

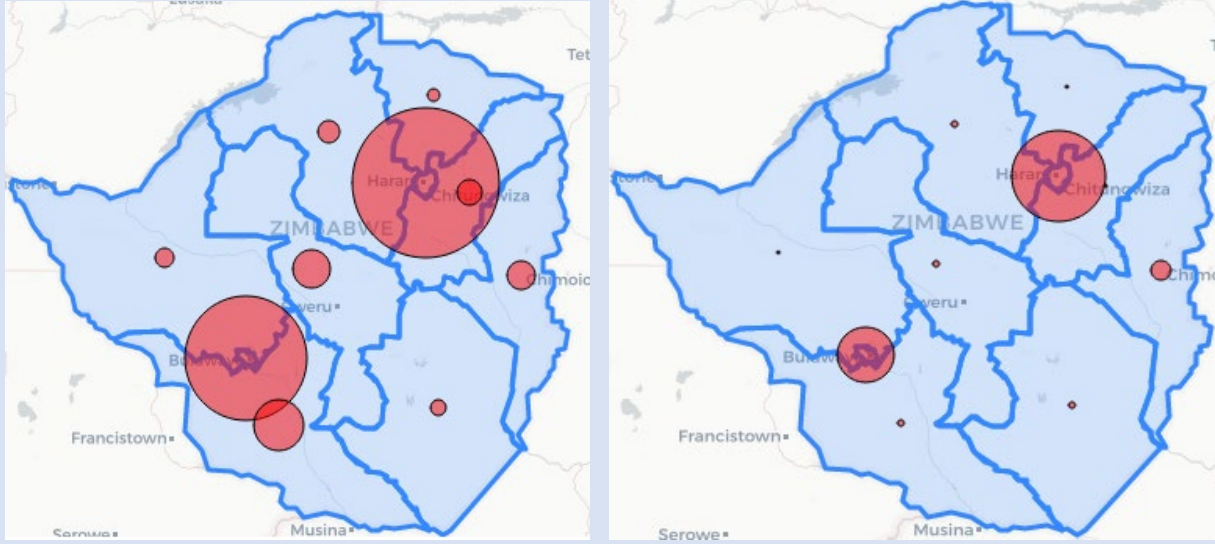


Zimbabwe Covid-19 SitRep 18/03/2021

HIGHLIGHTS TODAY

- **59 New Cases (All local)** and **1 Death** reported in the last 24 hours. (7 day rolling average* for new cases **rises to 33 today from 30 yesterday**).
- **Vaccination of frontline workers continues in static sites in all the provinces to reach the targets as 395 were vaccinated (As@1600hrs today) bringing cumulative vaccinated to 40 002 .**
- **As of 17 March 2021, @1500hrs there were 51 hospitalised cases: Asymptomatic 8, mild to moderate 32, severe 9 and 2 in Intensive Care Units.**
- **2484 tests done today (Positivity today was 2.5%)**
- **90 new recoveries reported: National Recovery rate stands at 93.5% and Active cases down to 876 today.**
- **As of 18 March 2021, Zimbabwe has now recorded 36 611 Cases 34226 recoveries and 1509 Deaths.**

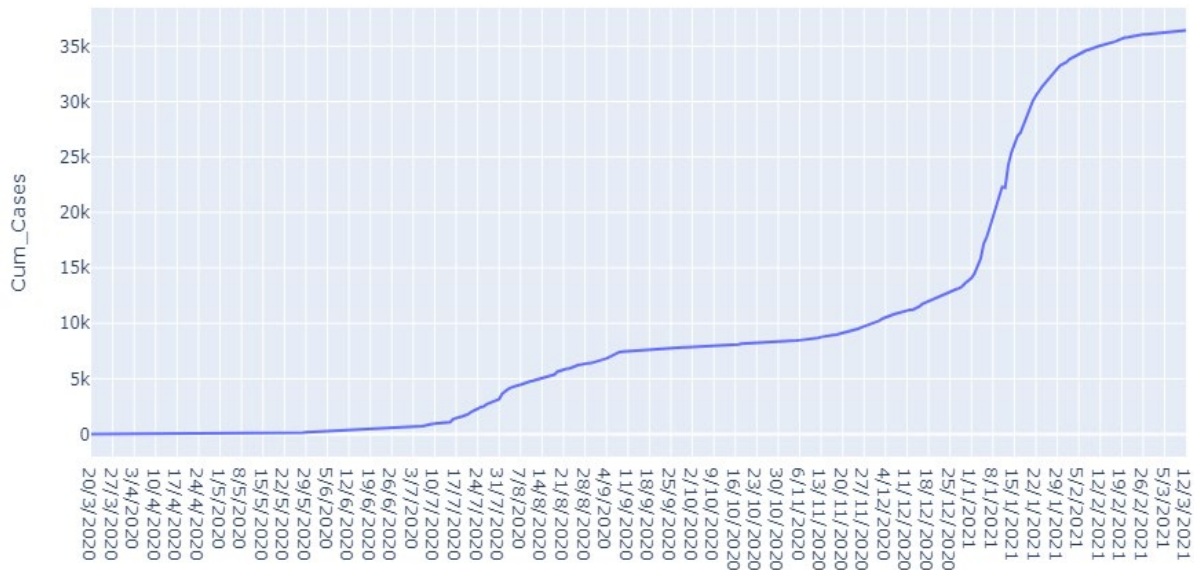

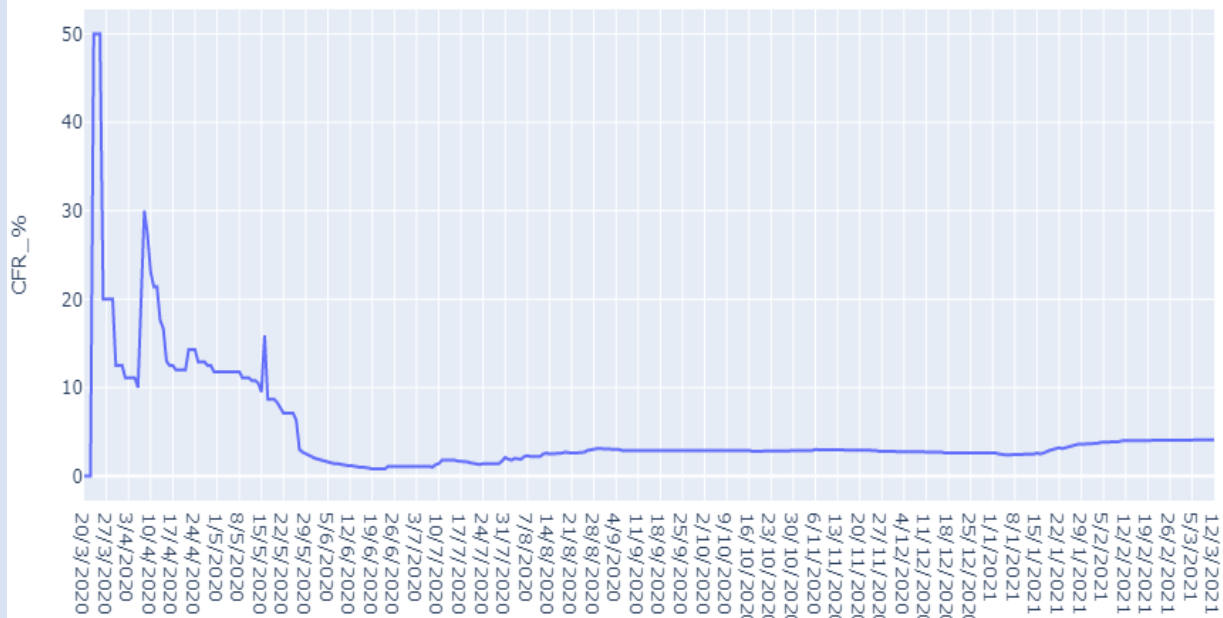

Zimbabwe Covid-19 Case Fatality Ratio



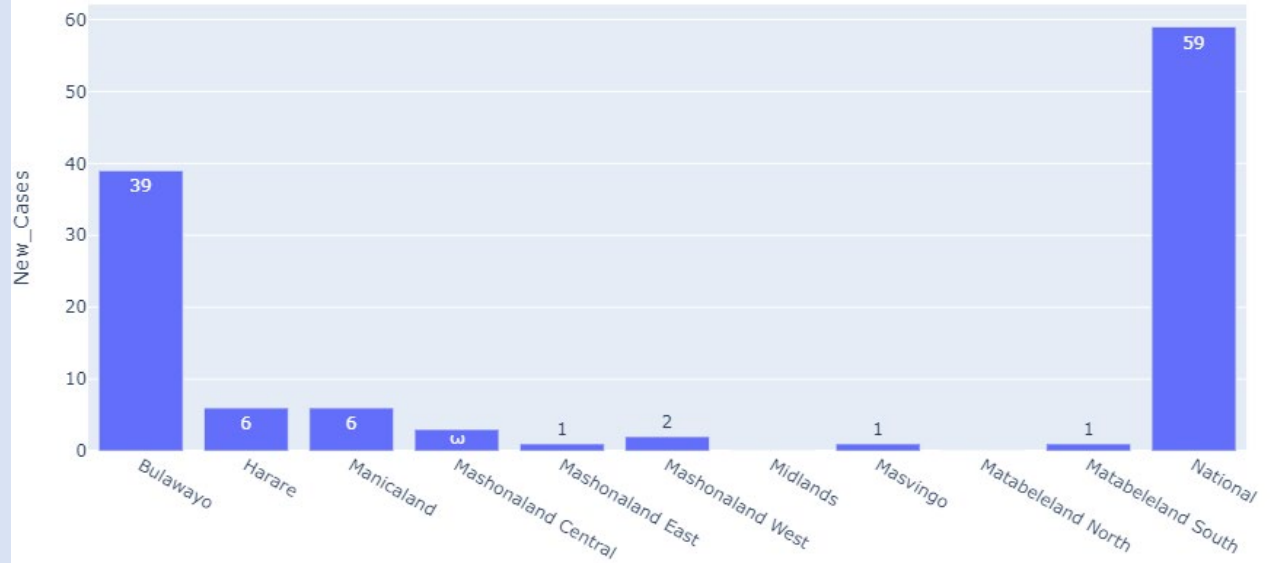

- National Case fatality Rate now stands at **4.1 %** as at 18/3/21

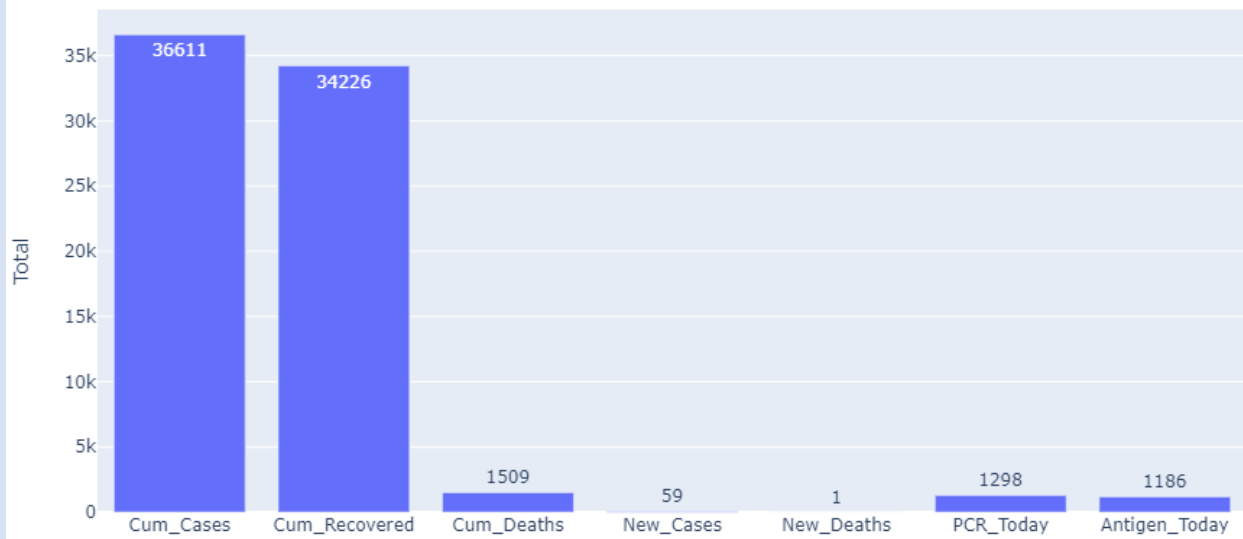

Covid Cases Profile

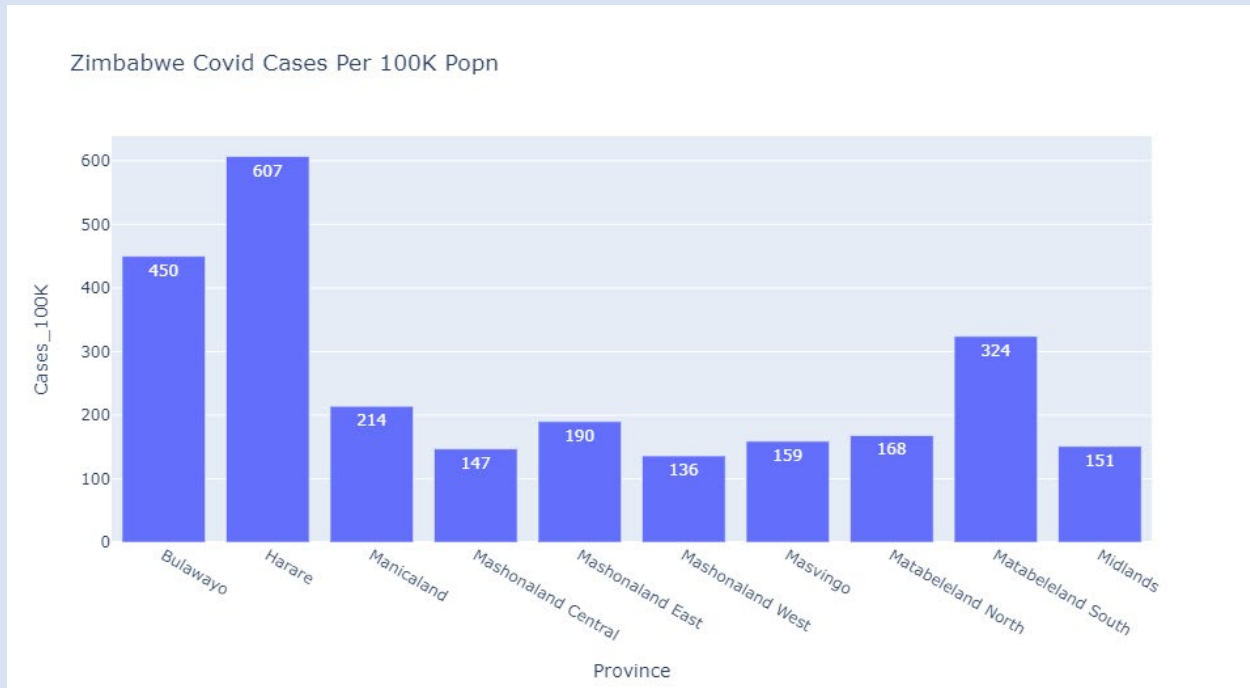


COMMENTS

INCIDENCE OF CASES BY PROVINCE

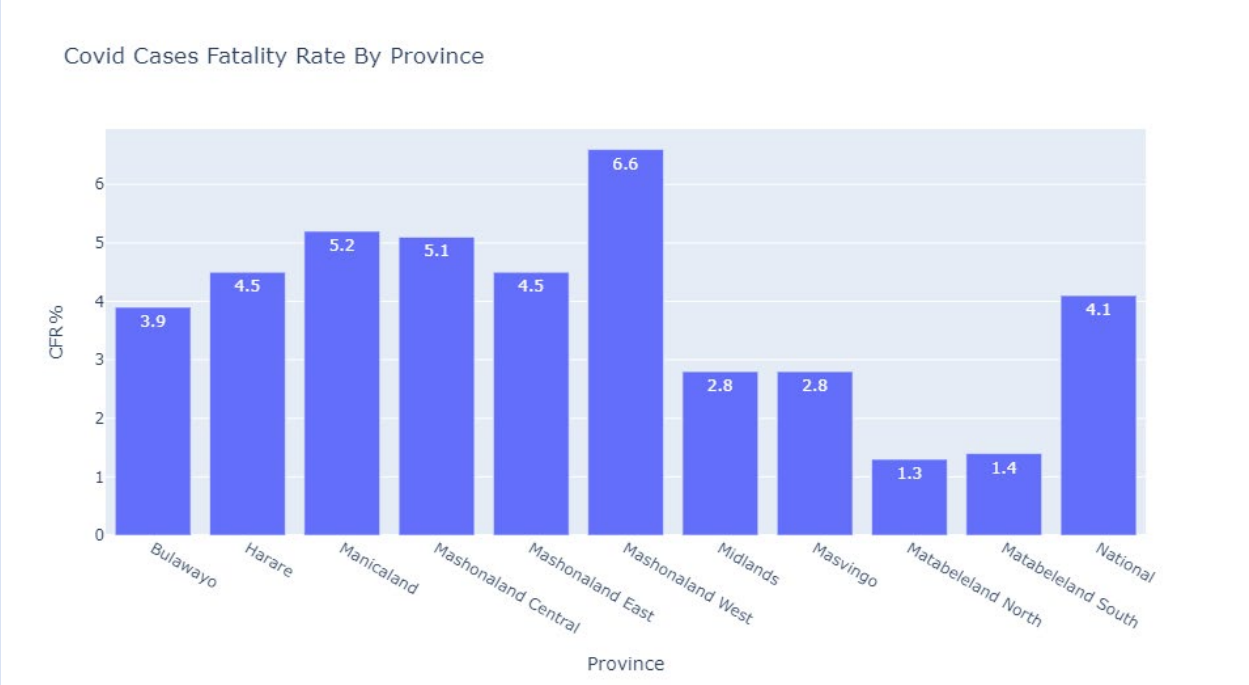


COMMENTS

COVID CASE FATALITY RATIO BY PROVINCE

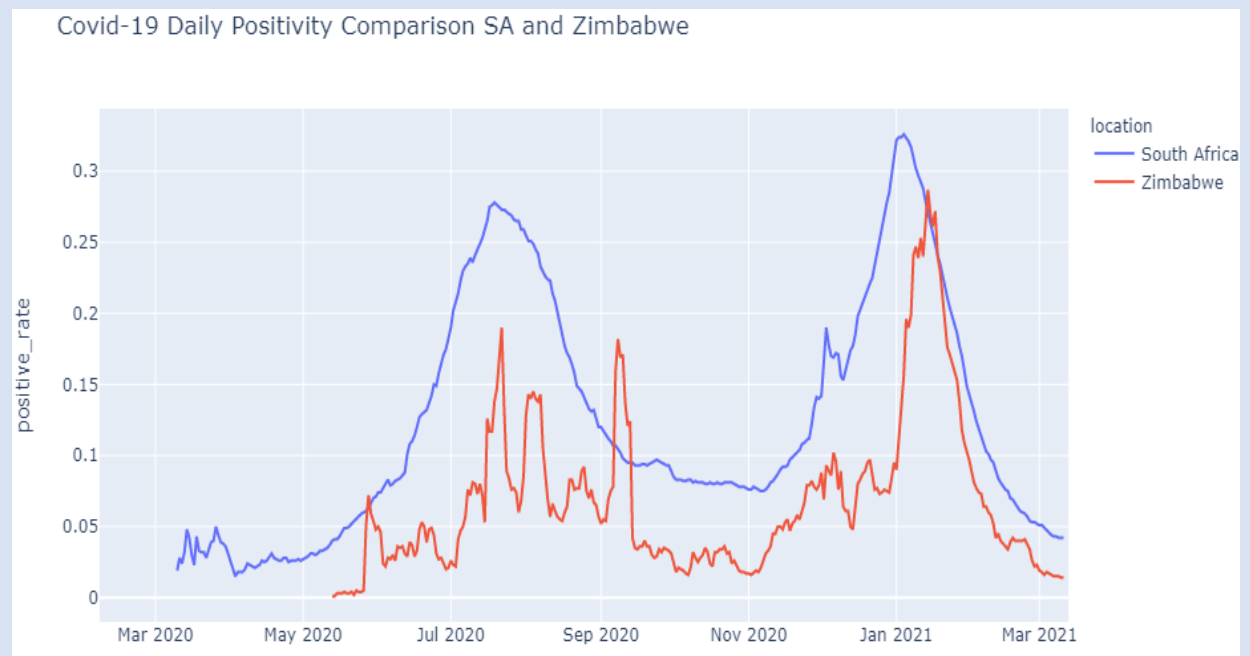
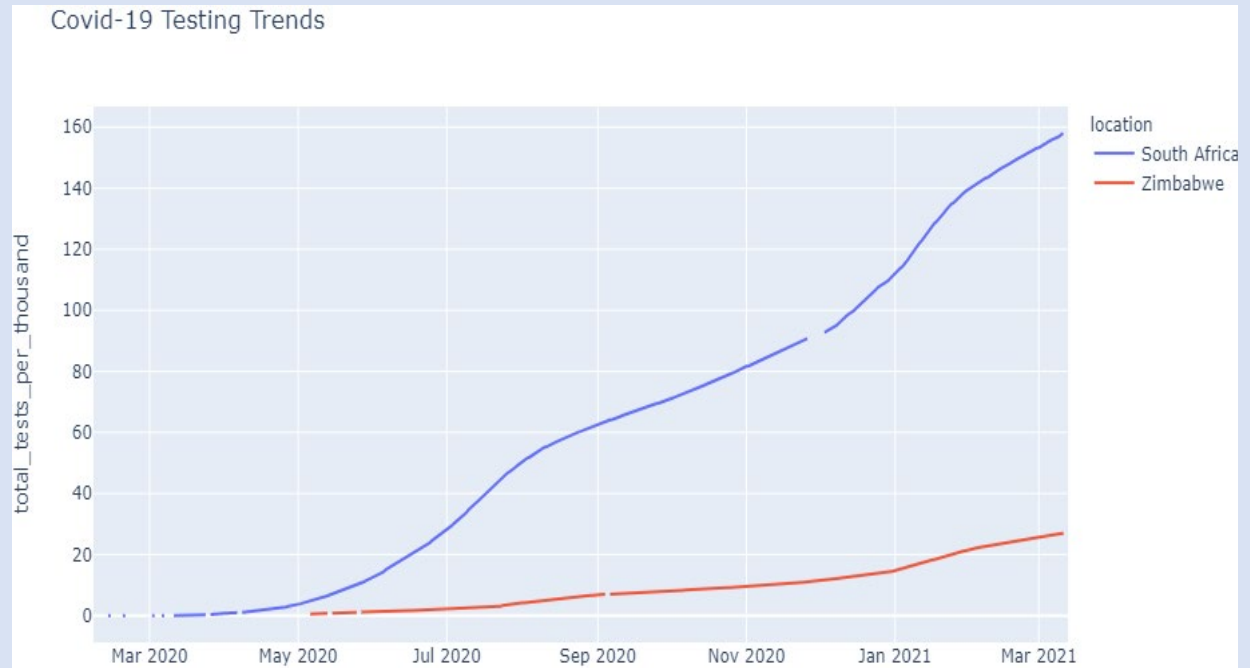

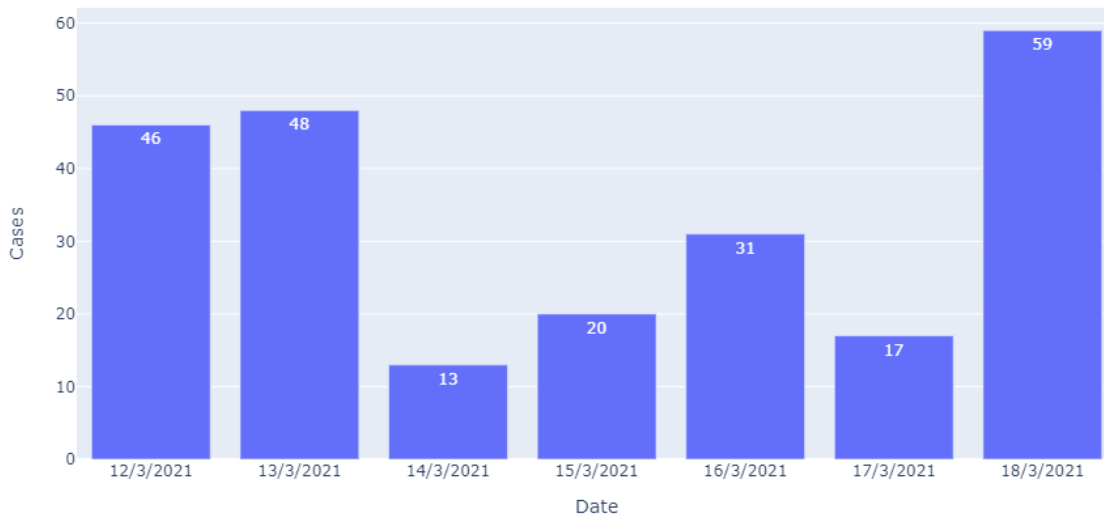

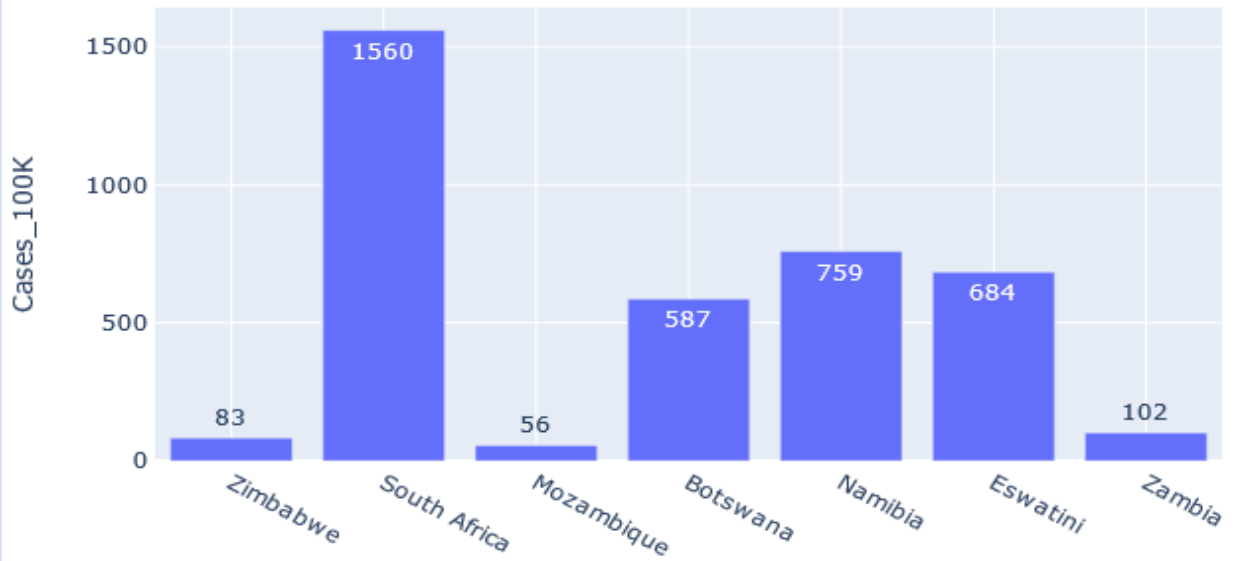

Zimbabwe Covid_19 Cases in the Last Seven Days

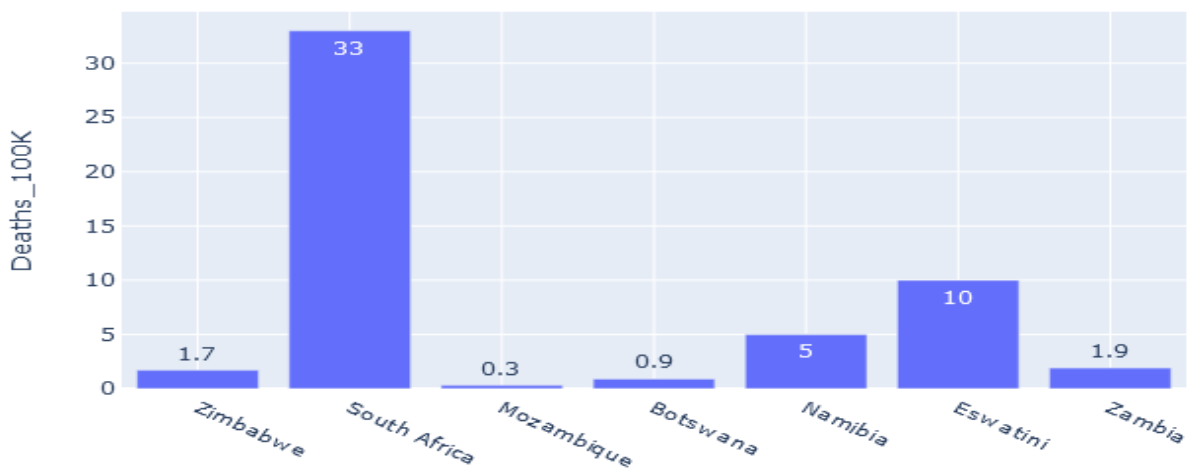




SADC Covid Cases Per 100K Population
