

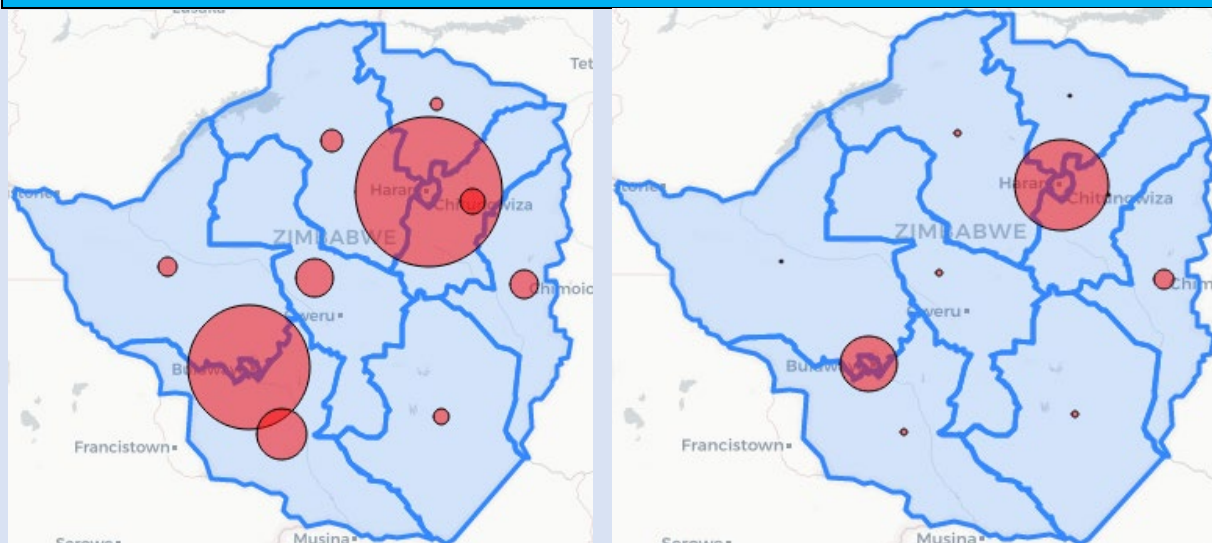


Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 19/12/2020

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- **104** New Cases and **2** Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases rises to **133** from **126** yesterday).
- **98** are local cases & **6** Mozambican drivers (Deaths reported by Mat North **(1)** & Bulawayo **(1)**)
- **Harare Province reported the highest number of cases today (34)**
- **1581** PCR tests done today (Positivity today was **6.6%**)
- **90** new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at **82.2%** and Active cases go up to **1849** today
- As of 19 December, Zimbabwe has now recorded **12 151** Cases **9984** recoveries and **318** Deaths.

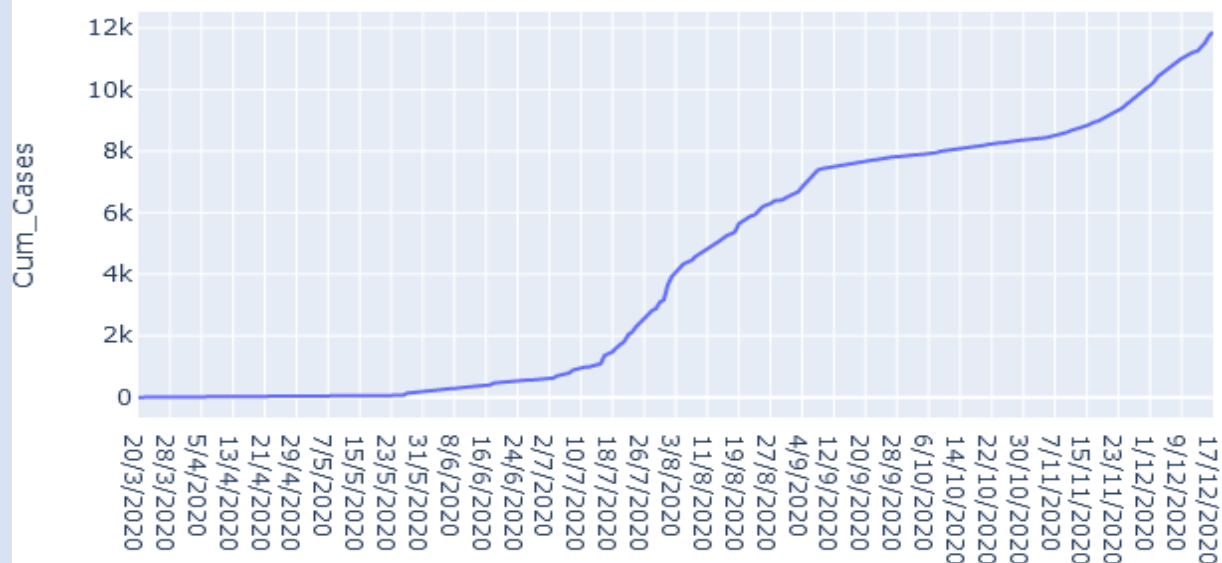

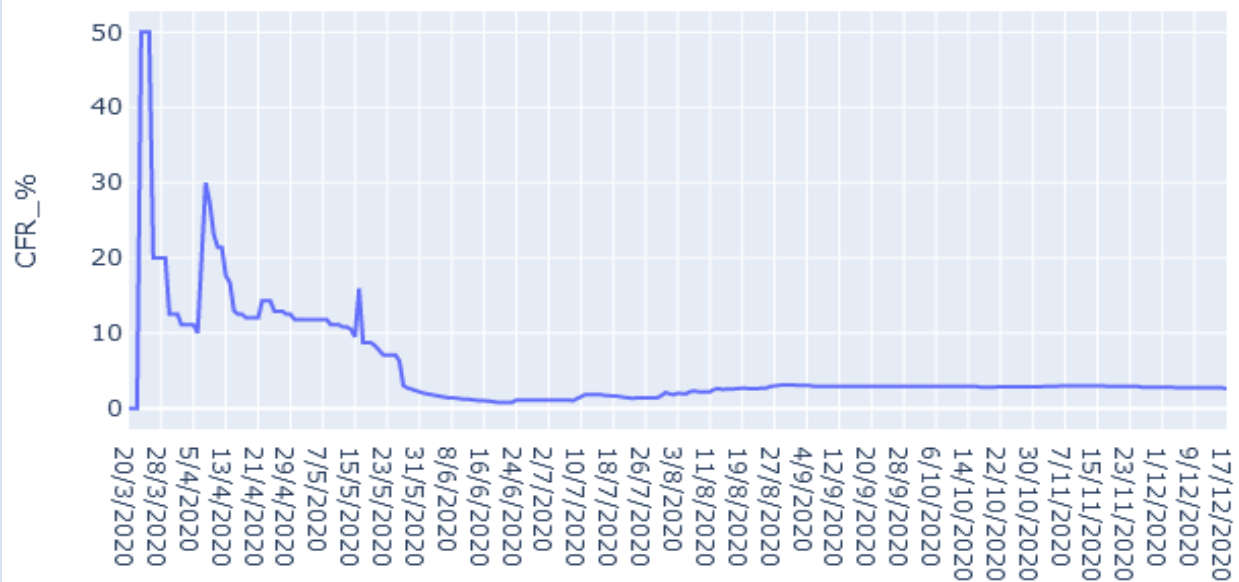

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate



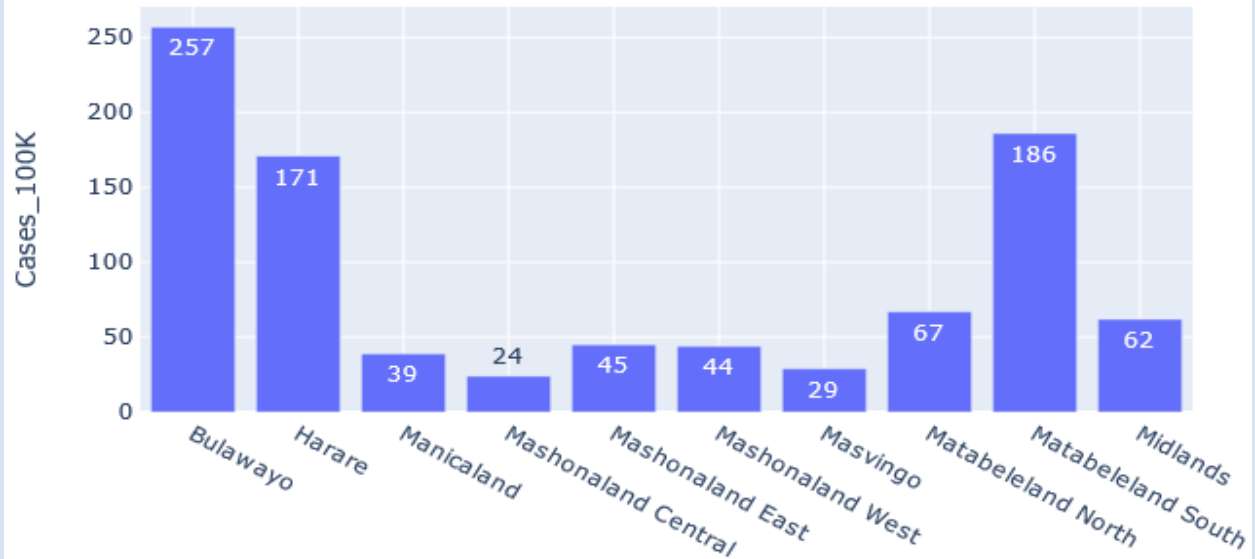
COMMENTS

- National Case fatality Rate now stands at **2.6 %** as at 19/12/20

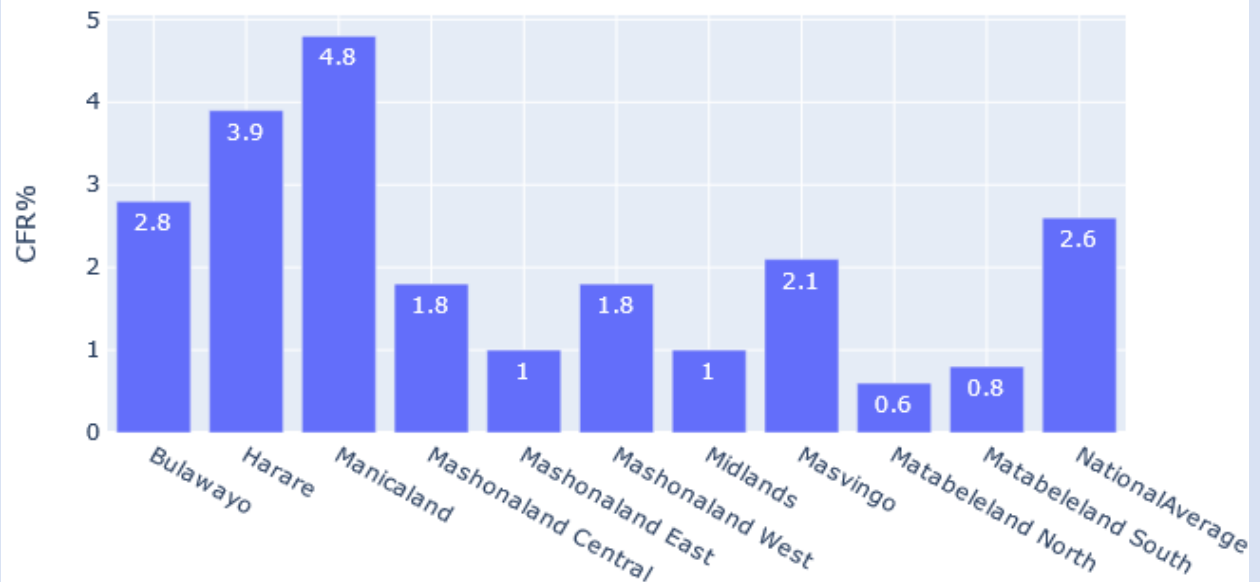

Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province



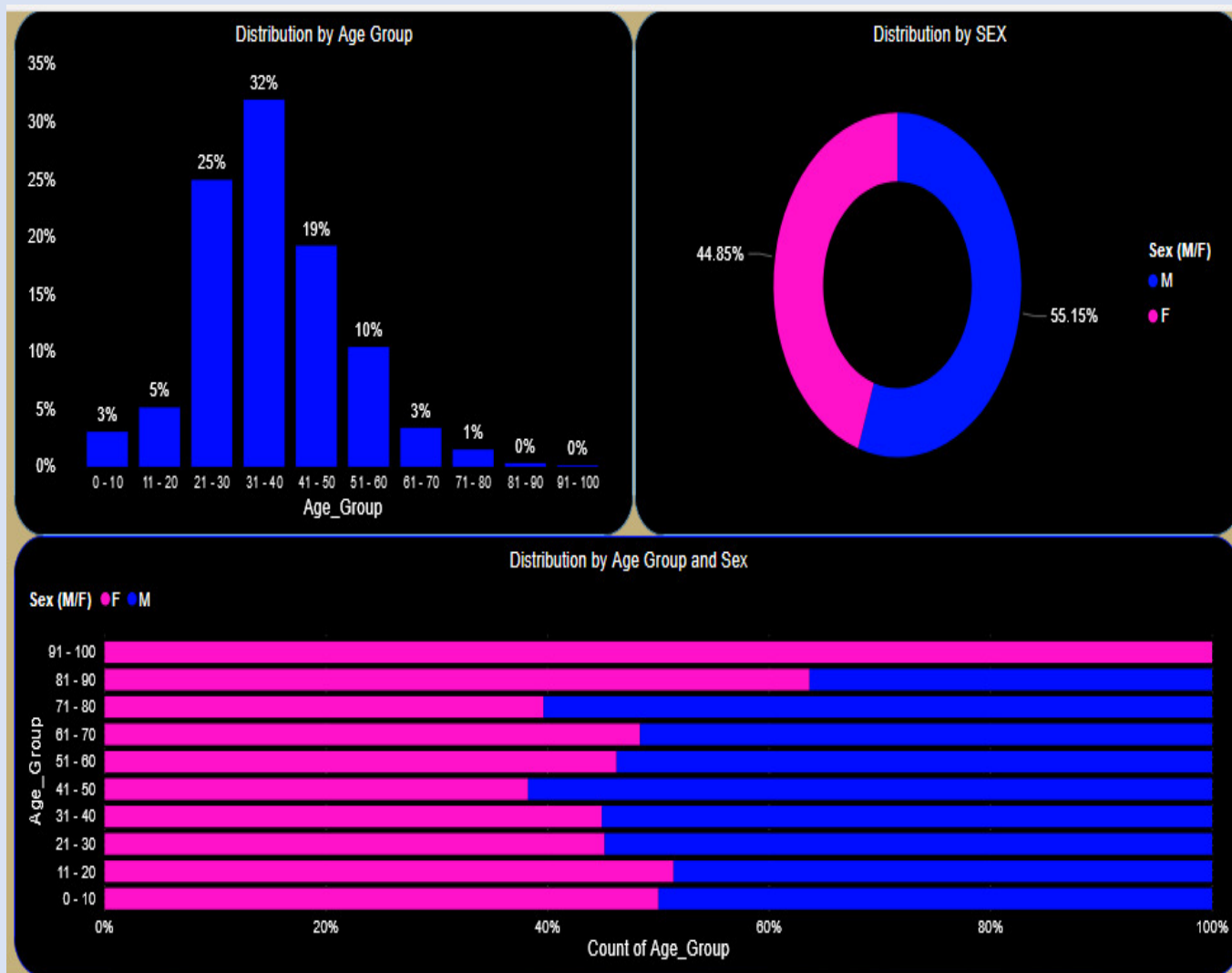
COMMENTS

Age and Sex Distribution for Cases



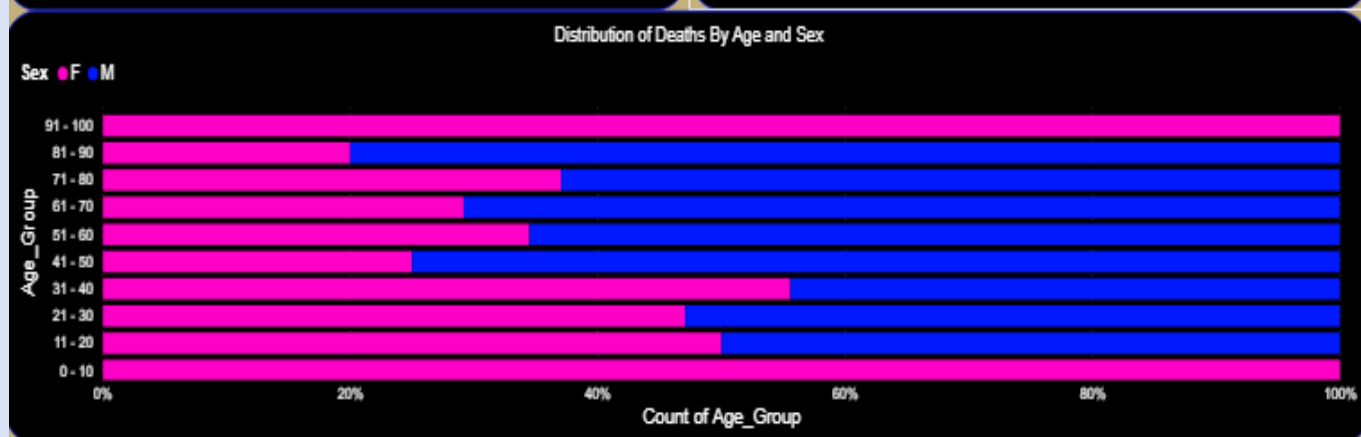
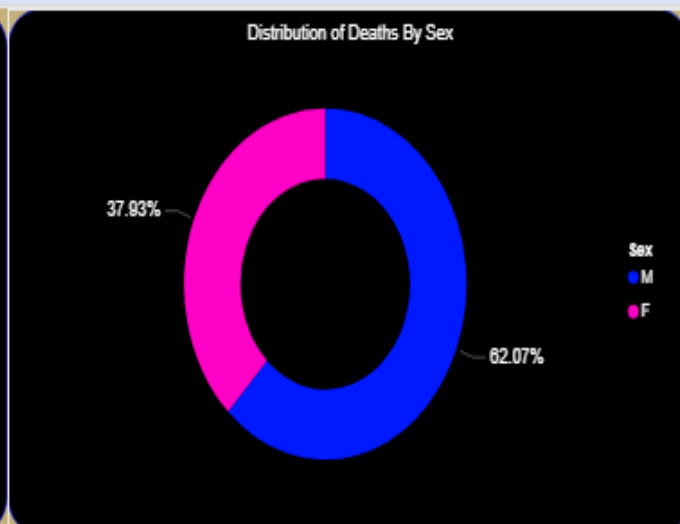
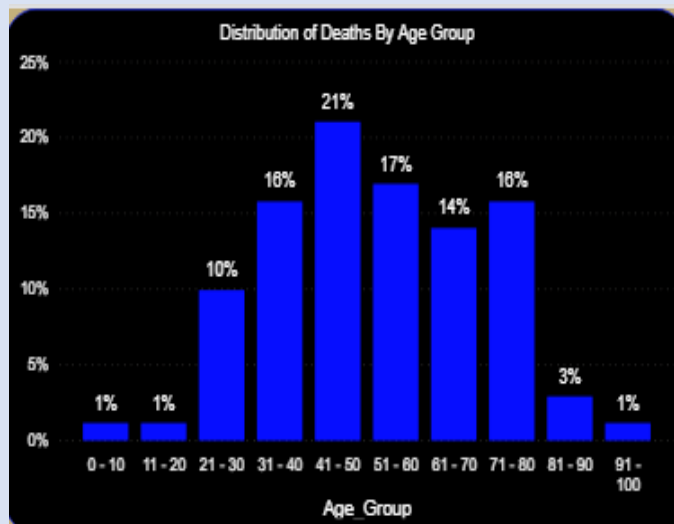
COMMENTS

- There are more deaths from males as age rises

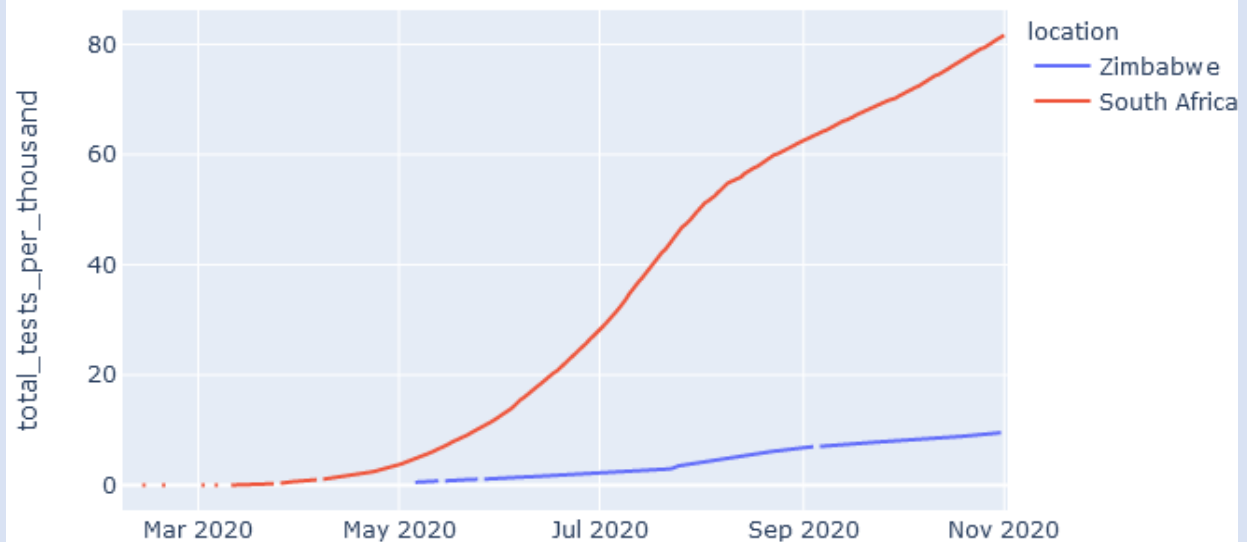

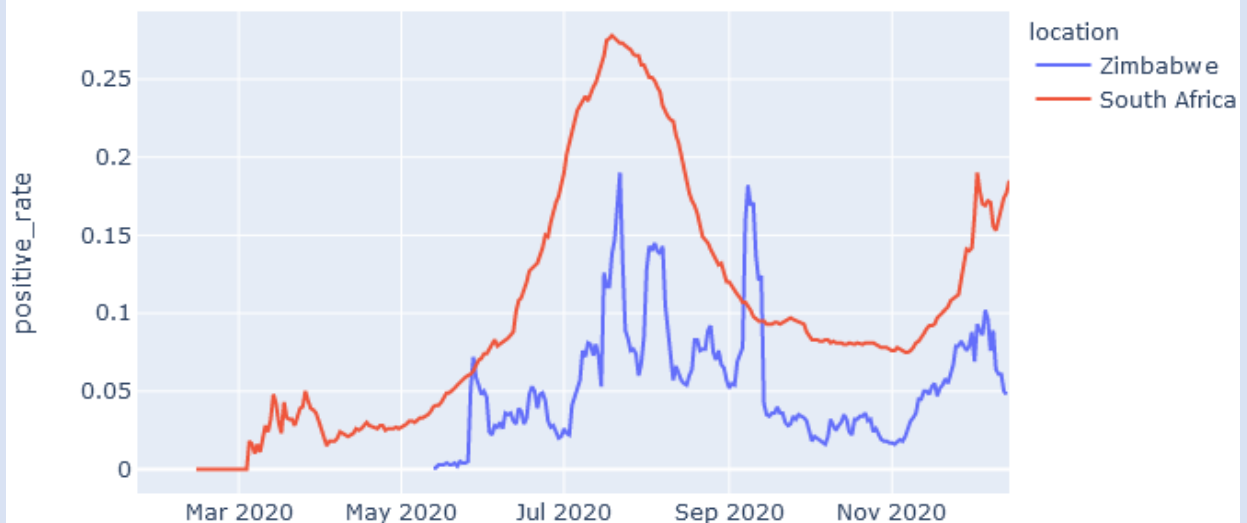

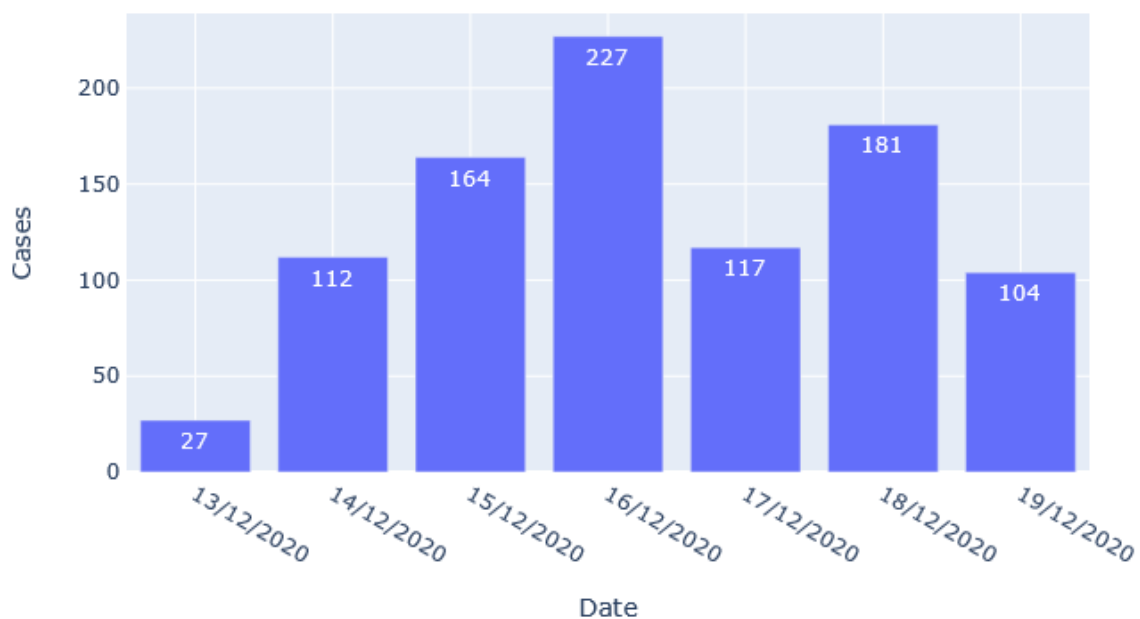

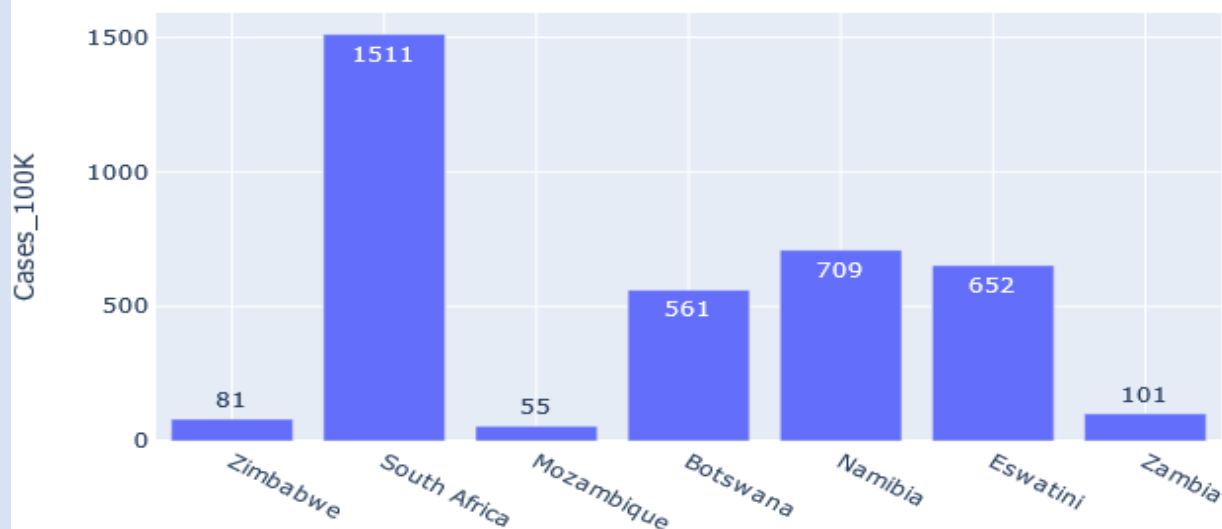

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cases In Last Seven Days

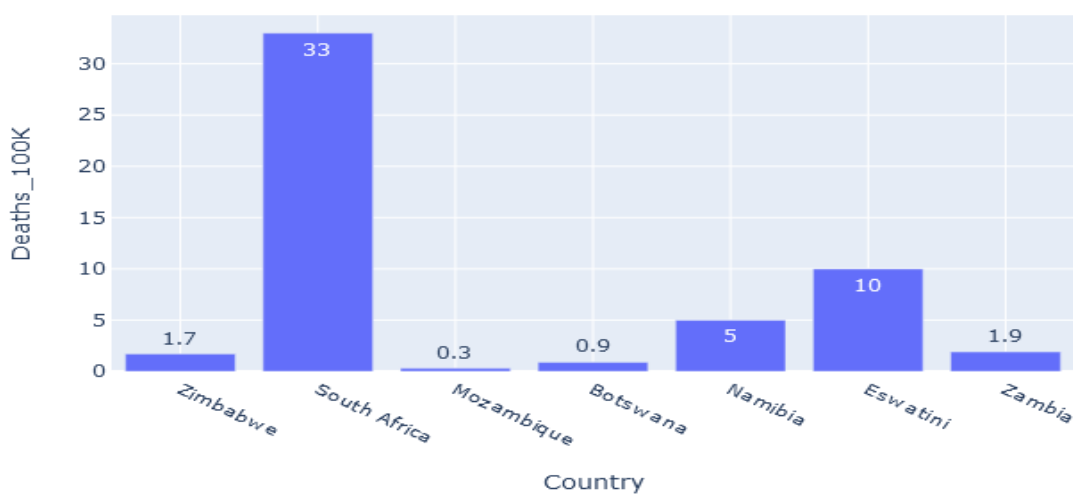




SADC Covid Cases Per 100K Population
