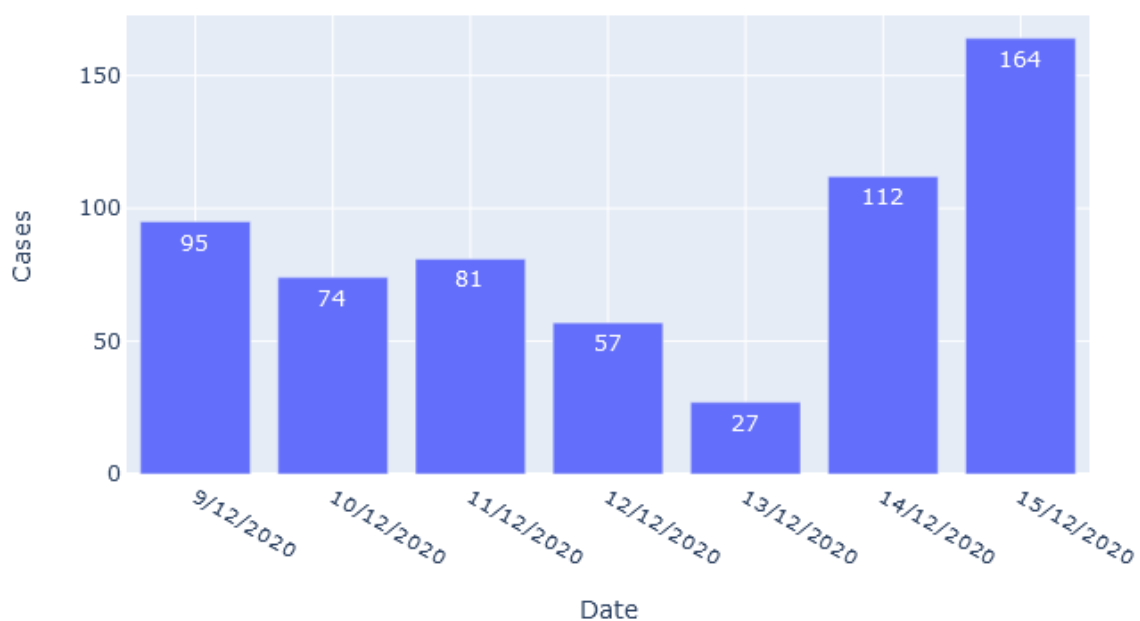

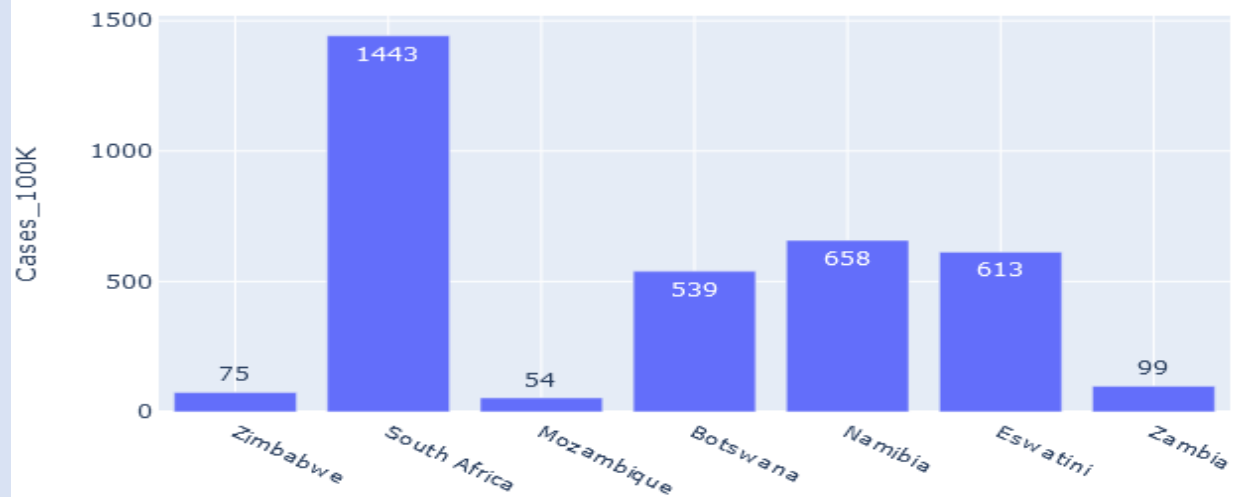

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cases In Last Seven Days

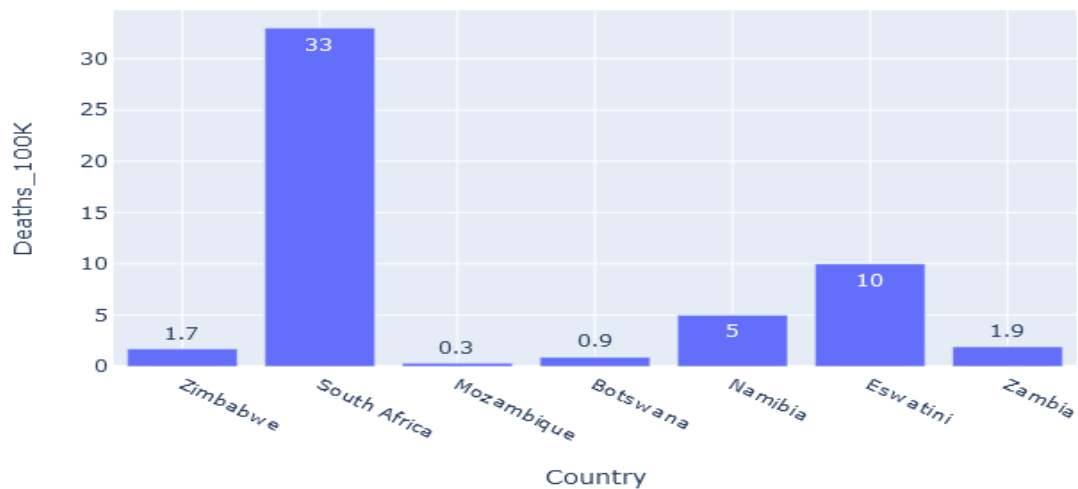




SADC Covid Cases Per 100K Population
