

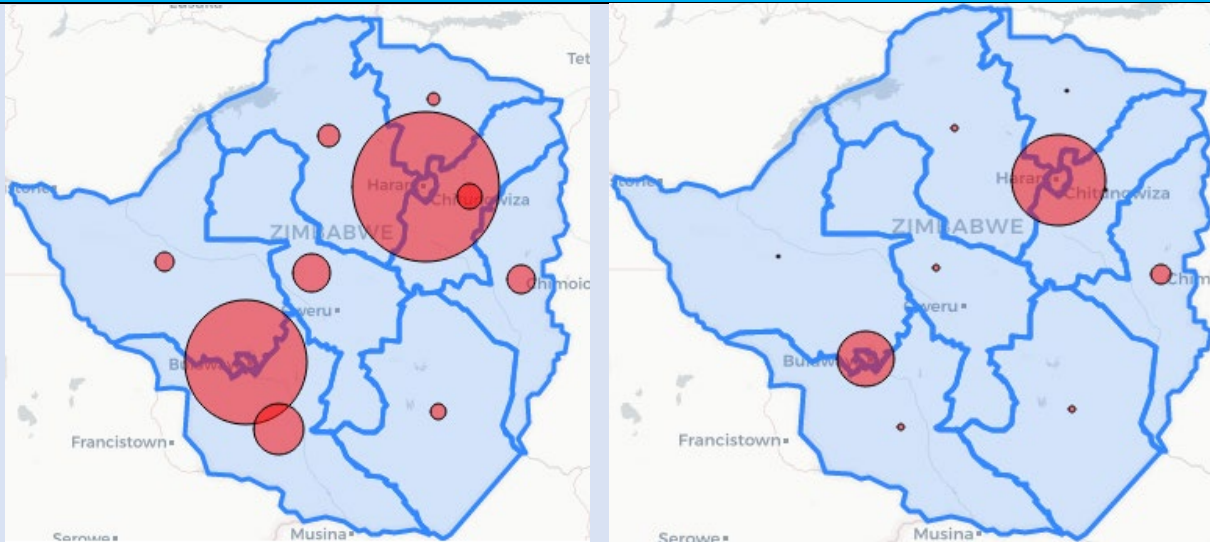


Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 14/03/2021

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- **13** New Cases (*All local*) and **2** Deaths reported in the last 24 hours. (*7 day rolling average* for new cases remains at 27 today*).
- Vaccination of frontline workers continues in static sites in all the provinces to reach the targets. (*As@1600hrs today no reports had been received*) bringing cumulative vaccinated to **36 359**.
- *As of 13 March 2021, @1500hrs there were 94 hospitalised cases: Asymptomatic 81, mild to moderate 13, severe 0 and 0 in Intensive Care Units.*
- **1127** tests done today (*Positivity today was 1.2%*)
- **32** new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at **93.3%** and Active cases go down to **938** today.
- As of 14 March 2021, Zimbabwe has now recorded **36 484** Cases **34043** recoveries and **1503** Deaths.

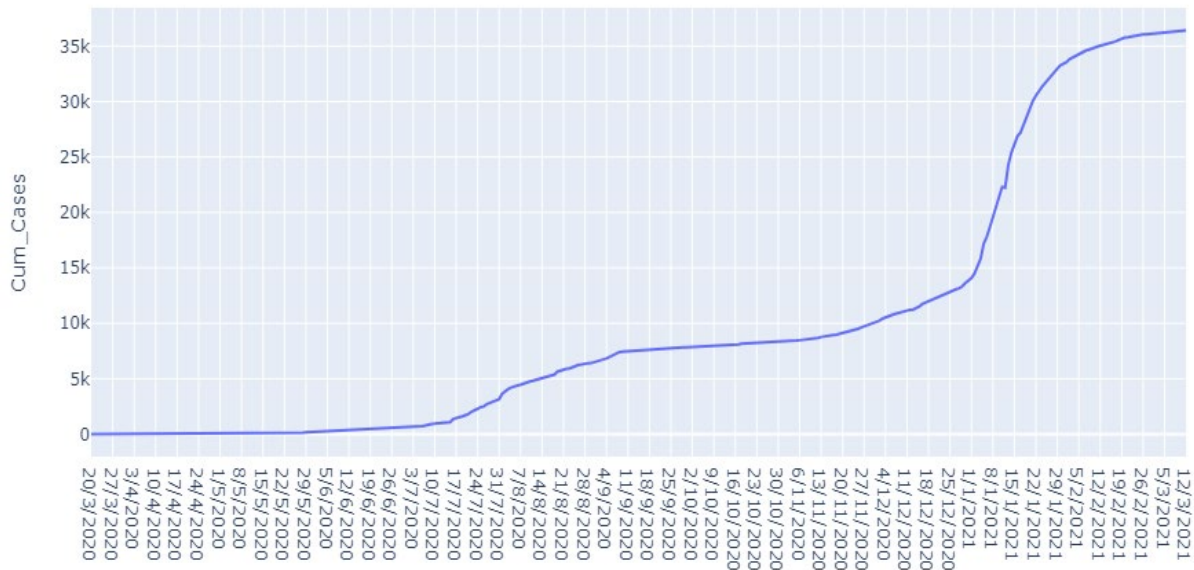

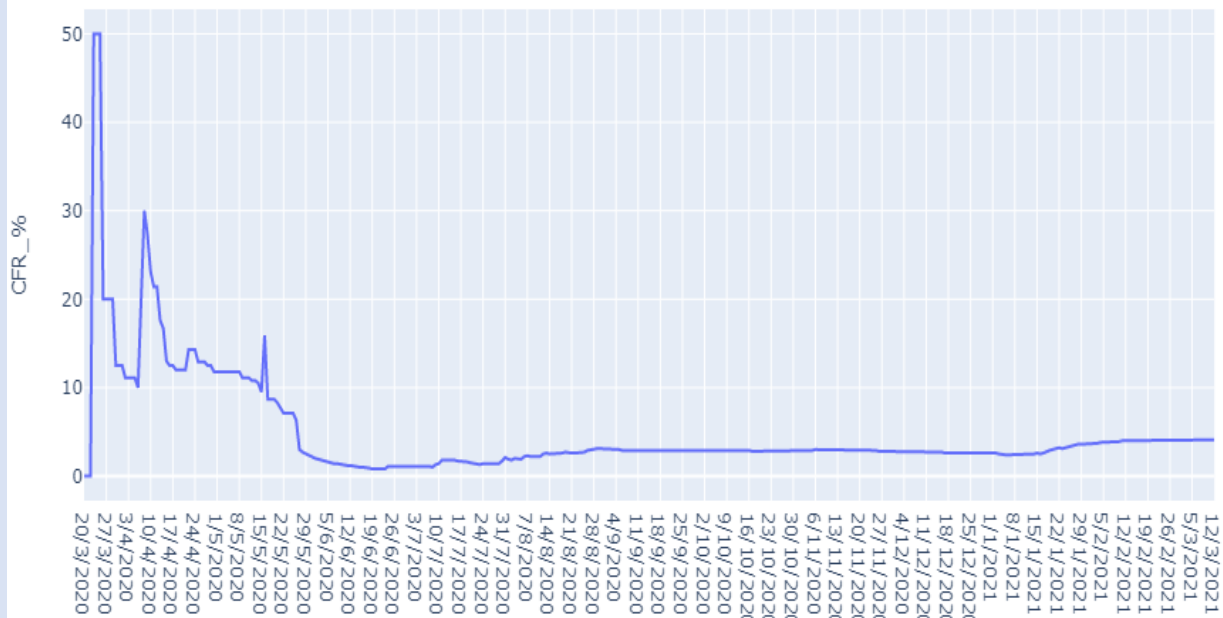

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Ratio



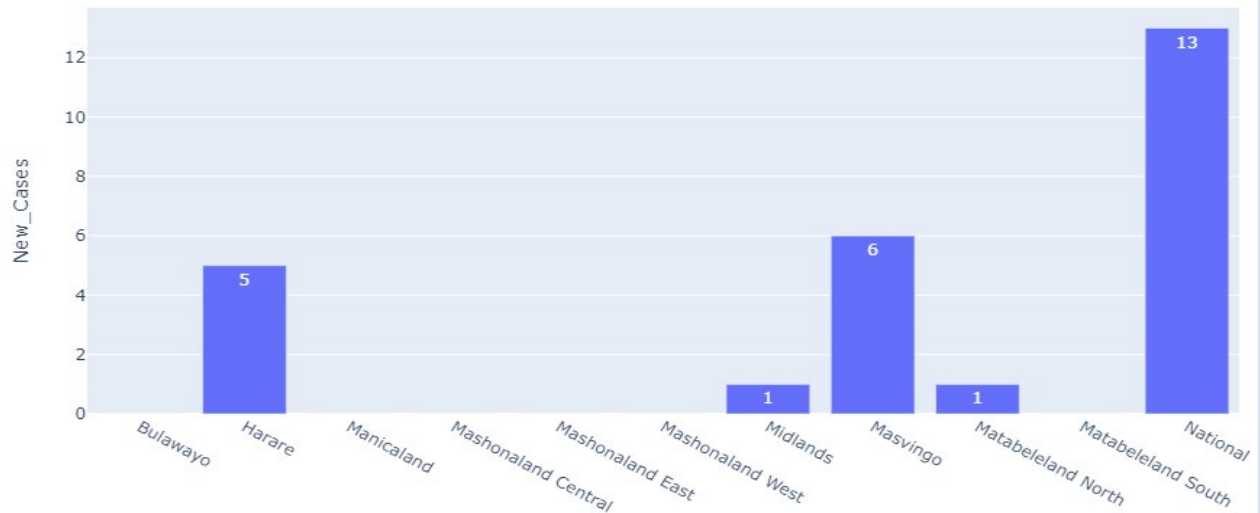

- National Case fatality Rate now stands at **4.1 %** as at 14/3/21

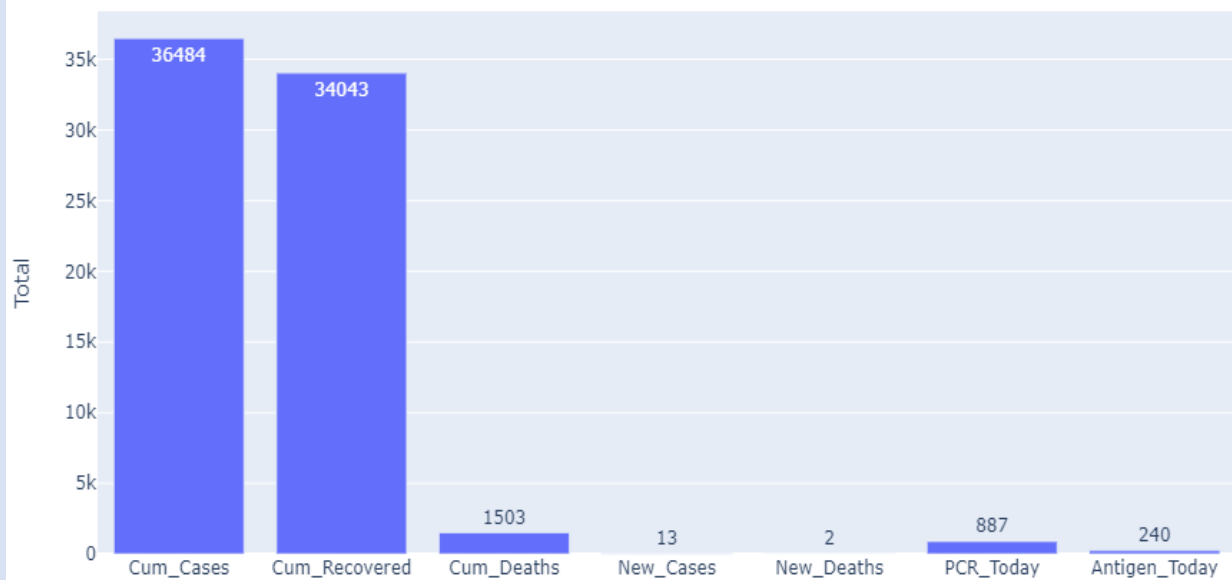

Covid Cases Profile

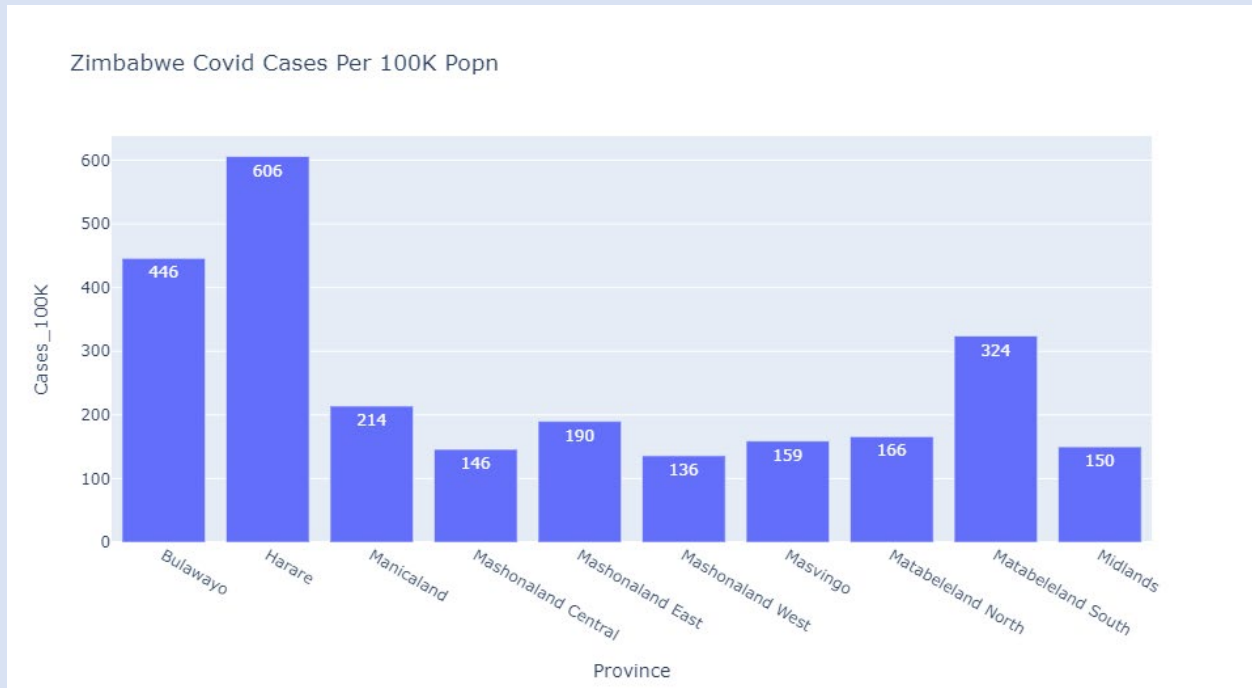


COMMENTS

INCIDENCE OF CASES BY PROVINCE

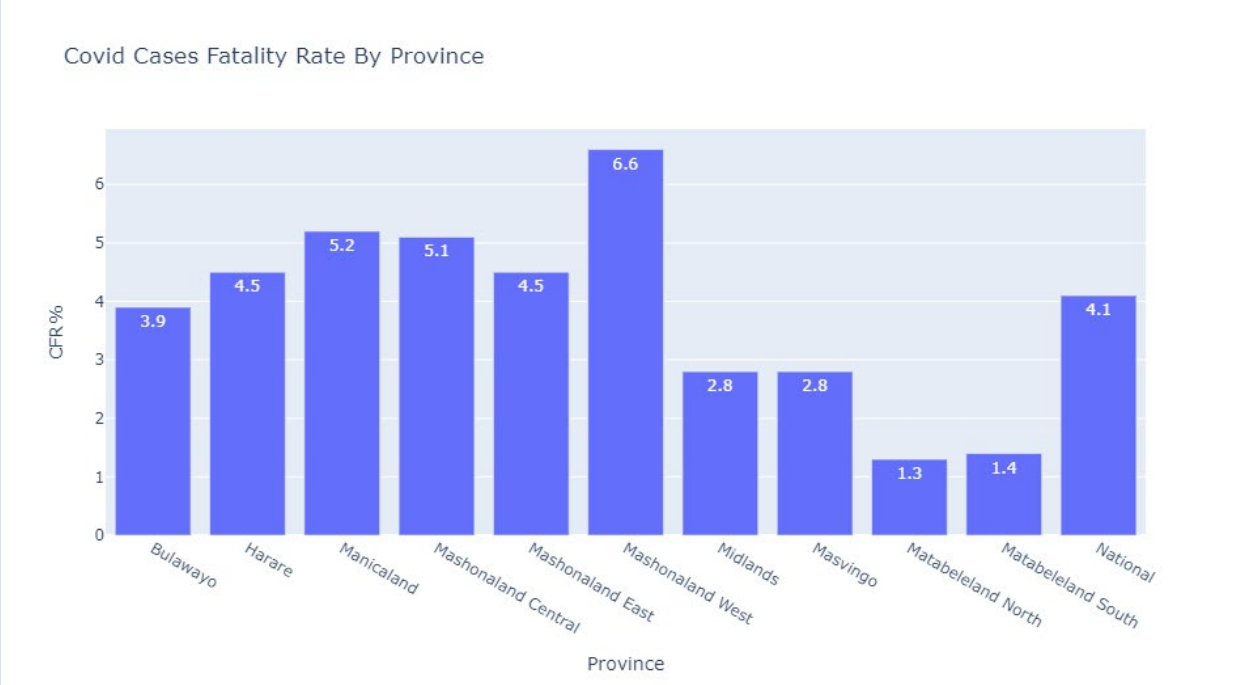


COMMENTS

COVID CASE FATALITY RATIO BY PROVINCE

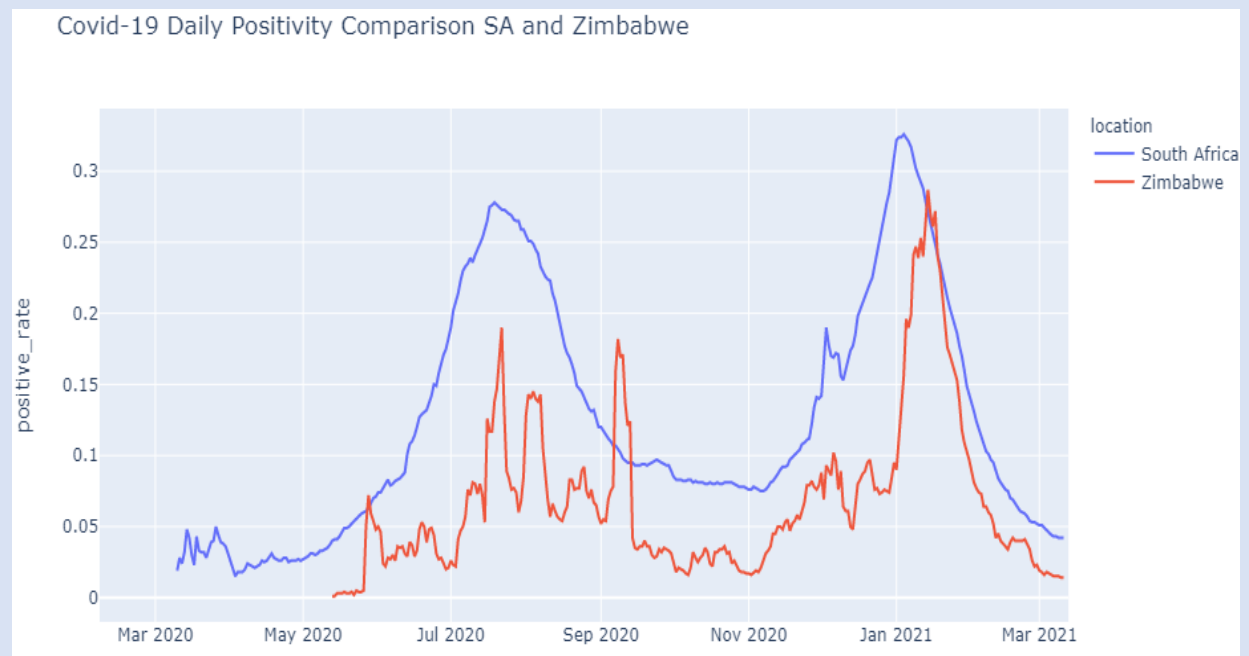
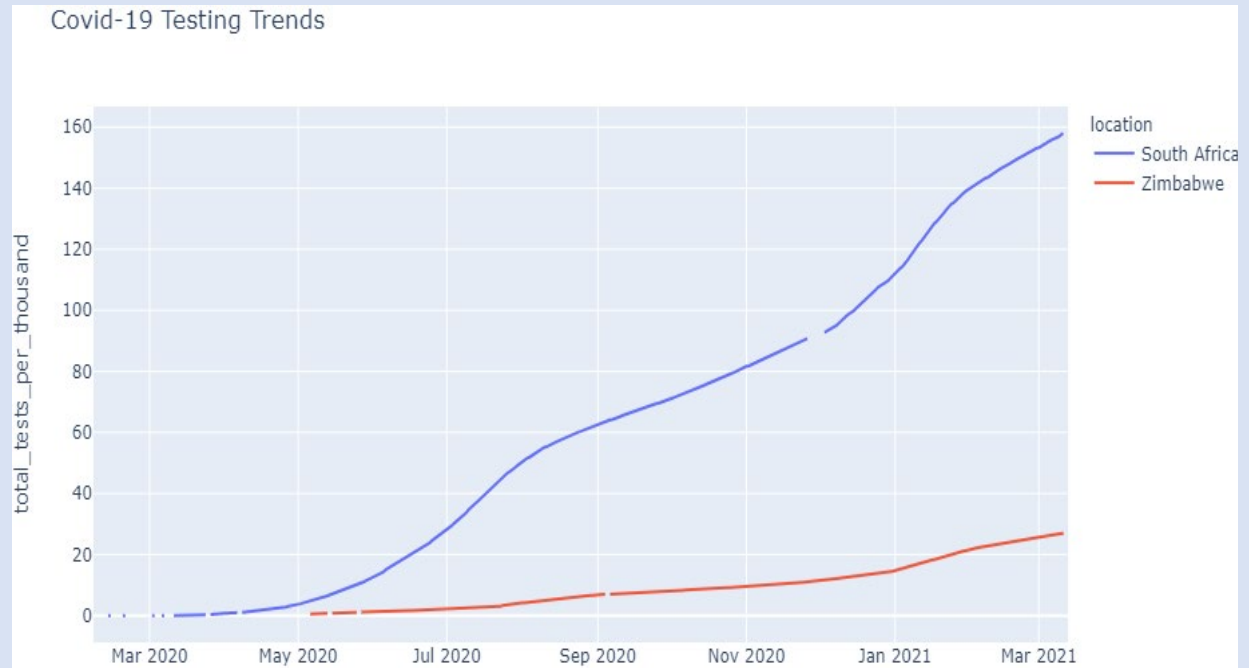

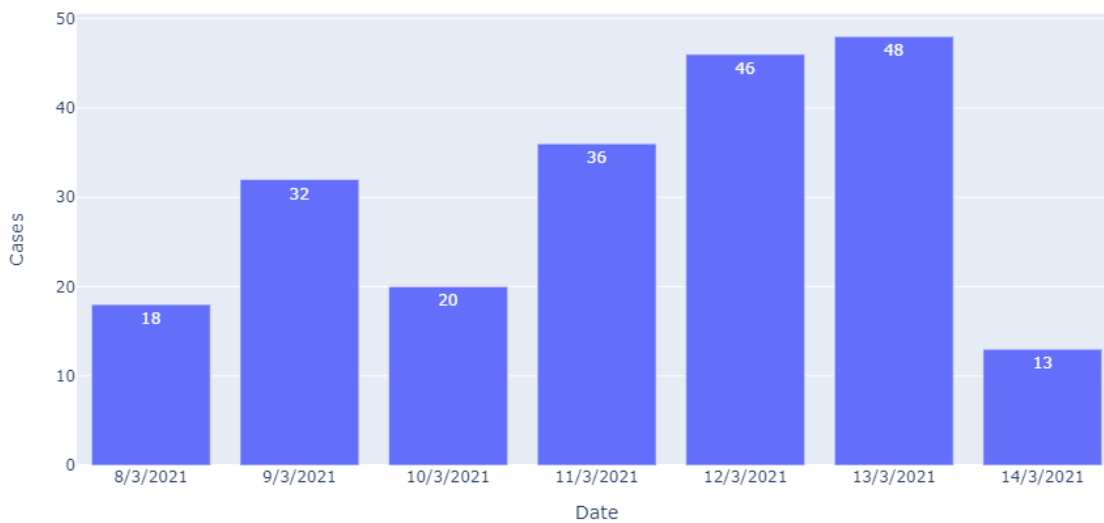

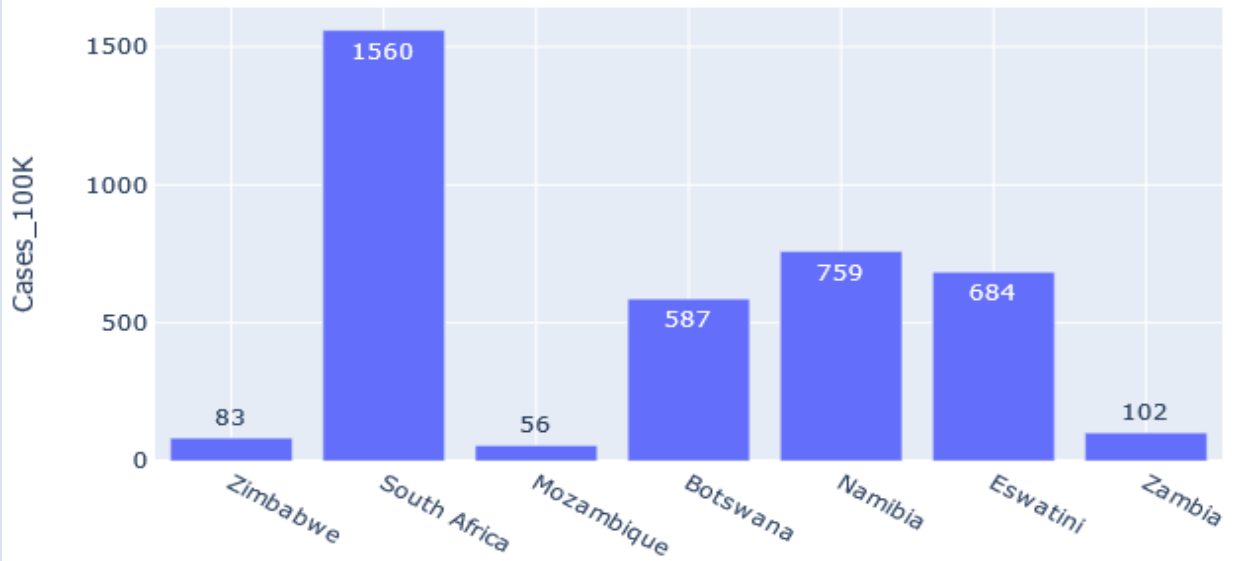

Zimbabwe Covid_19 Cases in the Last Seven Days

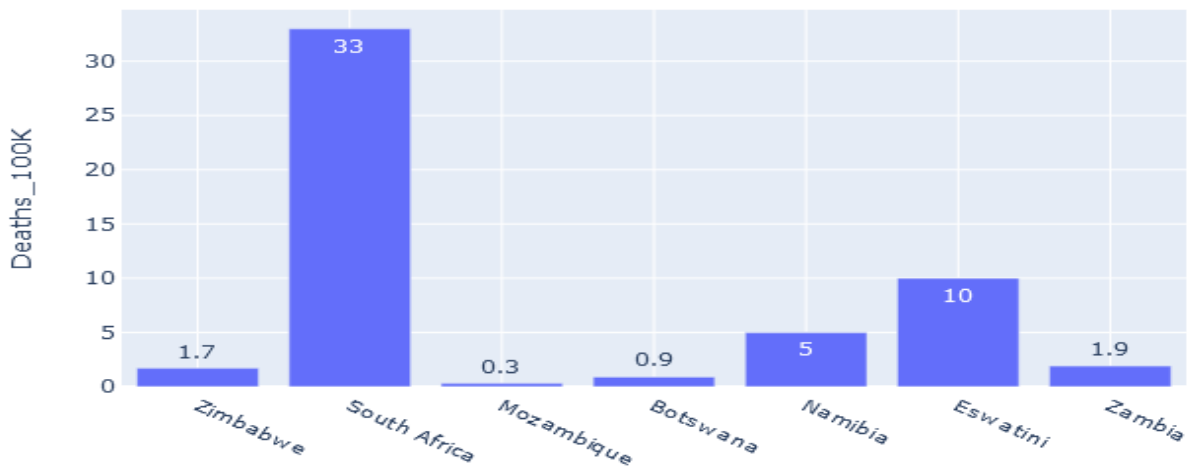




SADC Covid Cases Per 100K Population
