




## Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 22/12/2020

### HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- **122** New Cases and **4** Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average\* for new cases falls to **146** from **152** yesterday).
- **105** are local cases and **17** are returnees from SA (Deaths reported by Mash East (2), Bulawayo (1) and Manicaland (1))
- **1425** PCR tests done today (Positivity today was **8.6%**)
- **47** new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at **81%** and Active cases go up to **2059** today
- As of 22 December, Zimbabwe has now recorded **12544** Cases **10159** recoveries and **326** Deaths.





## Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Rate




### COMMENTS

- National Case fatality Rate now stands at **2.6 %** as at 22/12/20



## Covid Cases Fatality Rate By Province




## COMMENTS

### Age and Sex Distribution for Cases




## COMMENTS

- There are more deaths from males as age rises









Zimbabwe Covid-19 Cases In Last Seven Days






SADC Covid Cases Per 100K Population
