

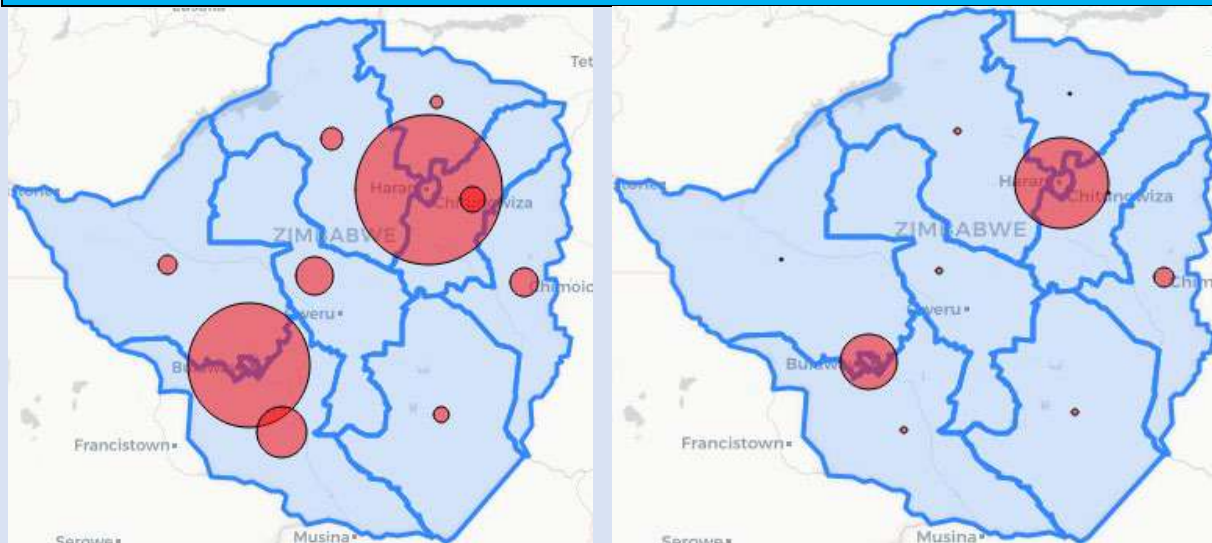


Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 16/12/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- **227** New Cases and **3** Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases rises to **106** from **87** yesterday).
- **All Provinces reported cases today, Mash West reported the highest (101)**
- **1352** PCR tests done today (Positivity today was **16.8%**)
- **All 227** are local cases (Deaths reported by Harare **(1)** and Manicaland**(2)**)
- **103** new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at **82.6%** and Active cases go up to **1734** today
- As of 16 December, Zimbabwe has now recorded **11749** Cases **9702** recoveries and **313** Deaths.

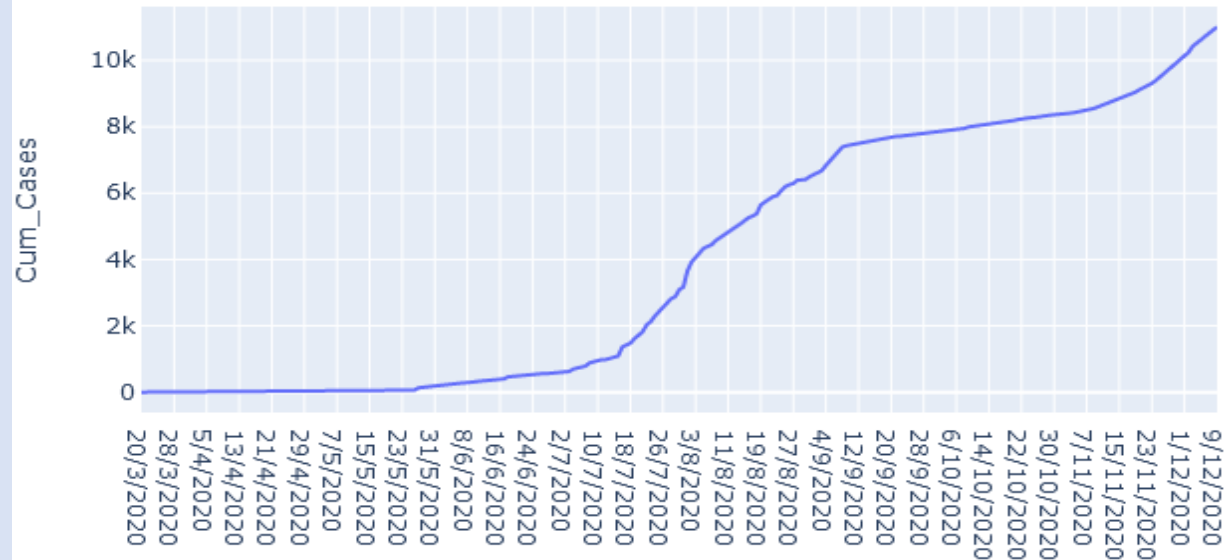

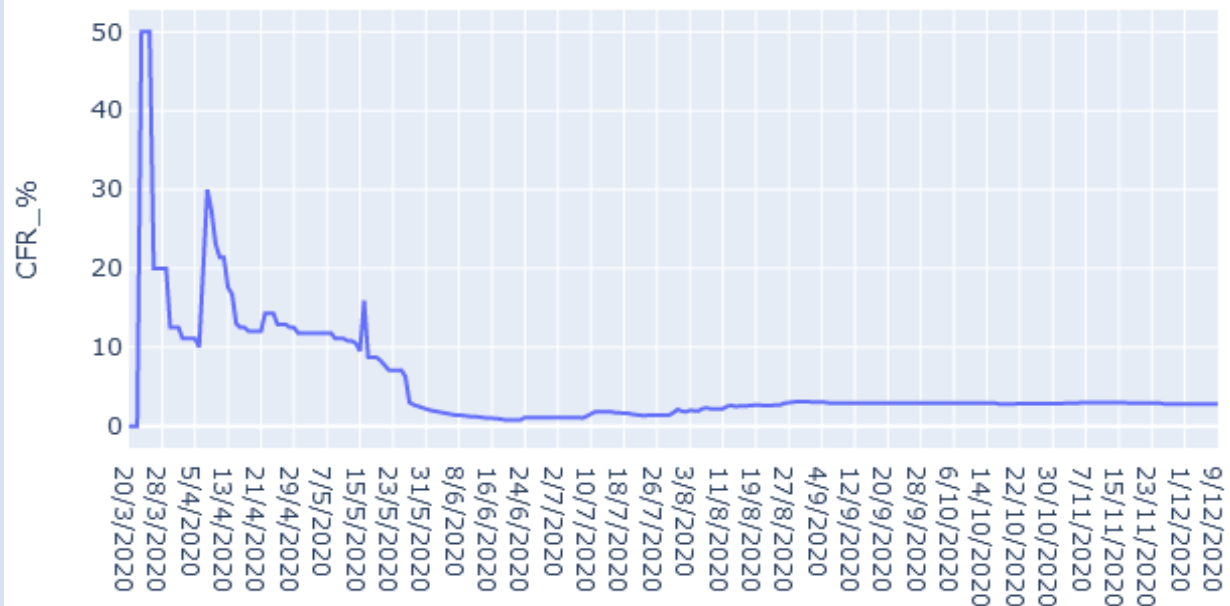

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate



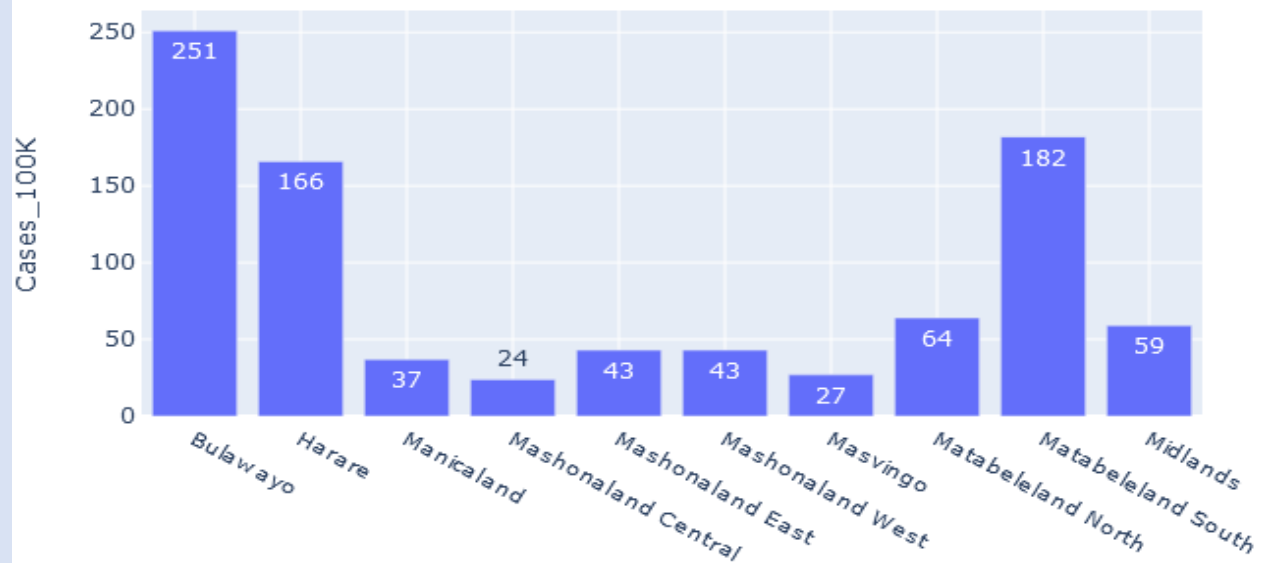
COMMENTS

- National Case fatality Rate now stands at **2.7 %** as at 16/12/20

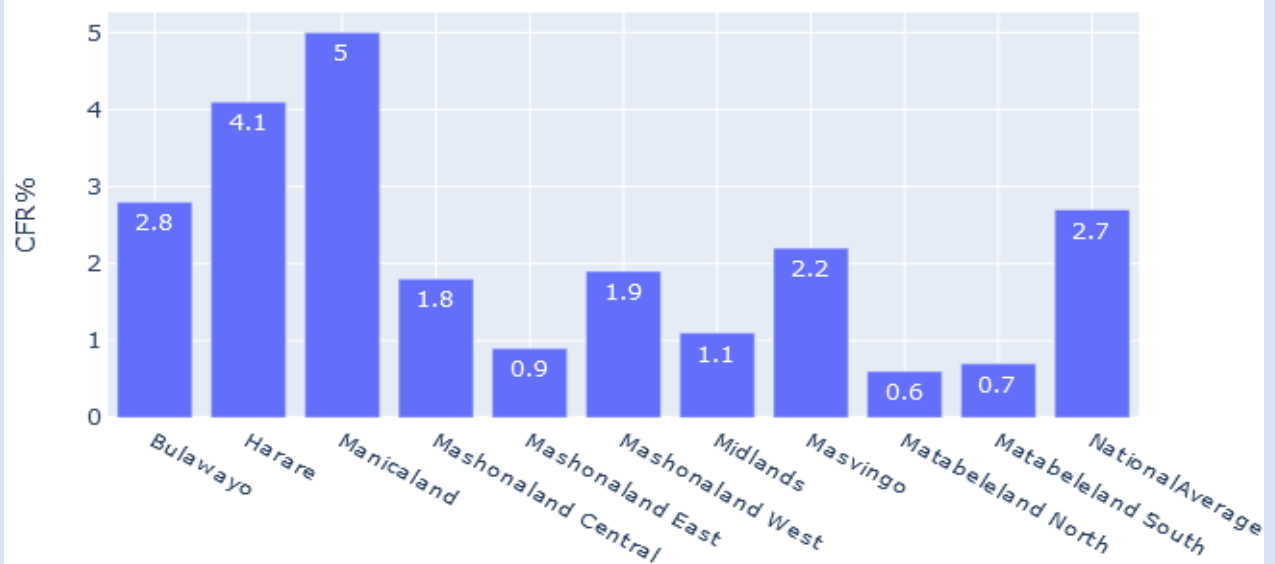

Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province



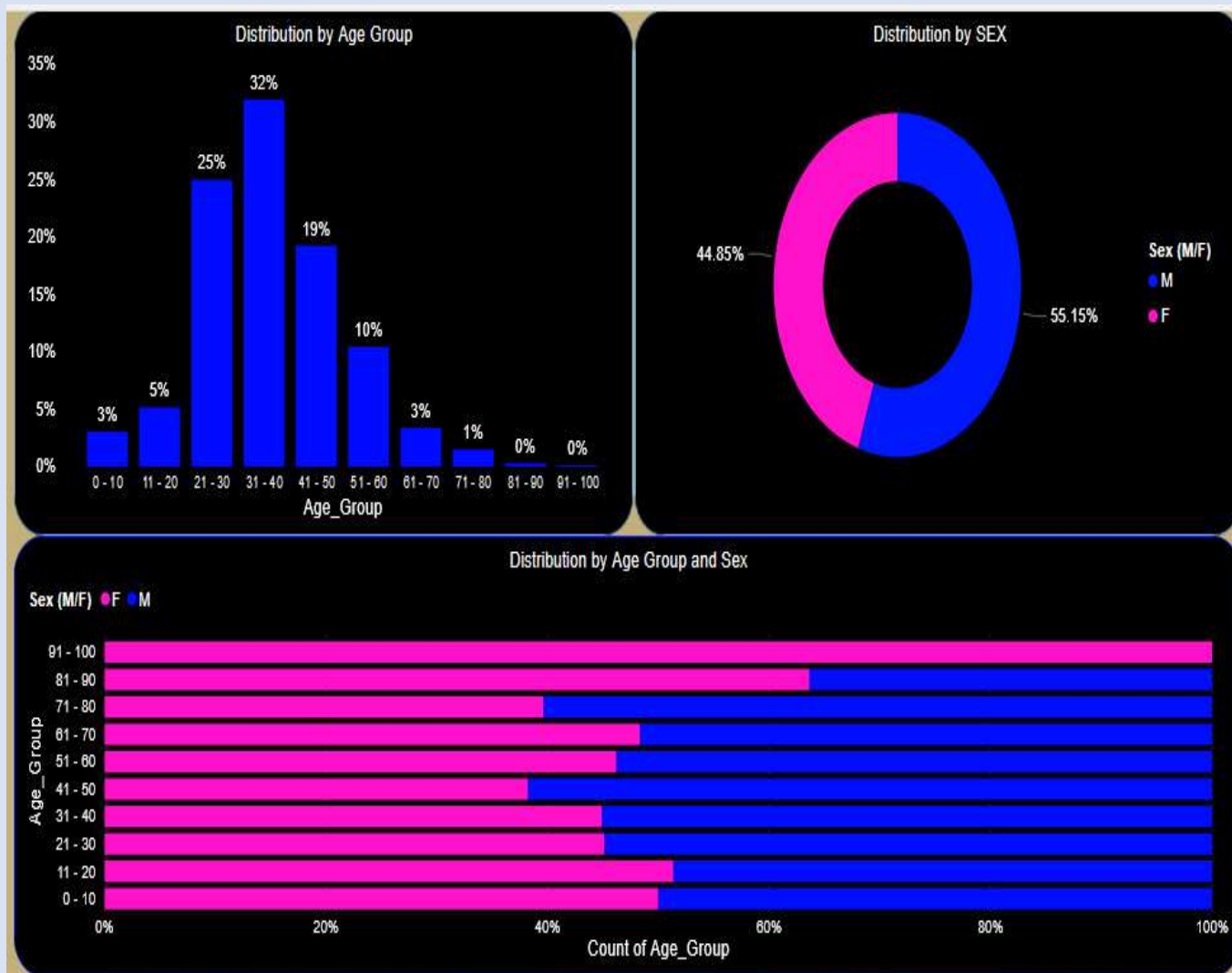
COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases



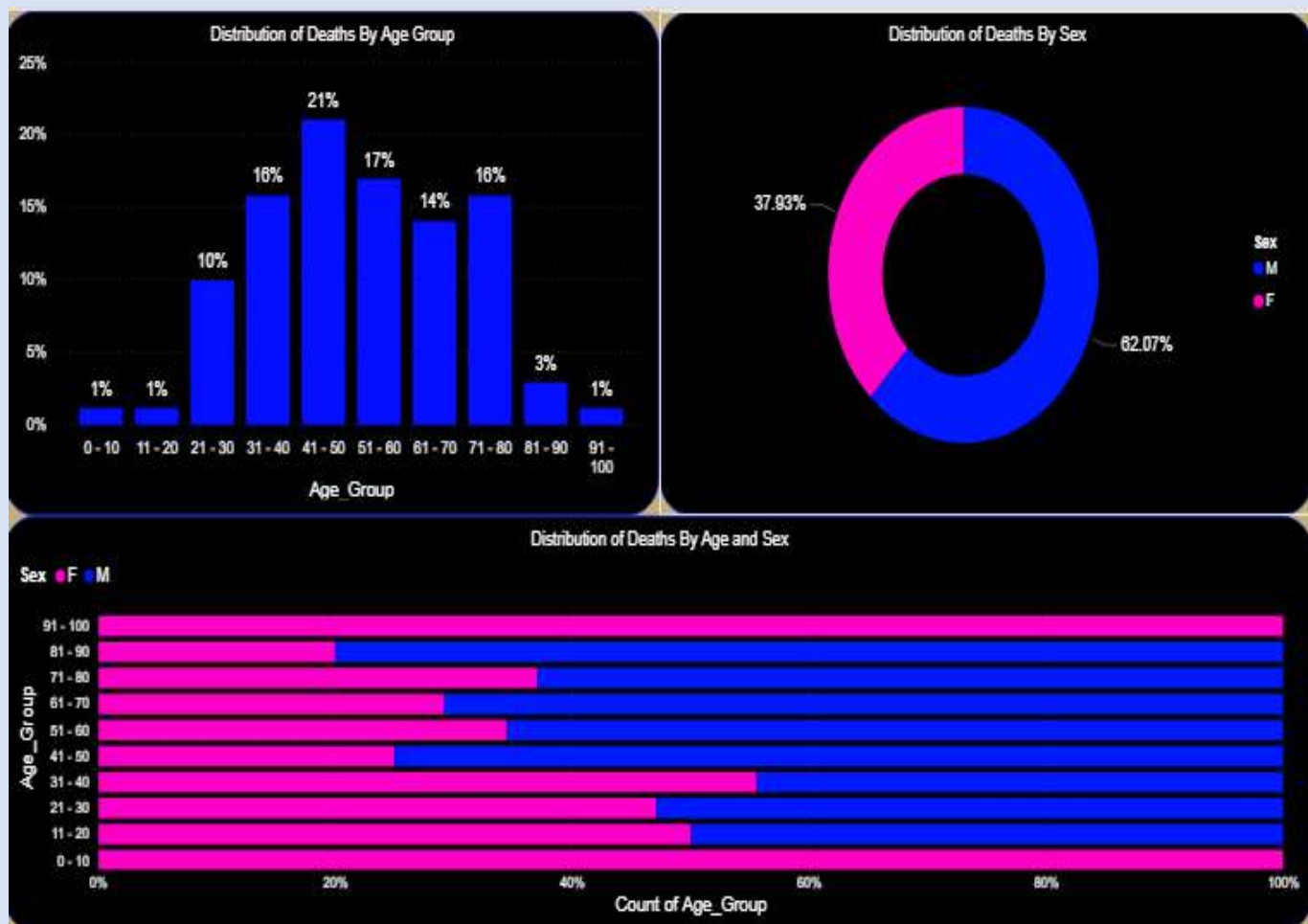
COMMENTS

- There are more deaths from males as age rises

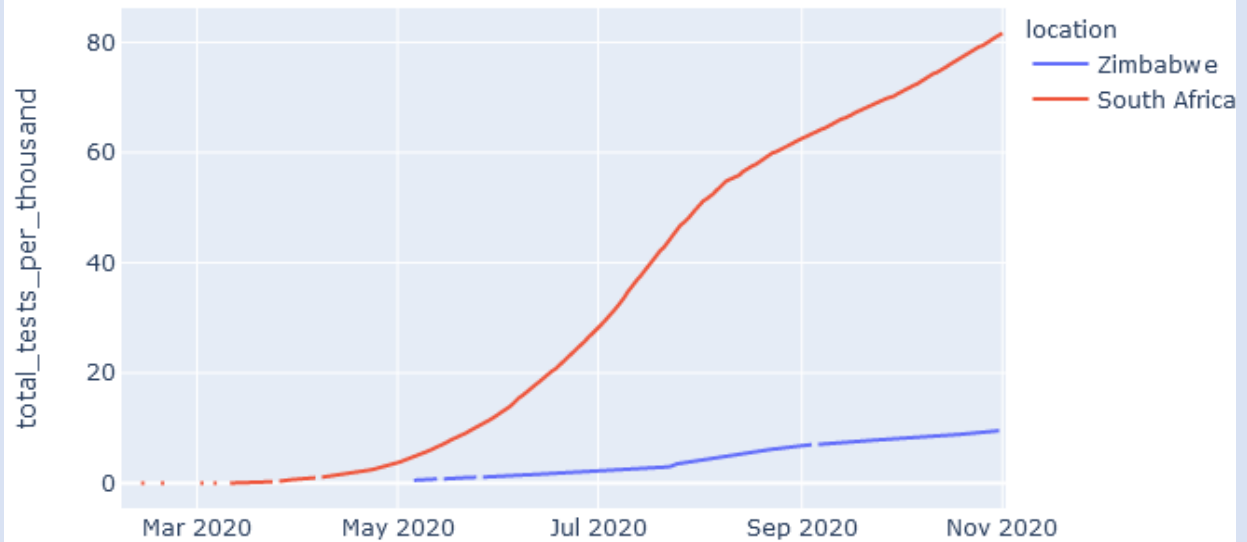

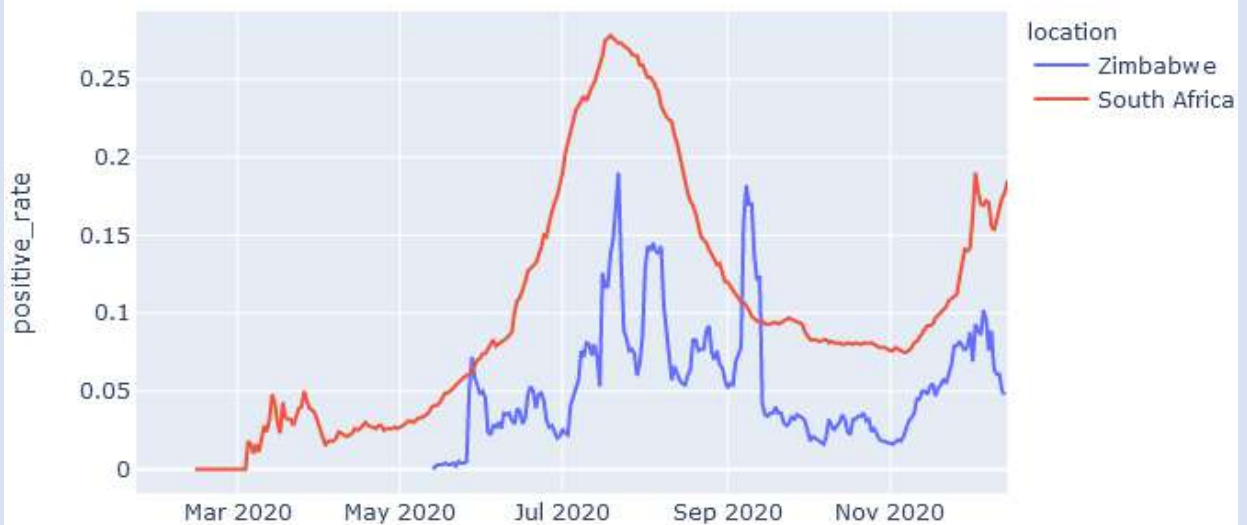

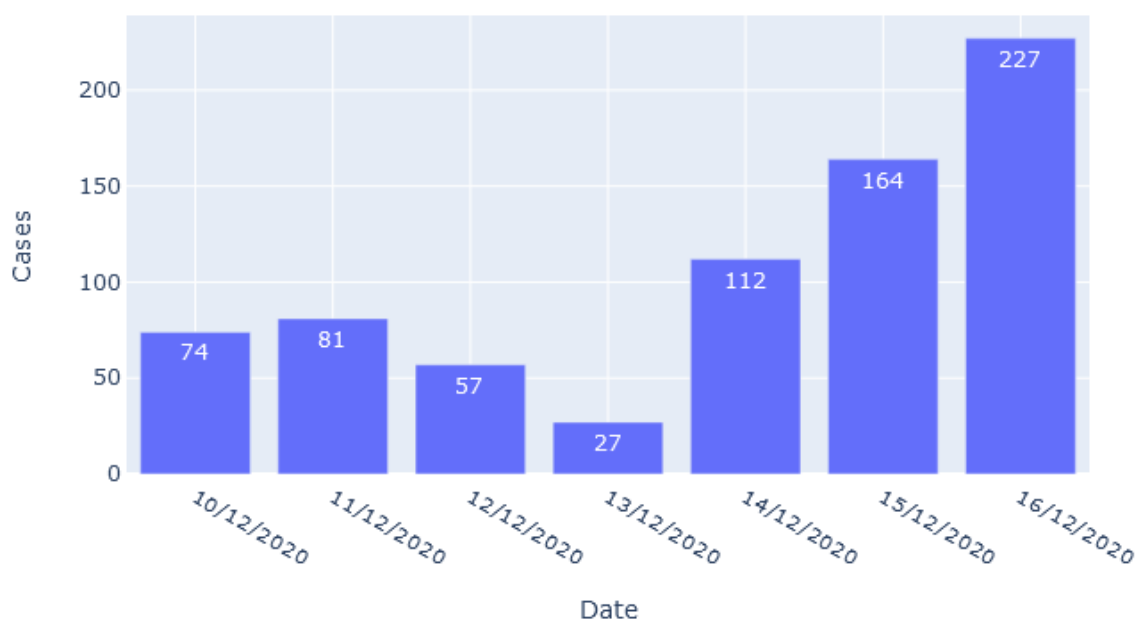

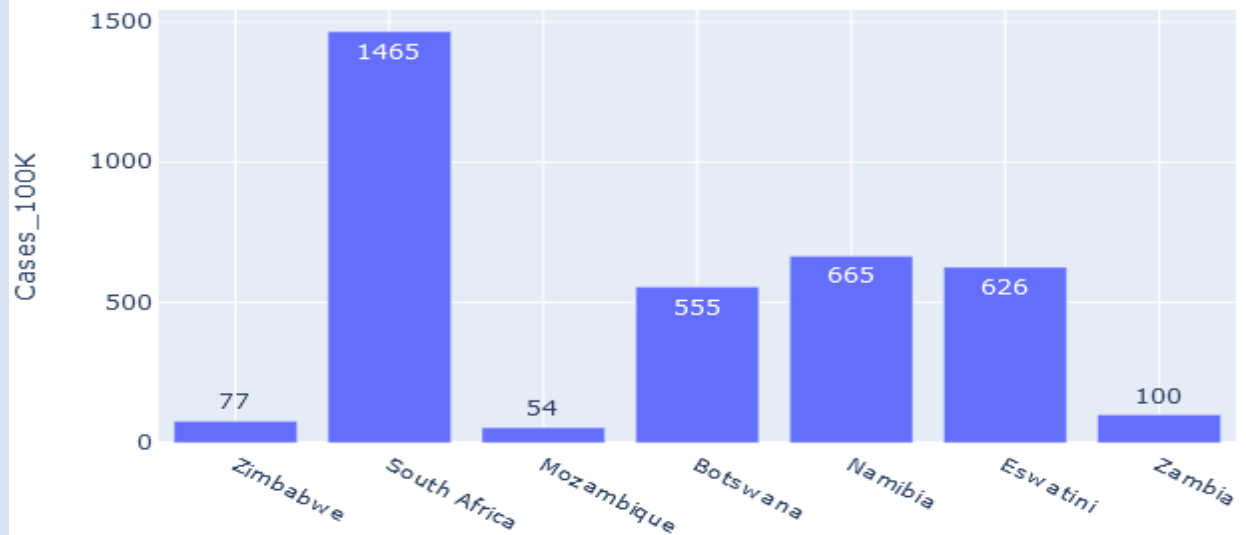

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cases In Last Seven Days

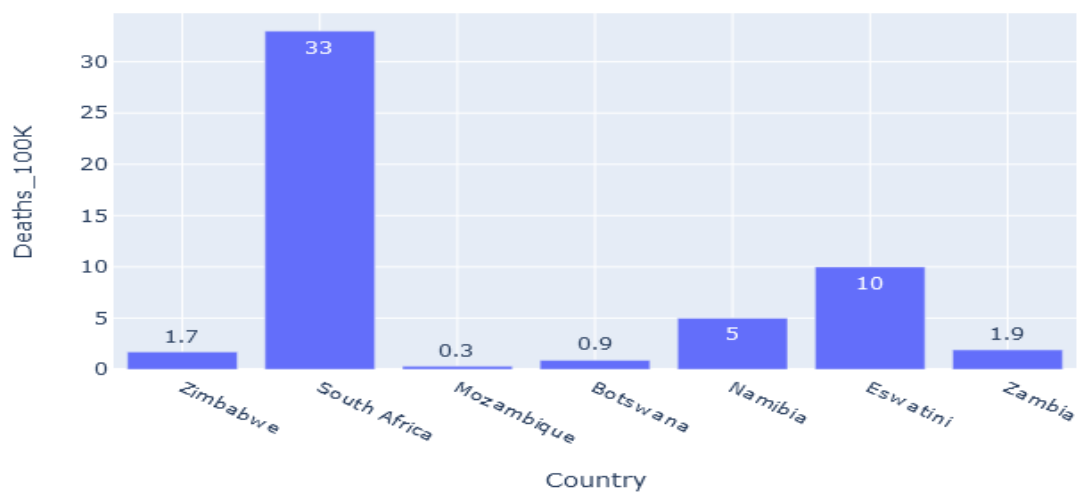




SADC Covid Cases Per 100K Population
