

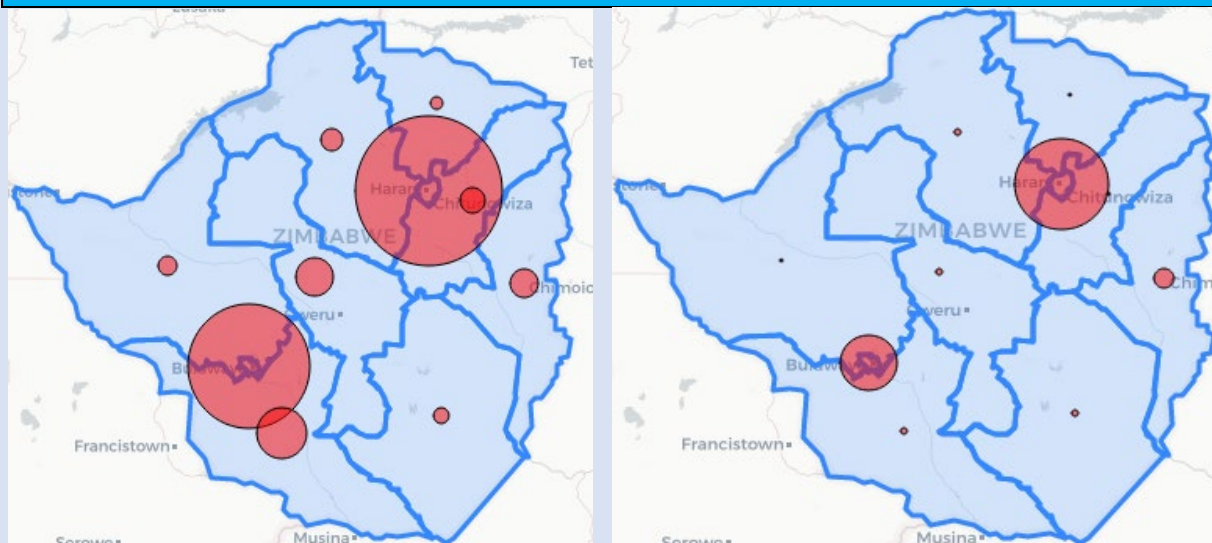


## Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 21/12/2020

### HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- **97** New Cases and **2** Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average\* for new cases falls to **152** from **154** yesterday).
- All **97** are local cases (Deaths reported by Bulawayo)
- All Provinces except Mash West&Mat South reported cases today with Harare highest (50)
- **1205** PCR tests done today (Positivity today was **8%**)
- **88** new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at **81.4%** and Active cases go up to **1988** today
- As of 21 December, Zimbabwe has now recorded **12 422** Cases **10 112** recoveries and **322** Deaths.

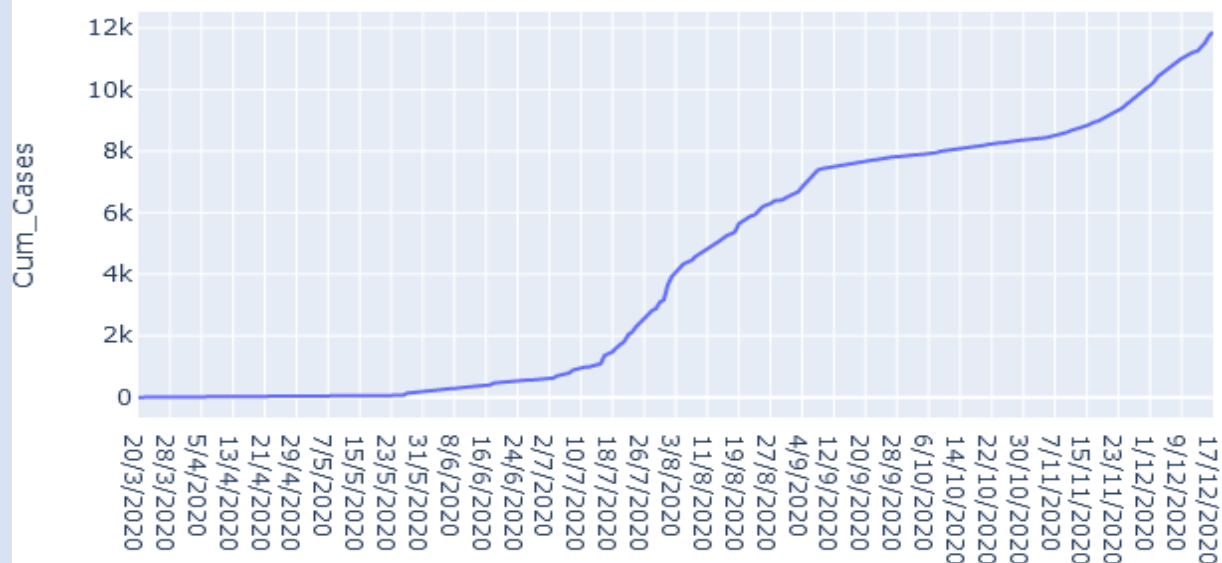

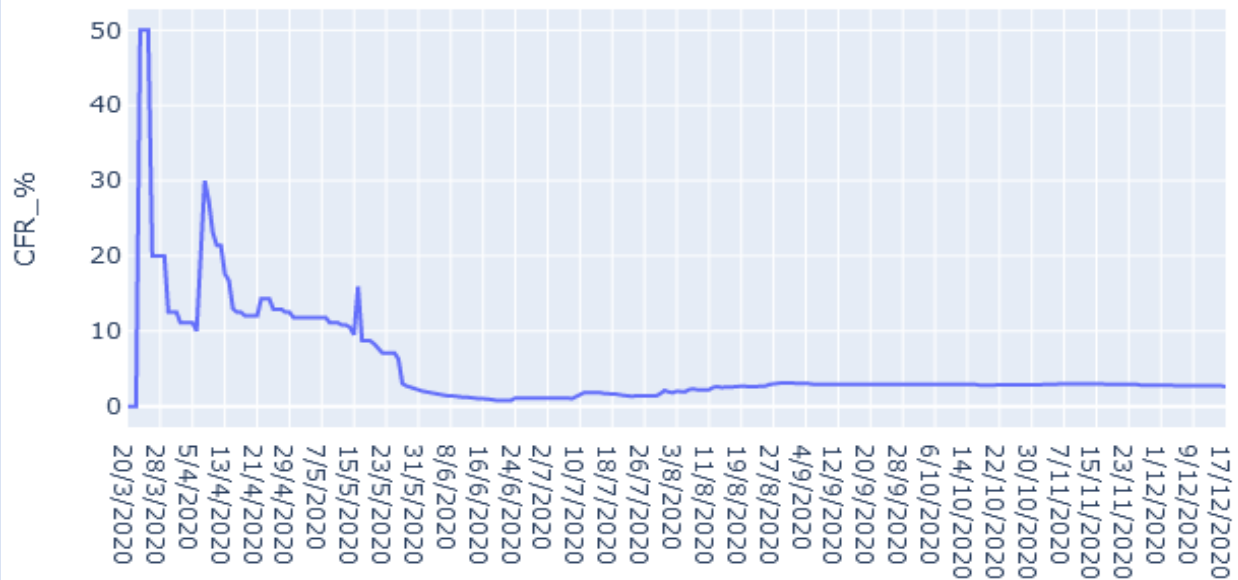

## Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate



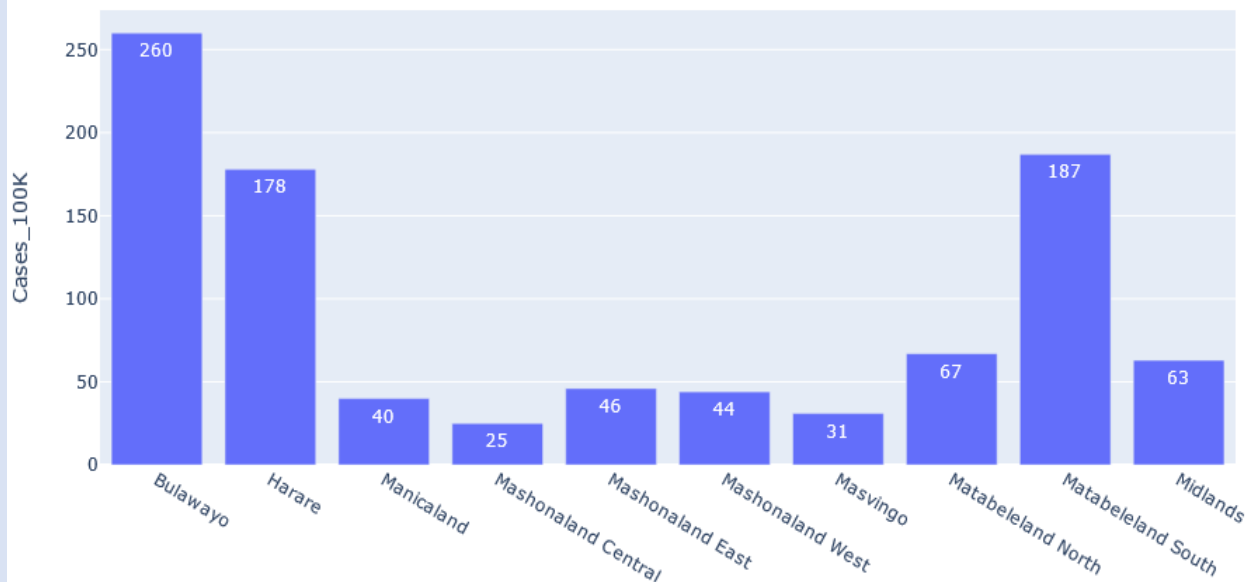
### COMMENTS

- National Case fatality Rate now stands at **2.6 %** as at 21/12/20

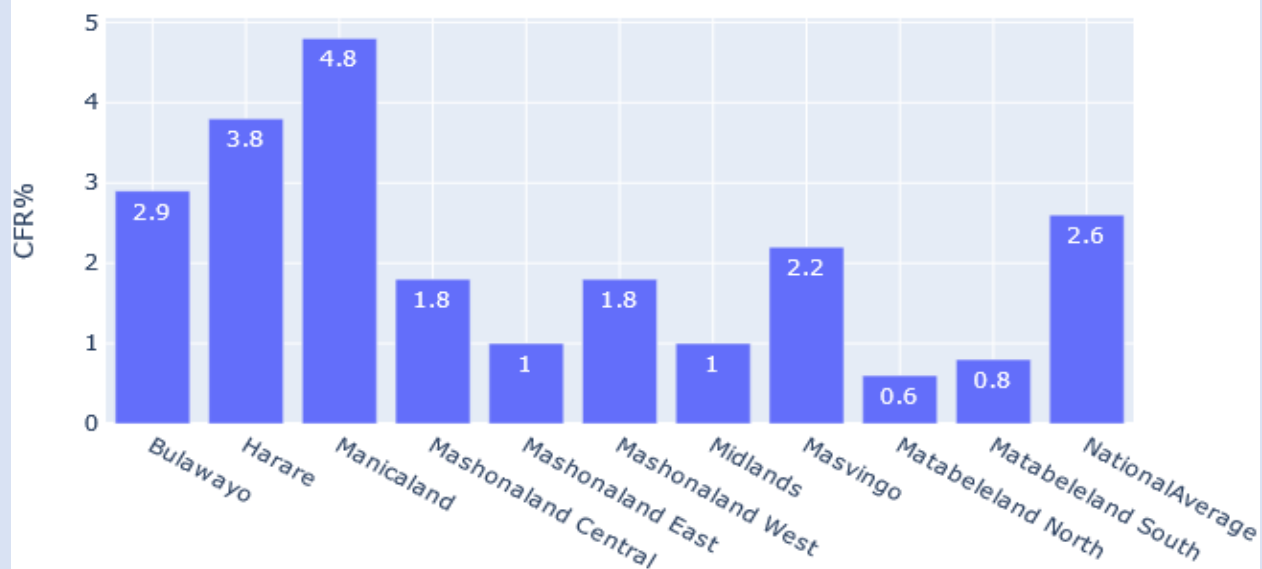

## Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province



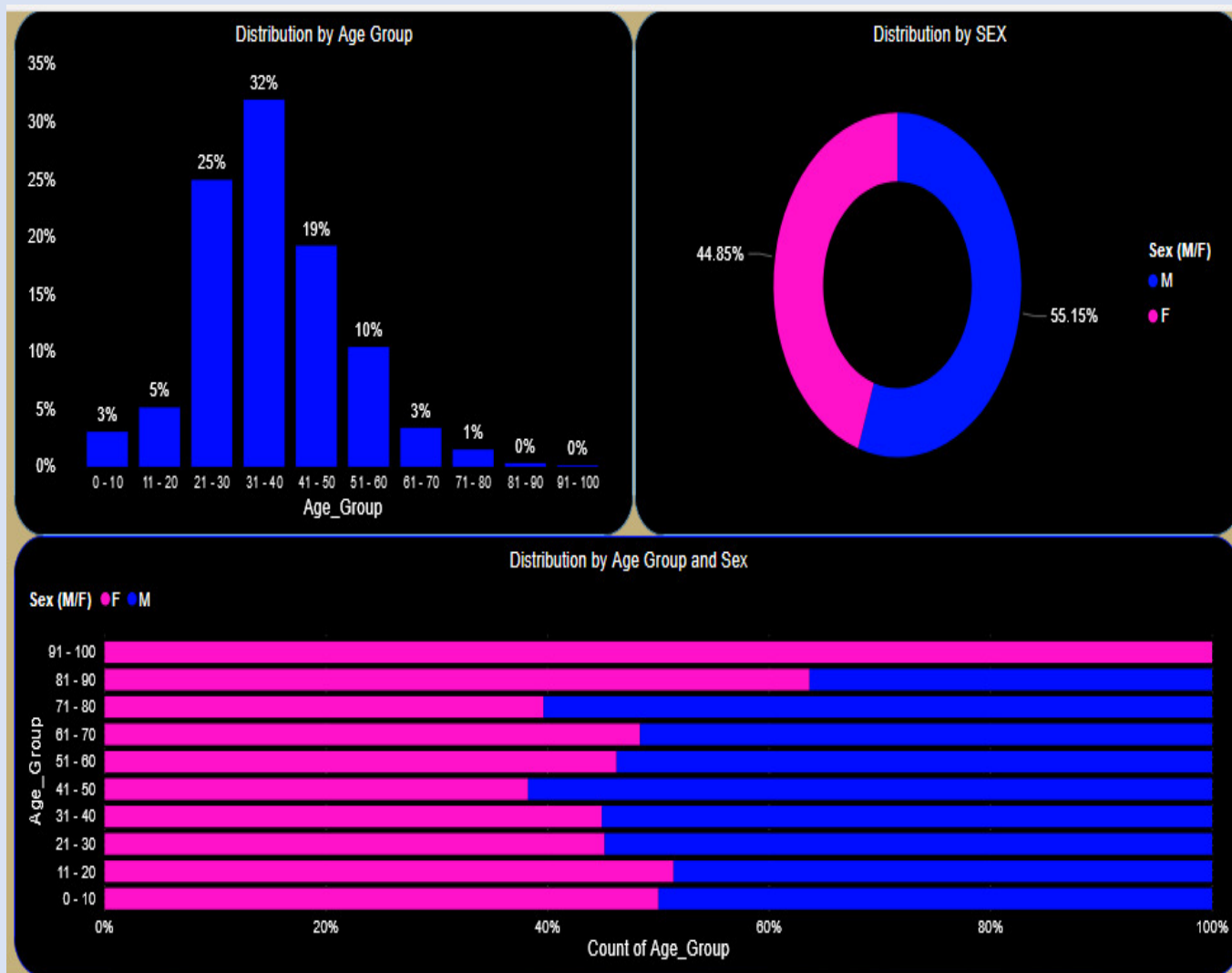
## COMMENTS

### Age and Sex Distribution for Cases



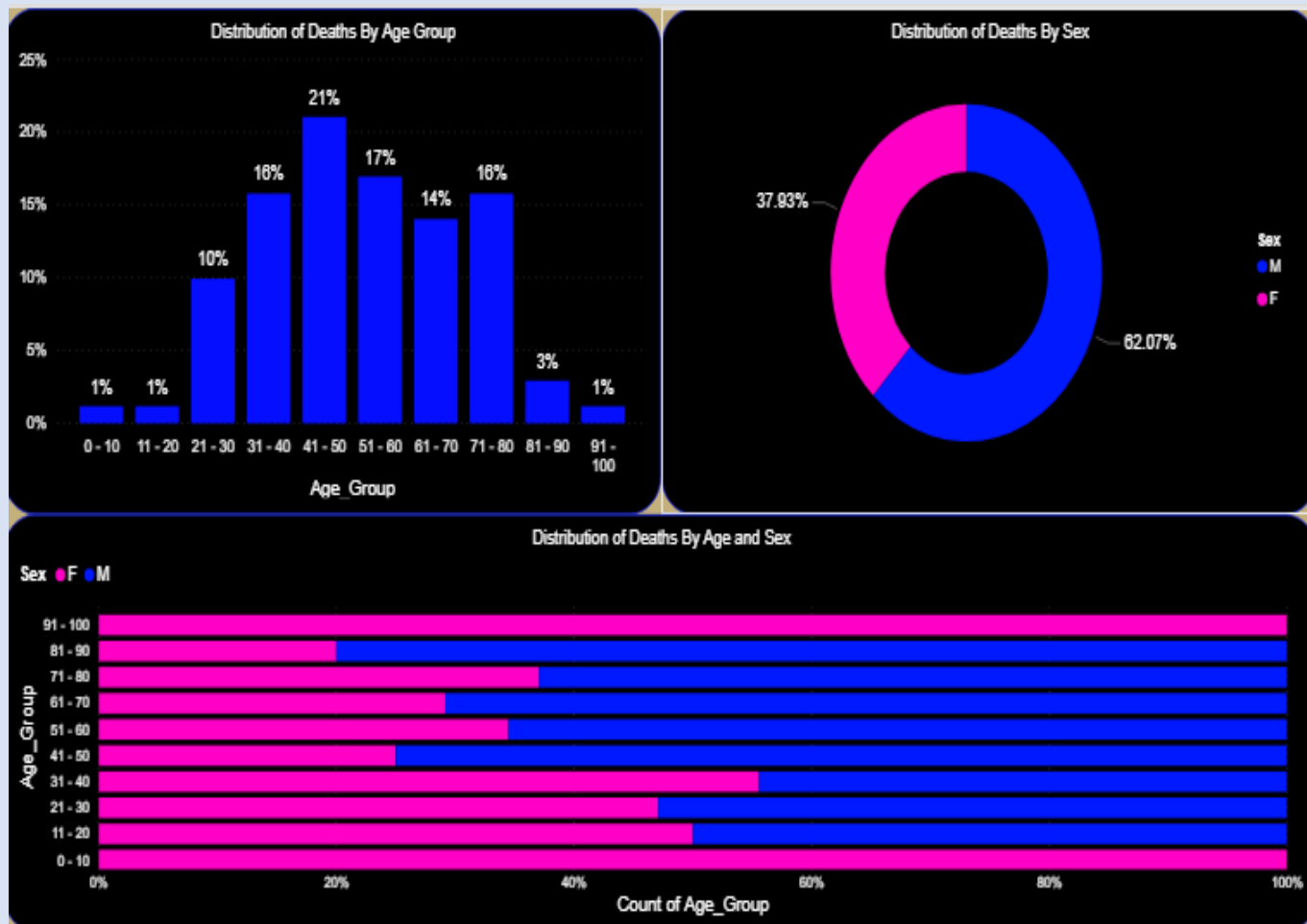
## COMMENTS

- There are more deaths from males as age rises

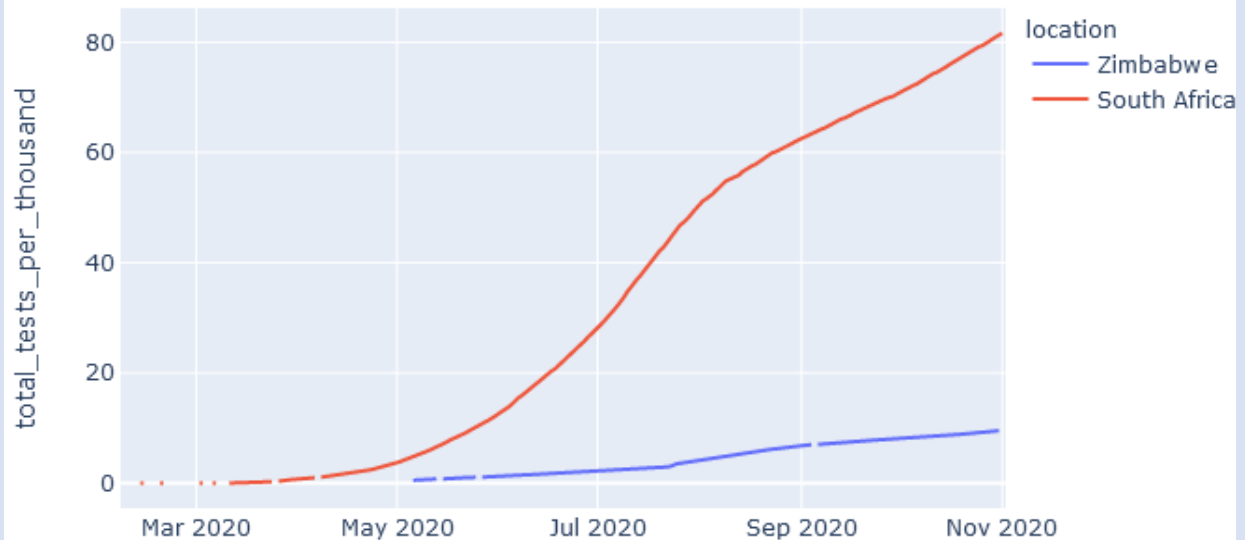

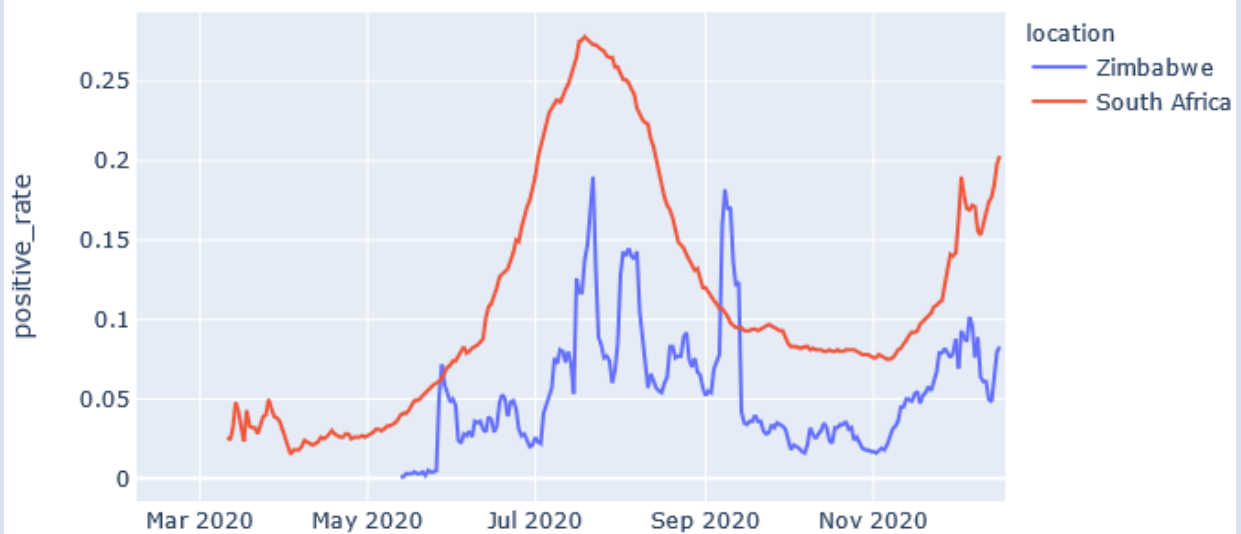

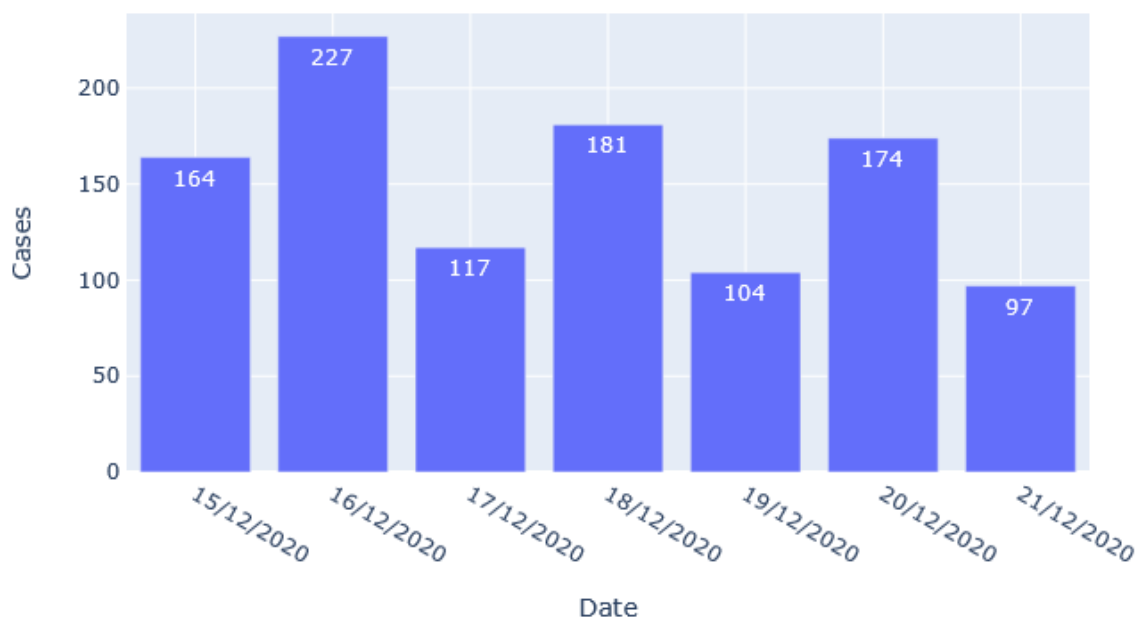

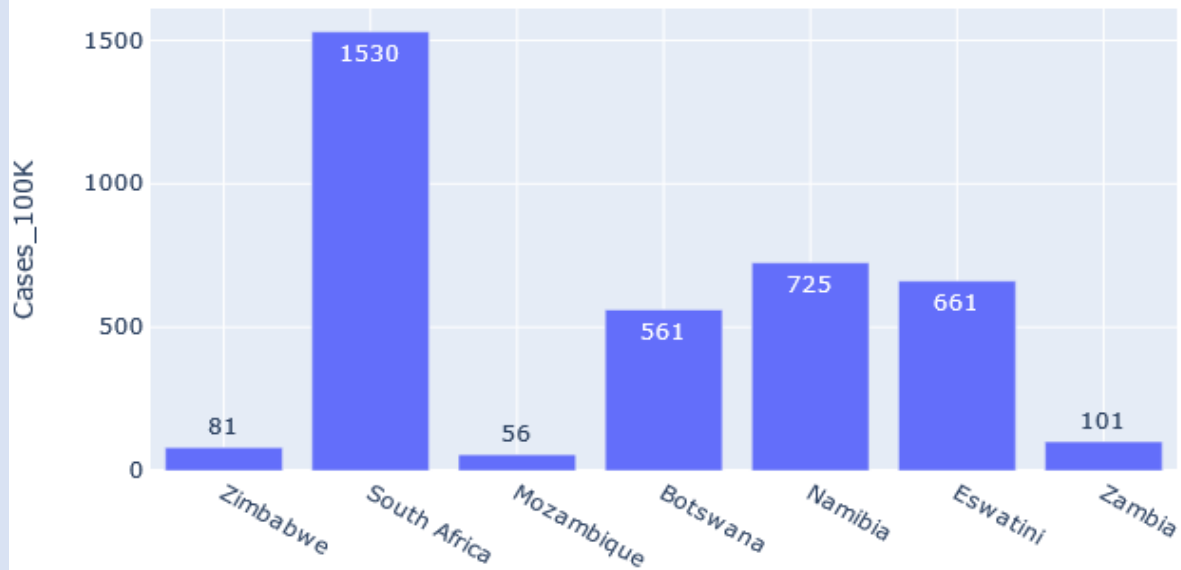

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cases In Last Seven Days

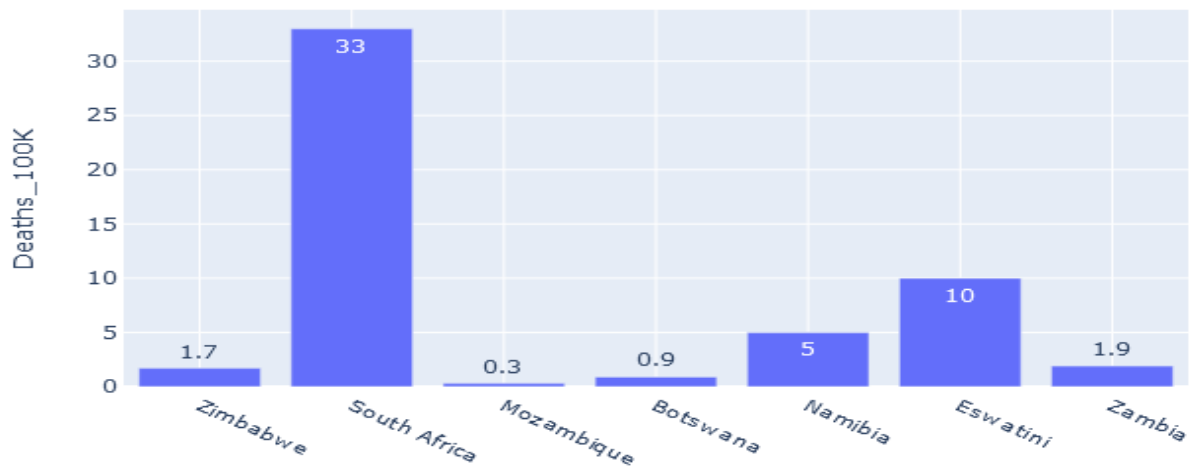




SADC Covid Cases Per 100K Population
